Love in the Spotlight

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The Camera sweeps through the quaint, yet vibrant main street of Myrtle Gardens, FL. The gentle breeze blowing through the tree lined streets. Shoppers walk and neighbors laugh with each other. There is a friendly bustle that only can be found in a town where everyone knows everyone.

The camera stops on what was once the crown jewel of the town. The Embassy Theatre. We see the exterior of the theater, a faint memory of the glory it once held. The camera zooms in to the marquee "Happy Retirement ADRIAN BAKER." It pans down to a plaque that reads "EMBASSY THEATRE. WHERE MOVIE STARS ARE BORN" There, a photo of our hero, KATE WARNER, hangs.

FADES TO:

2 INT. KATE'S HOME HOLLYWOOD, CA - DAY

The same photo in KATE'S home office. The camera zooms out to see the room is sunny, bright, and stylish, just like KATE, 30's, beauty, brains, and talent all wrapped up with kindness and warmth. She sits on her settee with a script, computer open, and phone by her side.

KATE'S phone buzzes. She picks it up without looking as she is reading furiously.

KATE

(answers the phone)
I really want to say yes, but this
ending, this screenplay, just
isn't right.

LILY

Well, knowing you, you already know what you're looking for.

KATE

Oh my gosh! Lily! I thought you were Jacob.

LILY

Your tall, successful, and handsome movie exec? I get that all the time.

KATE laughs.

KATE

I mean, I did make you rehearse opposite me in countless shows. Remember when I made you play everyone OTHER than Juliet so I could perfect my death scene?

LILY

Among sooooo many others. I've probably been your leading man more than anyone else. But, what are best friends for if not total humiliation?

KATE

That's what I've always said.

LILY

So...I have some news.

KATE

Is it that Jimmy finally asked you out?

LILY

What? No! Why is that always the first thing you guess?

KATE

Because someday I'll be right. He's been in love with you for years.

LILY

Ok, well, we can discuss that another time, because we allwwwayyys do. Anyway, I wasn't sure if the Myrtle Gardens gossip made it to you, but ADRIAN is retiring.

KATE

(sadly) Yeah, Mom mentioned that.

LILY

Well, the town is throwing him a big send off.

KATE

Is he leaving town?

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LILY

No, but you know this place, any chance to throw a party.

KATE

You mean any chance for my Mom to throw a party?

LILY

Of course, I do. Anyway, I think she didn't want to bother you about all of it because you just got back from filming...but it's this weekend.

KATE

Like...in 2 days this weekend?

LILY

Mmmhmmmm.

KATE

Well...

KATE opens her calendar.

KATE (CONT'D)

Jacob and I don't have anything scheduled, and it might give me some time to find a good script in peace. Everything I have read so far has been so blah. Just completely wrong. It's my first time producing. Everything has to be just right.

LILY

Well, there's nowhere more peaceful than Myrtle Gardens.

KATE

(laughing) There is so much truth in that statement. Jacob and I are having dinner tonight.

LILY

Maybe you'll finally convince him to come and see where you grew up.

KATE

Maybe. I'll call you tomorrow and let you know?

LILY

Sounds like a plan.

KATE

Talk soon.

LILY

Mwah.

KATE hangs up the phone goes back to her script. Just as she picks it up, her phone buzzes. She looks at it. A text from JACOB. She reads "Virgo Rising. 7 pm."

KATE texts back: "See you then. Love you." No response.

CUT TO:

3 INT. EMBASSY THEATRE - DAY

The camera pans from the back of the theatre to reveal a shell of a set on the stage for the upcoming tribute to ADRIAN. The ghost light is on the stage. The camera moves through the space. The outline of someone at the director's table can be seen. This is NICK, 30's handsome, smart, the best friend everyone wants. He is surrounded by scripts, fabric samples, gels, but he is only focused on the computer. The screen is full of graphs, numbers, and budgets.

ADRIAN BAKER, 60's, fabulous and eccentric, waltzes in the theatre full of flair and pizzazz that only he possesses.

ADRIAN

(playfully) THIS does not look like a rehearsal for my send off extravaganza.

NICK

That's because THIS...

NICK gestures at his desk.

NICK (CONT'D) (CONT'D)
...is what will hopefully keep
this place running after you've
extravagantly retired. Emphasis on
hopefully.

ADRIAN

If anyone can bring this beautiful girl back to her former glory, it is you Nicholas.

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NICK

Right now, I just have to focus on keeping the doors open.

ADRIAN

I'm so sorry for leaving you with this burden.

NICK stops what he is doing and looks at ADRIAN

NICK

It's not a burden! It's a legacy. And I am honored to be entrusted with it. This is just a little speed bump along the way, that's all.

ADRIAN

You are a sweet young man. Utterly full of it, but sweet nonetheless. I'll leave you to it.

NICK

ADRIAN, can you meet me tomorrow at Town Hall for the hearing about the theatre? I think having you there may help sway the council.

ADRIAN

As you wish.

NICK gets back to work.

FADE OUT

4 INT. VIRGO RISING RESTAURANT - NIGHT

The camera finds the candle on the table and pans up to see KATE waiting alone at the table. We see the surrounding tables noticing who she is. She tries to hide her face. JACOB MILLS, 40's, very handsome, rich, a little stuffy, enters.

JACOB

Kate!

KATE looks up. The patrons at surrounding tables get out their phones take pictures and video of KATE.

KATE

Jacob. Hi.

They embrace.

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KATE (CONT'D)

Um, can we maybe go somewhere a little more private. Everyone is noticing that I'm here.

JACOB

You're a movie star, Kate. It comes with the territory, you know that.

KATE

And you know I am beyond flattered, I just like to be as private as possible.

JACOB

Well, seeing you out and about will help with the box office of your newest venture.

KATE

With my handsome beau and movie exec making it all happen?

JACOB

(Pause) Have you signed off on that script yet? My boss is on my back.

KATE

No. Actually, I wanted to talk to you about that. I'm not really sure about the ending, in fact the whole screenplay doesn't feel right...

JACOB

I'm sure it's fine, Kate. As soon as you sign off we can get this moving.

KATE

It's just that if I am producing a project, I really want it to be something special, and I just don't think it is.

JACOB

Kate. This writer has given the studio their last 5 blockbusters. It's fine. Just sign off on it, and let's move on to the next.

KATE

This is a big deal for me. You know I want to be more than just an actor. It's a delicate decision and I want to treat it that way.

JACOB

Just. Sign it. Ok? Trust me.

KATE

I, (beat) okay.

JACOB

Great. There is something else important that I want to talk to you about.

KATE

Actually, I needed to talk to you too. Not a huge deal, but, I thought, maybe this time..

JACOB

I think I should go first.

KATE

Oh. Sure. Sorry. Go ahead.

JACOB

Kate, we have been seeing each other for a while now. And I really feel that we are at a turning point. Both professionally and personally.

KATE

Jacob..I don't think we are
ready//

JACOB (CONT'D)

I've been offered promotion
to senior executive and I
need to focus on my career if
I want to be President before
I'm 45..//

KATE (CONT'D)
//...to take that step
together...I love you but...//

JACOB (CONT'D) //I think we need to break up//

KATE (CONT'D)

(she blinks) What?

FAN GIRL

Hi, Ms. Warner, I'm so sorry to bother you, but could I have your autograph?

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KATE

(completely robotic) Huh? Yeah. Of course. Thank you so much for watching. Your support keeps me going. There you go.

FAN GIRL

Oh wow! Kylee is never gonna believe this!

FAN GIRL leaves, ecstatic.

KATE

(stares blankly) I ...

JACOB

Kate. I am sorry. You know how terrific I think you are.

KATE looks around and see the patrons. They gawk at her. Film her. Snap her picture.

KATE

I do. I know. I just...(overwhelmed)
I need to go.

KATE gets up from the table. She begins to walk away. She turns back.

KATE (CONT'D)

Tell your boss, thank you for the opportunity, but I can't sign off until I find the right script.

JACOB

Kate, we are all counting on this.

KATE

Then tell them I will bring a story to them. The ones they gave me aren't good enough for me to put my name on. But I will find something that is. I promise. Um, (beat) Bye? I guess.

KATE puts on her sunglasses and walks away. JACOB begins to say something, but his phone rings. He answers.

JACOB

Yes sir. What can I do for you...

FADE OUT:

5 INT. KATE'S HOUSE HOLLYWOOD, CA - NIGHT 5 *

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KATE walks in, takes off her sunglasses, coat, and locks her door. She walks to her computer, turns it on and books a ticket to Myrtle Gardens. She picks up her phone and dials.

KATE

(on phone) Mom? Get my room ready, I'm coming home.

KATE TO LILY(VIA TEXT)

Hey Lil. I won't be calling tomorrow, but I'll be seeing you TTYL.

KATE goes to her bedroom. She grabs a box from the highest shelf in her closet. Inside are some of her most treasured memories. Ticket stubs, newspaper clippings, memorabilia, all from The Embassy Theatre. She smiles.

She stops on a program from a One-Act play. She looks at the names on the front cover. Directed by KATE WARNER. Written by NICK KRUGER. A picture falls out. She and NICK, her best friend in college, laughing. She remembers.

She picks up her phone and looks up NICK'S number. She contemplates. She dials. She hangs up. She shakes her head and puts the program back in the box.

CUT TO:

INT EMBASSY THEATRE - NIGHT 6

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NICK is in the theatre working. His phone lights up for a second. He picks it up too late. He sees the name, KATIE WARNER and the caller ID picture, the same picture KATE was just looking at. He thinks about calling back, but doesn't.

NICK

(to himself) Butt dial.

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NICK takes a picture of KATE from his director's binder and sits it by the light for inspiration. He continues to work.

CUT TO:

7 INT. KATE'S HOME HOLLYWOOD, CA - NIGHT 7 KATE puts the box back on her shelf, but keeps the picture of she and NICK out. She goes to her bed and lies down, looks at the pic and smiles. FADE OUT: 8 INT. EMBASSY THEATRE - MORNING 8 NICK is asleep at the table, a mess of papers surrounding him. ADRIAN enters. * ADRIAN My boy, are you ready to dazzle the board? NICK (waking up) What...ADRIAN, what are you...? Oh shoot! What time is it? ADRIAN Time to make our way to Town Hall. NICK I fell asleep. I fell asleep?! I don't have everything prepared... ADRIAN Well you have me. We have you. And that, my boy, will have to be enough. Let's go. NICK I...Ok. Let's go. NICK grabs his laptop and they are out the door. FADE TO: EXT. KATE'S CHILDHOOD HOME - MORNING 9 KATE gets out of her car. LILY, 30's, spunky and fun with a winning smile and a twinkle in her eye, sits on the porch waiting for KATE. KATE Lil?!

LILY
There she is...Miss Hollywood.

KATE takes off her sunglasses, because here, she is just KATE.

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LILY (CONT'D)

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I've missed you.

KATE

I've missed you too. So much.

LILY runs down the stairs to embrace her best friend..

KATE (CONT'D) What are you doing here? Where's Mom?

LILY

Oh, she stopped by the boutique and asked if I would come and meet you...she wanted to be at Town Hall for the hearing about the theatre. So I closed up and came on over.

KATE

What hearing? About the Embassy?

LILY

Yeah. There was maybe more to me calling than just the retirement party.

KATE

There always is.

LILY

It's for good reason!

KATE

What's going on?

LILY

The theatre is in trouble.

KATE

(beat) What kind of trouble?

LILY

Real trouble. It's not making the money it used to. People have moved out of town and as much as ADRIAN has tried, there just isn't as much of an audience anymore.

KATE

Oh.

LILY

I thought maybe you could help?

KATE

Me? How?

LILY

Kate. YOU'RE Kate Warner. THE Kate Warner. If you care about something, everyone does. Especially people in your own hometown. I thought maybe if you came back and showed your support...it might make a difference.

KATE

Why didn't mom tell me?

LILY

I think she knew you were stressed about producing your first project...she didn't want to bother you. She's stubborn. Like her daughter.

KATE

Well...with ADRIAN retiring...if we save the Embassy, who is going to run it?

LILY

Ah...the other reason your Mom probably didn't tell you about all of this. The new Artistic Director...is Nick.

KATE

Nick? Nick Nick? (pause) I thought he was still in New York?

LILY

He was. Until his mom got sick. He came back here to take care of her and then just stayed.

KATE

Oh. Right. I knew that. I knew that.

LILY

LILY (CONT'D)

you because he didn't want to burden you.

KATE

Sure. I mean, he knows it wouldn't have been a burden. (pause) I just...I should have come back. You know? I always said he's the friend that would do anything for me, and, then when it really counted, I didn't do anything for him.

LILY

And what am I?

KATE

You know what I mean.

LILY

I'll allow it. But only because of jetlag. Are you gonna be ok if you run into him?

KATE

It's Myrtle Gardens, Lily, you mean when. When I run into him.

LILY

I was trying to be optimistic.

KATE

Yeah. I'll be fine. It will be good to see him, actually. I'd like to apologize in person.

LILY

For missing the funeral?

KATE

Yeah. And just...life. It kind of got away from me for a while.

LILY

Is he still the one?

KATE

The one? No...I..wait what do you mean?

LILY

The one that could have been?

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KATE

(Confused) I...

LILY

What am I saying!? You're dating a hot Network Exec now. Jason? Right?

KATE

Jacob, actually. And not anymore. In fact, he dumped me just yesterday.

LILY

He dumped...you?

KATE

Yeah. Totally off script, right?

LILY

I'll say. Are you okay?

KATE

Actually, yes. Much better than expected. I mean, since the tabloids picked it up this morning.

KATE shows LILY her phone with an article and video about the breakup.

LILY

Yikes.

KATE

You saw it already didn't you?

LILY

I'm sorry I brought it up. I didn't mean to upset you all over again.

KATE

Does everyone know?

LILY

What...no... (beat) absolutely they do. Yep.

KATE

Great.

LILY

But hey, after tomorrow the entire town will be talking about Adrian and his retirement, and you know how he loves the attention.

KATE

I do. I can't believe we might lose the theatre.

LILY

I know. C'mon Let's get you unpacked and get you to the Embassy. Your mom is going to meet you there after the hearing.

KATE

Just like old times

LILY

You know nothing changes around here.

KATE

There's some comfort in that.

LILY smiles and helps KATE take her things inside. The door closes behind them.

CUT TO:

10 EXT TOWN HALL - DAY

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The doors swing open and out walks NICK, ADRIAN, followed by CAROL WARNER, 50's bright and warm. CAROL breaks off to talk with a small group. ADRIAN and NICK continue on.

NICK

Four days?! Four DAYS?! I can't raise \$100,000 in four days.

ADRIAN

But the good news is they do want the theatre to succeed.

NICK

I don't feel like having to raise \$100,000 in four days inspires much confidence in the art. Or me.

ADRIAN

I mean they didn't just throw it out the window entirely. They are (MORE)

ADRIAN (CONT'D)

giving you and the theatre a chance.

NICK

Yes. A chance to fail.

ADRIAN

You've never failed at anything you've set your mind to.

NICK

I wish that were true.

CAROL catches up to them.

CAROL

Nick. ADRIAN. I am so sorry for how that went in there. The Embassy has been put before the city council before, but I've never seen this.

NICK

Well, it's never been this bad off before either. We've been in the red for over seven years. They have every right to ask us to pull ourselves out before they release the funding.

ADRIAN

And we will.

NICK

I appreciate your optimism ADRIAN, but I'm not so sure.

CAROL

Well, let's look at what we can do. We can make this retirement tribute unforgettable. I have to run home and grab some costumes. I'll drop them by and then you can put me to work.

NICK

I can use all the help I can get.

ADRIAN

(to CAROL) I'll help you with the costumes

CAROL

Ah. Wonderful. Thanks.

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ADRIAN

(shrugs) It makes me feel useful.

NICK

I'm heading to the theatre now. I'll see you in a few.

CAROL and ADRIAN head to CAROL'S car. NICK begins his walk to the theatre.

FADE TO:

11 EXT MAIN STREET - AFTERNOON

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KATE and LILY walk toward the Theatre. JIMMY, 30's, shy, artsy, and loveable, walks out of the coffee shop.

JIMMY

Oh hi, Lily. (pause) Oh my goodness. Kate. Hi! I didn't realize it was you.

KATE

That is actually very refreshing. Hi Jimmy.

KATE sneaks a look at Lily. Lily clocks it.

LILY

Hi Jimmy. What's up?

JIMMY

Actually I was heading to the store to see you...I mean...to see if you maybe needed a little afternoon pick me up.

JIMMY hands her the coffee.

JIMMY (CONT'D)

A little coffee with your cream and sugar. Just the way you like it.

LILY

Thanks Jimmy. That's really sweet of you. Hey, Kate, do you mind if we stop by the store quickly? I closed up pretty fast and just want to check on things.

KATE

Wait. No one's at the store at all? Lily! Go. I'll be fine. Mom's meeting me at the Embassy. It'll be nice to see the old place and soak it in on my own anyway.

LILY

You're sure?

KATE

100 percent. Go.

LILY

Ok. I'll call you later.

JIMMY

(to LILY) I'll walk you there, if that's alright?

KATE looks at LILY and gives her a knowing look.

LILY

Sure. That would be nice. Thanks.

LILY and KATE exchange looks. LILY mouths "stop it" to KATE. JIMMY is enthralled. JIMMY and LILY walk off and KATE walks toward the theatre.

CUT TO:

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12 EXT EMBASSY THEATRE - AFTERNOON

KATE walks to the Theatre doors. She smiles as she sees the plaque in her honor on the door. She takes a selfie with it. As she takes her phone from her bag, JACOB'S name and photo pop up on the caller ID. KATE ignores the call and takes the selfie.

She opens the doors to the theatre and walks inside.

CUT TO:

13 INT EMBASSY THEATRE - MOMENTS LATER

KATE walks down the aisle of the theatre and takes in the * sights and smells.

KATE makes her way to the stage. The ghostlight is all that illuminates the house. She walks slowly around. Touching * costumes, set pieces, and finally stands in the center of the *

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stage and looksout at the audience. Her home. She begins to hum happily.

NICK arrives at the theatre. He hears something. He quietly opens the door to the auditorium and his breath is taken away. He walks toward the stage, but is still in the dark.

NICK

"Constant as the northern star".

KATE

(startled) I'm so sorry, I didn't know anyone was here...

KATE grabs her bag to go.

KATE (CONT'D) (CONT'D)

I'm meeting my mom and (beat) Nick? Is that you?

NICK

Last time I checked.

KATE

Well, your comebacks are as snappy as ever.

NICK

I had to be ready in case you came home. Looks like it paid off.

KATE

Ha! I couldn't miss Adrian's retirement. Is he here?

NICK

He will be. He and your mom went to grab the costumes.

KATE

As "constant as the northern star".

NICK

Not quite. A few things have changed.

KATE

Yeah. A few things.

NICK

It's good to see you Katie.

KATE

It's just Kate now.

NICK

Not to me.

KATE

(she smiles). You're the only one I ever let get away with calling me Katie. It's good to see you too, Nick.

They look at each other for a brief moment, that seems to encapsule a lifetime. Then a loud slam as the door opens to reveal ADRIAN.

ADRIAN

Darlings!

NICK

He always did know how to make an entrance.

ADRIAN

Katie Warner! Darling, how are
you?

NICK

I thought I was the only one you allowed to call you that?

KATE

Adrian doesn't count. Besides, he usually calls me...

ADRIAN

My Beatrice. You look beautiful.

CAROL walks in with an arm full of costumes.

CAROL

Now that is a memory. What a beautiful show.

NICK

(to KATE) You were wonderful.

KATE

So were you. You should have been onstage more often.

ADRIAN

I agree. A breathtaking Benedict.

KATE

Who is nothing without his Beatrice.

ADRIAN

"There was a star danced, and under that, you were born." Much Ado, Act 4 Scene 1

KATE

Hi Adrian.

KATE and ADRAIN hug. CAROL hangs costumes up on the stage.

CAROL

Isn't that the show where you fell in the middle of your monologue?

NICK

(he laughs) I forgot about that.

KATE

As well you should have.

CAROL

Hi Honey.

CAROL rushes down, arms now free to hug her daughter.

KATE

Hi Mom (they hug) So good to see you. I missed you.

ADRIAN

I suppose you have been apprised on the details of our little drama?

KATE

Yeah. Lily filled me in. Mom, why didn't you tell me? I would have come sooner. I can donate...

ADRIAN

No. I will not take a hand out.

CAROL

(To Kate) I know you would have, honey. That's why I didn't say anything. I know how stressed you are about producing your first project.

KATE

Some things are more important.

ADRIAN

Well, I'm just thrilled that you are here now. Celebrations can commence!

KATE

I'd like to help if I can. Nick? Adrian? Is there anything I can do?

NICK

Yes. You can go and enjoy some much-needed time with your family. Take this guy with you (points to ADRIAN) so I can get some work done.

KATE looks at him suspiciously. She takes a deep breath.

KATE

Mom?

CAROL

I think that is the perfect idea. Nick, you won't join us?

NICK

I really have to get some work done, but thank you.

KATE

I'll see you around?

NICK

In this town? I think it's a quarantee.

KATE smiles as she, CAROL, and ADRIAN exit. NICK watches them all go, sits at his desk, gently touches the picture of he and KATE, and gets to work.

CUT TO:

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14 INT. KATE'S CHILDHOOD HOME - EVENING

KATE, LILY, CAROL, and ADRIAN are all gathered in the kitchen. They drink wine, snack on what will eventually be the meal, and laugh. There is a familiarity in the air that you can only get at home.

KATE

I remember the first day I met you Adrian. I was SO nervous.

ADRIAN

Why?

KATE

I had always dreamed of becoming an actor, but I didn't really know what that meant.

CAROL

(To ADRIAN) That's true. Ever since she was three and I told her that superheroes were just people pretending to be superheroes

KATE

And I said then THAT'S what I want to be.

LILY

I remember you being a wreck before you left school to meet him...a "real actor"

KATE

Yeah! Because he was a REAL actor. I had never met someone who had really done it before. (to ADRIAN) You had been to New York. You had been on Broadway! Who was I?

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ADRIAN

The sweetest, most ambitious, sparkling 16 year old I had ever met. That's who.

KATE

You're just saying that because we are birthday twins

ADRIAN

Therefore, it is like looking in a mirror. (Beat) But truly. I knew right away we would be great friends.

KATE

And I knew my life had changed for good.

CAROL

Well, you were only 16.

LILY

And you thought tight rolled jeans were "haute couture".

KATE

Uh, they came back, didn't they?

LILY

Unfortunately.

KATE

Anyway, I'm glad I can be here.

ADRIAN

Me too, my Beatrice.

CAROL

I just wish we could do more to ensure your legacy survives.

ADRIAN

We are doing everything we can. That's why I appointed Nick to take over. Other than Kate here, he's the only one I know who loves the theatre as much as me AND could handle the pressure.

CAROL

If only we could get more support from the board, or even some more volunteers. I feel like I'm an island most days.

KATE

Mom, you've been running that volunteer board for as long as I can remember. What happened?

CAROL

It just fizzled. People moved away and no one moved in. The town is fading. The Embassy is all we have left when it comes to any type of cultural enrichment.

LILY

You know, I read about this tiny town up north that's entire main street was revitalized by a theatre. It brought in tourism, (MORE)

LILY (CONT'D)

revenue, new businesses. What if we did something like that here?

CAROL

How?

LILY

We could implore someone with a lot of sway to work with her "would have been" flame, you know...(looks at KATE) had she not run off to become a famous movie star.

KATE

Subtle.

LILY

Subtlety IS my super power.

KATE

I'm more than happy to help. I just don't know how.

ADRIAN

Creativity...and perseverance.

CAROL

If anyone can help, I know it's you. But right now...let's just all relax and eat. It's been too long.

They all head to the table for dinner.

KATE

(changing the subject) Oh, Lily. How was your walk with Jimmy?

LILY

Really? That's you want to talk about?

KATE

Yes. Yes it is.

They all sit and begin to dig into the meal.

FADE TO:

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15 INT. KATE'S CHILDHOOD BEDROOM - MORNING

KATE wakes up and looks around her room. She smiles and takes it in for a moment. She grabs her phone. Four missed calls

from JACOB, even more texts. She places it down, ignoring him.

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She gets out of bed and heads to her vanity. The room is just as she left it. She looks at the pictures in her vanity mirror. Takes a second. Then smells coffee and her mom's famous blueberry waffles - aka Blue-ffles. Smiles and heads downstairs.

KATE

I smell coffee.

CAROL

And my famous blue-ffles. I know how much you love them.

KATE

CAROL (CONT'D) // With love// And plenty of blueberries.

Only the way you make them...//with love//

KATE pours coffee and sits at the counter as CAROL makes food.

KATE (CONT'D)
It's just me and you now. Mom, tell me. How much trouble is the theatre in?

CAROL

A lot. Adrian has been relying on government funding to subsidize the low ticket sales for about 7 years. It caught up to him.

KATE

Is no one going anymore?

CAROL

Not really. Just us blue haired old ladies.

KATE

Mom, you're not old.

CAROL

Well...I don't have blue hair yet anyway.

KATE

What's going to happen?

CAROL

The council said they would match the \$100,000 needed for the season (MORE)

*

CAROL (CONT'D)

if Nick could come up with it. But they have been in the red for so many years. No amount of bake sales or small musical revues can make up the difference.

KATE

What about a fundraiser? Or gala?

CAROL

He only has four days.

KATE

Four days?

CAROL

I guess, three now, technically.

KATE

What happened to the season opener? Wasn't that always a huge money maker?

CAROL

There was no audience. So ADRIAN had to cut it to save money. I'm basically the only volunteer left now. There just doesn't seem to be an interest anymore. The town is more interested in staying home and streaming from the couch.

KATE

I hate that I have a part in that.

CAROL

Hey. No. You left with goals and grabbed every single one of them. Never be sorry for that.

KATE

I just wish there was something I could do.

CAROL

Well, drink some of that magic bean juice, have a few blue-ffles, and perhaps you'll be inspired.

KATE

If anything can do it, your blueffles can. CAROL smiles. She serves KATE some waffles and looks to the mantle. A picture of the family sits there. The camera closes in on KATE'S dad LEVI.

CAROL

Your dad would be so proud of you. I mean, I am, of course. But you did what he always wanted to do.

KATE

Every show I've ever done, every award ceremony I go to...I still think I see his silhouette standing in the back of the house watching. He never did sit in the audience.

CAROL

He was too nervous for you. Plus, I think that was his way of being fully present for you. He could take it all in. Just watching you all by himself.

KATE

I really hate that he never got to see me on the big screen. See that I really made it. I miss him.

CAROL

Me too honey. Me too. But he's smiling down. And maybe he even left all of his pride for you behind with me, because I can't begin to put into words how proud you make me.

KATE

My biggest fan.

CAROL

Always and forever.

KATE smiles and takes a sip of her coffee.

KATE

Do you think that maybe, it's more of a lack of interest in the Embassy that's keeping people from coming?

CAROL

How do you mean?

KATE

Like, take me for example. I'll always love going to shows.
Musicals. Shakespeare, obviously.
Shaw. Contemporary. I love it all.
But, not everyone grew up with you and Dad.

CAROL

I feel for them.

KATE

(laughing) As do I. But, what I mean is...what if we could make going to see a show as fun and exciting as trailers make movies? You know? Make people see that it IS worth getting off the couch, getting out of the house. To see something they can't see anywhere else. To experience it.

CAROL

Ok. How?

KATE

We need to go viral.

CAROL

Viral?

KATE

Yeah. Get the word out. Bring the community into the theatre's world without them having to leave their couch. We could pull back the curtain and let them in, they would fall in love with it just like we did.

CAROL

I don't understand a word of what you are saying, but anything is worth a shot.

KATE

Lily has done some amazing things for the boutique online. I know she would help. And Jimmy! He's a photographer. We could ask him to take care of the visual side of it. CAROL

Plus he would do it just to be near Lily. Has he asked her out yet?

*

KATE

That's a project for another time.

They laugh together.

KATE(CONT'D) (CONT'D)

Do you think Nick would go for it?

→

CAROL

For you? Yes.

KATE

For the theatre.

CAROL

For both.

KATE

Well, then. Convince Nick. I guess I have my agenda for the day.

4

CAROL

He's an adjunct professor at the college now. You could try to catch him there.

KATE

He is? I bet he's a great teacher.

CAROL

The students love him. Last year, he was nominated for Professor of the Year.

KATE

I can't believe I didn't know that.

CAROL

Well, time to see him in action. Now scoot. I have costumes to make and you have a theatre to save. KATE

Right. Guess I never did give up that superhero dream. Thanks for breakfast, Mom.

CAROL

Anytime. Coffee to go?

KATE

Yeah. Thanks. And one for Nick. Black. One Sugar. I'll buy his attention.

KATE goes upstairs to get ready.

CAROL

Oh sweetie. His attention for you has always been free of charge.

CUT TO:

16 INT. TITIAN UNIVERSITY HALL - MORNING

16

*

*

*

KATE walks down the hall with two coffees in hand. A few students notice her.

She walks to the lecture hall and sneaks in the back. NICK teachs a small group of 10 students.

NICK

That leads us to want and need.

NICK writes on the board

· ·

*

NICK (CONT'D)

What does the hero think they want and do they proactively pursue it? What do they need, and how does it relate to their flaw or problem? How are they ultimately bound to change?

KATE

The object of the hero's pursuit, is what they desire. But what turns out to be the true solution to their flaw or problem is something else. It's their need.

*

*

NICK

And it's their need that ends up changing their life.

KATE and NICK look at each other for a moment.

NICK (CONT'D)

Everyone. May I introduce Kate

Warner.

The class take out their phones and chatter in KATE'S presence.

KATE

Hi. I'm so sorry to interrupt your session. I'll just wait...

NICK

It's no problem. We were just finishing up. (To class) I want an outline of your characters along with their wants and needs by Friday.

COLIN

Mr. K? Can we all get a selfie with Kate?

NICK

That is up to her.

KATE

(playfully) Only if "Mr. K" agrees to be in it as well.

NICK

Done.

The class surrounds KATE and NICK snaps a selfie of them all.

NICK (CONT'D) (CONT'D)

I will see you all next week. Upload those homework assignments by end of day Friday. And I will see you all at the retirement party Sunday.

The class files out. Several students stop and say hello to KATE as she makes her way to NICK. She hands him the coffee.

KATE

Black. One sugar.

NICK

You remember.

KATE

We had enough late night rehearsals that I know your wants and needs better than my own.

NICK takes the coffee.

NICK

So, what's up?

KATE

Right to it, huh? I've missed dealing with direct, honest people Ok. I want to help save the theatre

NICK

It's fine Katie. I'm handling it.

KATE

I know you are. But I still want to help. You know how much that place means to me.

NICK

(playfully) I do know, but you have more important movie star things to do.

KATE

Nothing is more important than family. And this place. The people. You. It's home. It's my family. I...haven't been the best at showing that, but it's the truth.

NICK is silent for a moment.

KATE(CONT'D) (CONT'D)

Listen. I owe you an apology.I should have been here when your mom got sick. You were there for me when my dad passed, and I...

NICK

It's fine. You were busy, Katie. You called. I understood.

KATE

But I shouldn't have been busy.
You would never have been too busy
(MORE)

KATE (CONT'D)

for me. You weren't ever too busy for me.

NICK

We lost touch. It happens to everyone.

KATE

But not to us. It shouldn't have happened to us. And I regret it.

NICK

Katie, look. I get it. You were always ambitious. I always knew you would make it...you had more drive than anyone in this town. Definitely more than me. Mom got sick and I made that a reason to give up.

KATE

Nick. It was your mother.

NICK

Yeah, but I could have gone back to New York. I used it as an excuse to stay where it was safe. I've made my peace with it. But...I need to prove to myself that I can still do something important and this, saving the Embassy, is important.

KATE

I agree. It is important. And I'm saying you don't have to do it alone.

NICK

(playfully) You know, you can't just swoop in and save the day and then leave. (serious) And, I told you I won't take a handout. The Embassy needs to survive on its own, and I have to figure that out.

KATE

I know. I'm not trying to swoop in. I want it to survive on its own as much as you do. I wouldn't be where I am without that place, (MORE)

*

KATE (CONT'D)

or without ADRIAN. (pause) Or without you.

NICK

(pause) I'll think about it.

KATE

You will. Really? Or you're just saying that to get me to stop talking like when I would give you ideas for your scripts?

NICK

I. Will. Think about it.

KATE

Ok. Yes. Good. I'll take it.

KATE smiles and begins to leave. She turns back.

KATE(CONT'D) (CONT'D)

Ok, but before you have a chance to change your mind, can we maybe have dinner and spitball a little? I mean, I do have some ideas, but I won't overstep. (pause) We were always a great team.

NICK

I have a feeling we still are.

KATE smiles. NICK returns the sentiment.

NICK (CONT'D)

Vera's Diner at 6?

KATE

Or I can get takeout and bring it to you.

NICK

You know what? You're the movie star. Yes, dinner on you. Meet you at the Embassy at 6.

KATE

It's a date.

KATE leaves.

NICK

(hopeful) It's a date.

FADE TO:

17 EXT. MAIN STREET - EVENING

17

*

The day dims and the streetlights begin to illuminate. The quaint town is beautiful in the evening.

KATE walks to the theater with a ridiculous amount of food in her hands. LILY and JIMMY walk together in the distance. They see KATE and run to her to help open the door.

LILY

Finally off the Hollywood diet, huh?

LILY and JIMMY take some food and relieve KATE.

KATE

There is some food I can only get here, and I am making the most of it.

LILY

Likely story.

KATE

Fine. I'm actually helping Nick with something.

LILY

00000000...

KATE

Wow. Really? We are just...

LILY

No need to explain. I approve.

KATE

(looking to Jimmy), and what are you two up to?

LILY

Nothing, He was just making sure I got home ok.

KATE

(mimicking) Ooooooo...

LILY

Touché.

JIMMY laughs quietly and gives KATE a smile. KATE'S phone buzzes. JACOB. She ignores it.

LILY (CONT'D)

Jacob?

KATE

You know me too well.

JIMMY

Jacob?

LILY

Kate's movie exec ex- boyfriend

KATE

Ex. EX boyfriend. And exec. Yes. Both

LILY

I said Ex. I'll say it first next time. What does he want?

KATE

Probably my signature on a contract to produce this script that I don't want my name anywhere near.

LILY

What are you going to do? Didn't you already sign a contract?

KATE

Yes, to produce. That's not the issue. The problem is I still haven't found the right screenplay and now I just...I have more important things to worry about.

LILY

Like dinner. With Nick.

KATE

And saving the theatre.

JIMMY

Which I think is only fair that we leave you to.

JIMMY opens the door for KATE and she starts in.

KATE (CONT'D)

Thanks for the help. Have fun...

LILY

Mmmhmm. You too.

LILY and JIMMY hand KATE the food. LILY turns to look at KATE one more time as they walk off. She smiles and mouths "call me".

18 INT. EMBASSY THEATRE - EVENING

18

*

NICK sits at his directors table with papers strewn about. He * is deep in thought.

KATE walks in, food piled high.

KATE

Delivery!

NICK looks up and sees her struggle.

NICK

Geez! Did you buy one of everything?

KATE

How dare you. No. Just multiples of everything...that I can only get here.

NICK

Your appetite hasn't changed

KATE

Not when the paparazzi aren't watching. I plan on enjoying every last bite of this.

NICK

Let me help.

*

NICK begins to help her carry everything.

KATE

I've got it.

NICK

No, I know you've got it, but let me help.

KATE

It's fine, I'm fine.

KATE in fact, was not fine. She starts to lose her balance. NICK grabs her…she holds on to some food. He got a bit, the rest hits the floor. They both laugh.

NICK

Are you ok?

KATE

That depends. Did the subs make it?

NICK

(Smiles and holds up a bag) I know what's important.

KATF

(laughs) Break 'em open. I've been craving these since...well, it never stops.

NICK clears a spot on the table and begins to clean up the food massacre.

KATE (CONT'D)

Actually. Could we have one of our Center Stage picnics? You remember those?

NICK

How could I ever forget?

KATE

Some of my favorite memories.

NICK

Mine too.

NICK and KATE grab the food and take it to the stage and hop up .

CUT TO:

19 INT. EMBASSY THEATRE - EVENING

19

NICK and KATE are on the stage with a picnic of food laid out in front of them. It's everything you would never think of a "star" eating. Fries, pizza, subs. All the junk food.

KATE

Okay, but that wasn't TOTALLY my fault. The set wasn't marked. I couldn't see it in the dark.

NICK

And you ran right into it and broke your foot.

KATE

AND kept right on going.

NICK

The show must go on.

KATE

I didn't think I was going to be able to get my shoe off, my foot was so swollen.

NICK

And you wouldn't go to the doctor until the show closed.

KATE

The only thing they would have been able to do for it was put me in a boot. There are no understudies in college!

NICK

I don't know. Adrian would have been pretty flawless as Eliza.

KATE

(feigned realization) He did it on purpose.

NICK

Nah, he knew you too well. Now Celeste on the other hand...

KATE

Celeste! Do you remember when I was cast in the role she wanted?

KATE(CONT'D) (CONT'D)

She said she wanted to push me down the stairs.

NICK

Oh, I remember. She said it long after you'd left town, too.

^

*

*

Are you serious?

NICK

Yeah, we dated for a bit.

KATE

What?!

NICK

Well..small town. It didn't last long though. I think she thought I was in love with you.

KATE

You told her we never dated, right? That we were just friends?

NICK

Best friends. And yes. But she never believed me. For the best though. She never ate fries.

KATE

Well, that's just criminal.

NICK

She's married now. They live a few towns over.

KATE

Of course.

NICK

Yeah.

They are starting to finish up their food.

KATE

(holding her stomach) Ugh...okay, I may have overdone it a bit.

NICK

You? Never.

KATE

(smiles) But I brought dessert. So...

NICK

So we brainstorm and continue.

KATE

Yes.

NICK helps her from the stage. There is a moment when she lands, they look at each other for a second too long. ELectricity. NICK leads her to the table.

*

NICK

So, what do you have to show me?

KATE

Right. Saving the theatre!

NICK

Ok Miss Warner. Dazzle me.

KATE

Oh...I didn't prepare a presentation or anything...

NICK

Katie. I'm teasing. What are you thinking?

KATE

Ok. So this last movie I did...

NICK

Dragon's Eye. Loved it. But, not as much as I *loved* Thorn Hill.

KATE

Thorn Hill!? You saw that?

NICK

Of course I saw it. I've seen everything you've ever done. Even before the world saw you as a movie star. You were always mine.

KATE

"Forever constant". (smiles) Well, with Dragon's Eye, we wanted to get people really involved...no...invested in it. So we started this campaign on Social Media. My page was used to promote interest. Everyone that followed me could see clips and teasers of behind the scenes content, scenes from the film that were cut, but, they had to subscribe to the film's fan page to see the full content.

NICK

But I'm not selling a multimillion dollar movie. Just a small town theater.

KATE

But that's so much more important than a multi-million dollar movie.

NICK

It doesn't feel like it lately.

KATE

And that is exactly what we are going to change.

 ${\tt NICK}$

Lead on MacDuff.

KATE

Cute. A Scottish play reference while sitting in the very theatre we're trying to save. Brave man.

NICK

I know.

KATE

So, we get the community involved. Jimmy is a photographer. Lily has mastered social media and done some amazing things for the Boutique. She can lead the online charge. I'll share it on every platform. I have a lot of friends who love theatre as much as we do, and maybe we can even make some new lovers of the art. We will add

KATE(CONT'D) (CONT'D)

A link to a donation page where people all over the world can donate to help. We can show everyone that this theatre was the heart of this town and can be again. Hopefully gain enough attention that we can get more butts in the seats, and more reserve in the bank. Who knows, maybe it will even become a tourist destination!

NTCK

Slow down there Macbeth.

You didn't just say that name?!

NICK

I think we've had as much bad luck as that superstition can divvy out. I'll take my chances.

KATE

Suit yourself.

NICK

We just need to get out of the red. (pause) It is intriguing, though.

KATE

High Praise. So, I think we should really focus on behind the scenes content. People that have never done what we do find it fascinating. It intrigues them. Maybe we can break it down a little and make theatre not so elitist and antiquated.

NICK

It's different, that's for sure.

KATE

So we take them backstage during rehearsals, post videos and pictures of the theater's history. Rehearsals of Adrian's retirement celebration. Anything and everything we can find that makes this place so special. Show them its heart.

NICK hasn't taken his eyes off of KATE this entire time.

NICK

You think this could work.

KATE

I think we have to try. And if my celebrity can help do some good for the places and...people...that I love the most...well, I mean, isn't that the point?

NICK

(mischievous) I think I have some very embarrassing rehearsal footage of you.

KATE

And I would be furious with you if you didn't use it.

NICK

Alright. I'm in. Let's go viral.

KATE

But...after dessert.

NICK laughs and opens the dessert for KATE. They share it. NICK looks at her adoringly.

FADES TO:

20

*

*

20 INT. KATE'S CHILDHOOD HOME - MORNING

KATE, LILY, CAROL, ADRIAN, and JIMMY are around the kitchen *table. KATE fills them in on the plan as they drink coffee *and snack on pastries.

KATE

Are you in?

ADRIAN

I have absolutely no idea how to use the social media, but yes.

KATE

You just be yourself. Let us take care of you for a change.

CAROL

That's what retirement is all about, after all.

ADRIAN

In that case, pass me another one of those delightful muffins

LILY passes ADRIAN a muffin. She moves to stand by JIMMY, who *acknowledges it and smiles.

LILY

So, when are we starting this?

Tomorrow?

LILY

Like one sleep away, tomorrow?

KATE

That's the one.

JIMMY

I can come by the theater tomorrow and grab some shots of rehearsal if that works.

KATE

I'll ask Nick.

NICK

Ask Nick what?

NICK just walks in, because it's that kind of town.

CAROL

Good morning kiddo! Coffee?

NICK

Please.

JIMMY

Is it cool with you if I stop by tomorrow to take some footage of rehearsals?

NICK

So she got to all of you too?

JIMMY

Mostly the pastries and coffee did.

NICK

The coffee trick again, huh?

KATE

I know my audience.

NICK

Mrs. W, you have that box of stuff you called me about?

KATE

Umm...what box?

NICK/CAROL

Nothing.

*

KATE

What box, Mom?

*

CAROL

Just some knick-knacks from the theater's history. Some newspaper clippings. Videos. That kind of thing.

NICK

Basically anything and everything that could potentially embarrass you that I don't have already.

ADRIAN

Perfection.

KATE

The support is uncanny.

LILY

Your idea.

KATE

(beat) My idea (smiles).

CAROL hands over the box. NICK takes out a very embarrassing picture on KATE.

NICK

Oh...now this one is going front and center.

KATE

I should have known better.

ALL

Yes/absolutely/of course you should have/etc.

NICK

I gotta get to class. See you tonight?

KATE/JIMMY

(excited) Yes.

KATE

(blushing) Oh, sorry, right.

NICK laughs at her embarrassment.

NICK

I will see you tonight.

NICK looks straight at KATE when he says this.

NICK (CONT'D)

Katie...

NICK heads out the door. EVERYONE turns to look at KATE.

LILY

Katie...(teasing)

KATE

(blushing) Come on. Let's get to work.

THEY ALL continue to pick on her as they gather around the table to talk strategy. KATE looks after NICK.

21 INT. JACOB'S OFFICE, HOLLYWOOD, CA - DAY

21

JACOB sits at his desk surrounded by work. He is frazzled.

His boss, VINCE SHRINER walks into his office. JACOB straightens himself.

VINCE

Do you have the paperwork from Kate Warner for me?

JACOB

Not yet, sir, of course, but I should have it in a few days.

VINCE

Don't you mean to say you will have it?

JACOB

Yes sir. She's out of town for an…event, and I've had trouble reaching her.

VINCE

Then call her Manager. That's what they do. (beat) You know if you can't get your own girlfriend to sign a multi-million dollar deal, I think this promotion may be too much for you as well.

JACOB

No sir. It will be handled.

VINCE

Have the signed contracts and script on my desk by Friday morning, 9am. Sharp.

Before JACOB can respond, VINCE has left the room. JACOB picks up his phone and dials KATE.

BEGIN INTERCUT

22 INT. KATE'S CHILDHOOD HOME - DAY

22

KATE and ALL work on the plan and snack. Her phone buzzes. LILY sees it.

LILY

Jacob? Kate, how many times has he called?

KATE

A few.

LILY

Don't you think you should maybe answer it? If only to ask him to stop?

KATE

Later.

KATE picks up the phone and sends JACOB to voicemail.

23 INT. JACOB'S OFFICE, HOLLYWOOD, CA

23 *

JACOB, frustrated, ends the call and tries again.

24 INT. KATE'S CHILDHOOD HOME

24 *

KATE'S phone rings again. This time she ignores it and puts it in her bag. Out of sight, out of mind.

END INTERCUT

25 INT. JACOB'S OFFICE, HOLLYWOOD, CA - MOMENTS LATER

25 *

JACOB leaves a voicemail

JACOB

Kate. Look, I get it, you're mad. I maybe didn't end things in the best way. But please, we still have to work together on this...and on many other projects, I hope. I need the signed contract and the approved script in my boss's hands by Friday morning or I lose that promotion. So. Call me. Please. You know how hard I've worked for this. We both have.

JACOB hangs up and calls to his assistant.

JACOB (CONT'D)
Hillary, I need a flight to
whatever airport is closest to a
place called Myrtle Gardens, FL
ASAP.

FADE TO:

26 INT. KATE'S CHILDHOOD BEDROOM - EVENING

26 *

KATE is getting ready to meet NICK and fussing over what to wear. CAROL walks by and notices.

CAROL

Nothing to wear?

KATE

I should have brought more with me, I guess.

CAROL

You're just heading to the theater, right? Won't loungewear do?

KATE

I just...I want to look...

CAROL

(teasingly) Nice for Nick

KATE

What? No! Nice for...working. For managing this project. This is serious. I need to be taken seriously.

CAROL

Honey, he's always taken you seriously.

KATE stops riffling through her clothes and looks at CAROL. KATE sits in her bed, looking around, like when she was 18.

KATE

Mom, why do I care all of the sudden? It's Nick! He doesn't care how I look.

CAROL

No he doesn't. He cares about how you feel. About what you think. About what you need. He cares about YOU. And you care about him.

KATE

Of course, I do. He's been my best friend forever.

CAROL

Oh sweetheart. Do you really think that's all it is?

KATE looks at CAROL confused.

CAROL (CONT'D)

I mean, it might be worth looking at through a different lens. From a new angle. Is there anyone else who knows you better? Anyone else you have more in common with?

KATE

That may have been the case years ago, but we have grown so far apart over the years.

CAROL

Have you? Have you really?

KATE

I didn't even visit when his mom passed.

CAROL

Kate, you have to stop beating yourself up about that. Nick understood. We talked about it.

You and Nick?

CAROL

Yes. I still volunteer at the theater. I still live here. And Nick still comes over for all major holidays. Honestly, even more so after his mom passed.

CAROL sits next to her daughter.

CAROL (CONT'D)

Honey, when I met your father, I had no interest in him...romantically. I was seeing two other suitors at the time...

KATE

Mom!

CAROL

It was the 70s. And your father just felt too safe. I wanted excitement. I wanted to get out of here. So I kept my options open for someone that could make that happen.

KATE

You never told me that.

CAROL

Oh Kate, you aren't the only small town girl who had big dreams. Mine just changed. I fell in love with teaching art at the elementary school, and...I fell in love with your father. I guess I realized that that safe feeling wasn't safety. It was...well, he was, my home. Then we had you, and we became this beautiful family, and that became my new dream.

KATE

I love you so much, Mom.

CAROL

I love you too. And sweetheart, I know your career has been your all consuming priority, but you don't have to keep running away from love.

I'm not. I just have a *very* bad habit of picking the *very* wrong guy.

CAROL

Or a very good habit of choosing gentlemen that keep you at an arms length so you don't get too attached.

*

*

KATE looks at her mother. CAROL shrugs.

CAROL (CONT'D)

Like mother like daughter. But that all stopped for me when I met your dad. That feeling of safety. That comfort. That love. When you lean into it...it's more magical than any movie.

KATE

I just never really thought much about it. I just told myself that my career was more important. What if I find the one and then something happens…like with Dad.

*

CAROL

Honey. Even if I had known we weren't going to have our whole lives together, I wouldn't have given up one moment of it. What I had with your father...it was all worth it.

KATE

It was?

CAROL

It was.

KATE

Thanks mom.

CAROL walks to the door. KATE calls out.

KATE (CONT'D)

Mom?

CAROL

Yes hun?

What do I wear?

CAROL laughs, as does KATE and they hug. Then they start going through clothes together.

*

*

FADE TO:

- 27 EXT. EMBASSY THEATRE EVENING 27 KATE walks up to the door to the theater. She takes a breath * and opens the door. *
- INT. EMBASSY THEATRE MOMENTS LATER 28 * KATE walks into the auditorium. JIMMY is already there with NICK taking photos. LILY is off to the side going through the old box of memorabilia from CAROL.

KATE tries to close the door quietly so as not to interrupt, but is not successful NICK turns and smiles at her.

Before he can say anything LILY is on her feet running to greet her.

LILY

Oh my gosh, you HAVE to see these photos. And programs. Ooooo, and costume designs from when the theatre was founded. It's so cool.

KATE

(laughing) Lead the way.

LILY drags KATE to her corner. NICK and KATE smile at each other across the room. KATE pulls out a video from the box.

KATE(CONT'D) (CONT'D)

What's this? B and B Sophomore

Year?

NICK hears this and runs across the room to snatch it from her.

NICK

Nothing!

KATE

Nothing?

NTCK

Nothing.

KATE and NICK look at each other. KATE is studying him. JIMMY looks at them both.

*

JIMMY

Okay. I think I have all I need of the empty theater. Now, we just need shots of the rehearsal.

NICK

Ugh, yeah. Everyone should start filing in...in about 15 minutes.

JIMMY

Anyone want a coffee? I could use a little jolt.

NICK

Sure, that would be great.

KATE

Yeah, thanks Jimmy.

LILY

Um, I'd love one. But I have a complicated order, so...I'll just walk with you. You'll need an extra set of hands to carry them back anyway.

JIMMY smiles. KATE nudges LILY. LILY mouths "Stop" and heads off with JIMMY.

KATE hops off the stage and crosses to NICK and they watch them go.

KATE

(teasing) Have fun.

LILY

(right back) You too.

NICK and KATE look at each other.

NICK

Help me put the rehearsal space together?

KATE

I thought you'd never ask.

KATE and NICK start moving set pieces and costumes. NICK looks at KATE. She doesn't see. KATE looks at NICK, but he misses it.

CUT TO:

29 EXT. MAIN STREET - EVENING

NICK (CONT'D)

Mastermind behind this whole social promotion thing...

KATE

I really think it's gonna work, Nick.

NICK

I hope you're right

KATE

Aren't I always?

They laugh as KATE sees something on the desk that catches her eye. A screenplay. Forever Constant, written by NICK KRUGER.

KATE (CONT'D)

Is this a new one?

NICK

Yeah.

NICK gets to the screenplay before her and tucks it away.

NICK (CONT'D)

So new that it's in desperate need of polishing.

KATE

I'd love to read it. I'm trying to find a new screenplay to produce.

NICK

I may have heard that somewhere.

KATE

Mom?

NICK

And Adrian. He's so proud of you. (beat). So am I.

*

KATE looks at Nick for a long moment. There is a moment of electricity. Then -

*

JIMMY and LILY burst into the room, laughing, with coffee, and still holding hands. KATE notices and gives LILY a look. LILY, confident in her choice, smiles back.

*

KATE

So...the screenplay?

NICK

Rehearsal first.

KATE

Fair enough.

Behind JIMMY and LILY, the CAST enters. They file in loudly and exuberantly.

JIMMY

Here ya go.

KATE

Thanks, Jimmy. So, are we ready for this.

NICK

As ready as we will ever be.

The team gathers around the table as the cast files in. NICK tries to quiet them the cast.

NICK (CONT'D)

Ok everyone. Let's start to get focused and then let's get rolling...(beat) Cast...please...

They see KATE walk out from behind NICK and they start to simmer down.

NICK looks to her and smiles. She smiles back.

NICK (CONT'D)

Well, I guess the surprise is ruined.

KATE

Sorry.

*

NICK

It's just as well. You've been the talk of rehearsals all week.

KATE

(to the cast) All good I hope.

NICK

So, we also have another surprise for you. Kate has offered to help get the word out about the Theatre. It's a small town, so I know you all heard that the council meeting didn't go as we'd hoped. So now we are looking for other ways to save this place. Kate, do you wanna explain?

KATE

Sure. Hey, first, thank you for letting me crash your rehearsal. Um, so, we are working on some behind the scenes stuff to celebrate the impact The Embassy has had, and continues to have on this community. With your blessing, we would love for all of you to be a part of it.

The cast is excited. Yeses, and woots all around. NICK is watching her intensely.

KATE(CONT'D) (CONT'D) Lily and Jimmy will be helping. And I'm sure you will see my mom and ADRIAN around too.

NICK

Actually, I barred ADRIAN from rehearsals so he would be surprised.

KATE

Good idea! Thank you. So, not Adrian, but myself, Lily and Jimmy for sure. We will be doing pics, videos, interviews. And if you can think of anything else we may have missed, please, let us know.

KELSIE (CAST MEMBER)

Um...Miss Warner

Kate. Please

KELSIE (CAST MEMBER)

Ok. Kate. Um...are you going to be performing?

KATE

No..no, no, no, ...this is Nick's show. I'm just going to be behind the scenes trying to get the word out.

KELSIE (CAST MEMBER)

(so nervous) It's just...

KATE

It's okay. What is it ...

KATE looks at NICK for the answer.

NICK

(softly) Kelcie.

KATE

Kelcie. Go ahead.

KELSIE (CAST MEMBER)

If we want to be noticed we should do everything we can to get attention, right?

KATE

I...uh

KATE looks to NICK for the answer again.

NICK

Thank you, Kelsie. We will think about it.

KATE

So, Lily here is going to start getting you all into costumes and Jimmy will be taking some fantastic photos of you in those costumes...We will start there, and then...

NICK

(jumping in) ...and then we will get this rehearsal started. Let's go.

NICK claps his hands and everyone gets to it.

31 INT. EMBASSY THEATER - MONTAGE

31

Montage of cast trying on costumes, rehearsing. JIMMY and LILY return with coffees in hand. They are styling and taking pics. NICK and KATE are smiling and having a blast.

CUT TO:

32 EXT. MAIN STREET - NIGHT

32

We see a *very* nice car drive up. It parks along the street, near the coffee shop. JACOB emerges from the car, suit and all. He looks around for a moment. He spies the theater and heads that way.

CUT TO:

33 INT. EMBASSY THEATER - NIGHT

33

KATE, JACOB, LILY and JIMMY are still working with the cast. KATE sneaks away to the table and looks for NICK'S script while he is preoccupied. She pulls it out and starts to call for NICK when the door of the auditorium swings open.

JACOB

Kate! There you are. I've been calling you.

*

EVERYONE turns around to see JACOB at the door. LILY knows immediately who it is and heads to KATE'S side.

LILY

I told you that you should have answered him.

KATE

Not. Helpful.

LILY

But accurate.

KATE glares at LILY. JACOB walks up to KATE. NICK sees this and heads toward KATE.

JACOB

Kate, I really need to speak with you.

NICK

Hi, sorry, but who are you?

JACOB

(extends hand to NICK) Jacob Miller. I'm with Kate.

NICK

Oh?

KATE

(flustered) Um...Nick, (to the cast) everyone, I'm so sorry. Will you excuse me for a minute?

NICK

Whatever you need...

KATE

Jacob?

KATE gestures to JACOB and they start to the door that leads to the lobby. She grabs her bag and places the screenplay inside for safekeeping. JIMMY and LILY cross to NICK.

LILY

Wow, what a way to ruin a mood.

JIMMY

You said it. (to NICK) You okay?

NICK

I'm fine. Why wouldn't I be? Let's get back to work.

They head back to the cast.

CUT TO:

34

34 INT. EMBASSY THEATER LOBBY - NIGHT

KATE leads JACOB into the lobby, out of the way, out of ear shot.

KATE

What are you doing here?

JACOB

I came to see you. I called, I texted, you didn't answer.

KATE

Jacob. You broke up with me.
Poorly. Publicly. You never once,
in the 2 years we were together
(MORE)

KATE (CONT'D)

wanted to come to Myrtle Gardens with me, so why are you here now?

JACOB

Kate, my boss came to see me today about the contract. The screenplay. You have to move on this. It's not just your reputation on the line. It's mine too. I could lose my promotion. They could pull you as producer.

KATE

I just haven't had time to find the right script.

JACOB

But you have time to play in this theatre?

KATE

Jacob, come on. That's not fair and you know it. You know how much this place means to me.

JACOB

And you know how much advancing my career means to me, and I thought it meant something to you too. Why isn't this more important to you?

KATE

It is. It's very important, Jacob. That's why I haven't made a decision, yet. It has to be right. I may not get another chance.

JACOB

Look. I know things didn't end very well with us, and that's on me. Truly. But I still want what's best for you. Becoming a producer is a big deal. And we both worked hard to get you this opportunity. It could be the first of many new things to come.

KATE

I know Jacob. I'm sorry. I'm just...I'm working on it. I really am.

*

JACOB

If you could work on it a bit faster, that would be great. I have to have it to my boss on first thing Friday.

KATE

Friday?! That's in two days.
That's Adrian's Retirement Gala.

JACOB

Yeah. That's why I kept calling, That's why I am here. We've had months to do this, but the clock is up. It has to be on his desk by 9am. Sharp.

KATE

(trying to lighten the mood)
Well...at least with the time
difference I have three extra
hours. (Beat) OK. Look, I will get
you a script and my contract in
time. I promise.

JACOB

I'd like to look it over before I go.

KATE

So you're staying? Here? (beat) That's fair, I guess. Alright. I have a line on a script that I think may be perfect. How's tomorrow morning? We can meet at the coffee shop.

JACOB

Okay. (beat) And Kate. Thank you. I mean it. I know I may have come off overbearing or unappreciative. But this is good. Very good. For both of us.

KATE

Thank you. And I know you helped make all this happen for me.

JACOB

I just got you in the door. You did the rest. You're so much more than a phenomenal actor. People see that. Now they will see even (MORE)

JACOB (CONT'D)

more. I'll meet you tomorrow
morning.

KATE

See you then.

JACOB begins to walk out. Then turns back.

JACOB

Is there a hotel...or...

KATE

Yes Jacob, Myrtle Gardens has a hotel. Two blocks that way. (she points)

JACOB nods and leaves. KATE takes a breath, preparing, and heads back in the theater.

LILY meets her as soon as she reenters.

LILY

Well, that was dramatic. Are you okay?

KATE

I'm fine.

LILY

Actually fine, or fine like you don't want to talk about it fine?

KATE

The second one.

LILY

But you should talk about it. And I'm here for you.

KATE

(beat, then blurts it out) I have to have the signed contract and a final script to Jacob...or...well his boss Friday by 9am or the movie won't happen at all. Jacob will lose his promotion and I'll lose my only chance to be a producer.

LILY

Wow. Definitely not actually fine.

KATE

KATE (CONT'D)

yet. I just have a really good feeling about it.

LILY

Well what are you doing here then? Go! We'll be fine without you for a while. Go read, and edit, and drink wine or whatever you producers-types do.

KATE

I need to at least tell Nick, or ask him about...

LILY

Whatever it is, sorry, but it can wait. Just go. I'll let him know you had to leave. He'll understand.

KATE

You can be very demanding...and persuasive.

LILY

It's why you love me. Go.

KATE tries to protest one more time but LILY shoos her out the door. She turns to the cast and crew.

LILY (CONT'D)

Kate had to go. She'll be back tomorrow.

NICK looks after Kate for a moment. Then back to work.

FADE TO:

35 INT. KATE'S CHILDHOOD BEDROOM - NIGHT

KATE is on her bed, computer open next to her and NICK'S screenplay is spread out around her. CAROL arrives in the door with a cup of tea and knocks softly.

CAROL

Hey sweetheart. I thought you might like some tea.

KATE

Thanks Mom. That sounds great. (she takes a sip) Mmmmm. I can never make tea the way you do. Cinnamon and nutmeg...and love.

CAROL

I didn't hear you come in. What are you working on?

KATE

Sorry. I got home and came straight up here. (beat) Jacob showed up at the theatre today.

CAROL

Oh. That's ... unexpected.

KATE

Not completely. I wasn't answering his calls...or texts. I just didn't want to face him, you know.

CAROL

You're still hurting, sweetie.

KATE

Not as much as I expected. Which is partly why I didn't answer. I felt like I owed it to him to be more upset or something. But he was right to break things off. Maybe he didn't do it in the best way, but we weren't a good fit.

CAROL

Hm. Well, then, why is he here?

KATE

His boss needs my signed contract and screenplay selection by Friday morning. And I haven't had luck finding a screenplay that's just right.

CAROL sees NICK'S name on the screenplay.

CAROL

What about this one?

KATE

This is the one I have a good feeling about, but I haven't read it. Yet.

CAROL

Why not?

*

KATE

Because today, when I found it, Nick kind of, took it back from me. It didn't seem like he wanted me to read it.

CAROL

So why do you have it?

KATE

I...took it.

CAROL

Kate!

KATE

For not being the person he thought I was.

KATE is asleep in a very awkward position in top of her bedding. She fell asleep working. She wakes up with a start * and looks at the clock. She has to get to the coffee shop to meet JACOB. She grabs her bag and picks up NICK'S script. She * smiles and puts it in her bag.

She checks her phone. Still nothing.

CUT TO:

37

CUT TO:

NICK is there, bright and early, working on the set. Music is loud, so is the hammering. He doesn't hear his phone. He looks at it to see he missed a call from KATE. He ignores it.

He takes he coffee mug for a drink. Empty. He heads out for more.

CUT TO:

39 INT. COFFEE SHOP - MORNING

39

JACOB and KATE are seated at a table by the window. They chat and laugh together. NICK approaches the coffee shop and sees them in the window. He stops and frowns. He heads back to the theater.

Inside, the camera moves in to see JACOB and KATE discussing the screenplay.

This is good, Kate. This is really, really good. Brilliant, even.

KATE

I'm so glad you think so too. This is what I was looking for.

JACOB

Who wrote it? Someone we've already worked with, I'm sure.

KATE

Actually, it's an unknown.

JACOB

That could be risky, Kate.

KATE

Well, I wasn't finding what I needed anywhere else. They were all missing something. Heart, I guess. Substance?

JACOB

Well, whatever was missing, I think you found it with...(looks at the cover page for the name) Nick Kruger. Wait. Didn't you know a Nick Kruger.

KATE

I know Nick Kruger. You just met Nick Kruger. He's my best friend from school. He runs the Embassy and teaches at the college now.

JACOB

Screenwriting?

KATE

Yep. Among other things.

JACOB

Well, if he has more scripts like this, there might be a career change in his future. (beat) I'm, flying out in a few hours. I will get you his contract by this evening. Get it signed along with yours and back to me by tomorrow morning.

KATE

Um...yeah, okay. I will. Thank you.

JACOB

Kate, you were right to be selective. *This* is the one. Congratulations. I think you and Nick will do great things together

KATE

Thanks, Jacob. And congrats to you too. I think we'll still make a pretty good team. Talk soon.

JACOB packs up and leaves quickly. KATE checks her phone again. Nothing. She packs up her things and sits for a bit, sipping her coffee.

CUT TO:

40 EXT. EMBASSY THEATER - LATER MORNING

40 *

KATE arrives at the theater, bag on shoulder and two coffee cups in hand.

She enters, walks through the lobby and into the auditorium.

She sees NICK sitting at the table, no lights are on. NICK is watching a video on the projector. KATE walks in.

KATE

Burning the midnight oil?

NICK quickly turns off the video.

NICK

I don't think that works when it's actual working hours.

KATE

Well, I brought you coffee anyway.

NICK

From Main Street?

KATE

Is there anywhere else?

NICK

Your Mom's is better.

KATE

My Mom's *is* better. But I was already at the café, so...

NICK

I saw.

KATE

Were you there? I didn't see you.

NICK

Just walking by. I was going to the college to cancel the morning's class. I'm bartering that for their help with the final touches on the show. KATE

Why didn't you come in and say hi?

NICK

You looked ... engaged. Busy.

KATE

I would have officially introduced you to you Jacob.

NICK

It's fine. We met.

KATE

No, it's kind of a big deal.
That's why I got here early! I
wanted to tell you that he and I...

Just then, the doors to the auditorium fly open and NICK'S boisterous, excited students flood in.

COLIN

Mr.. K! We are here to be your groundlings!

MEREDITH

That's not what we are. That's a totally different thing. Do you even pay attention in class?

NICK

Sorry, *Kate*. We will pick this up later.

KATE

(to herself) Kate? (to NICK, disappointed) Yeah later. Okay.

NICK

Would you mind getting the lights for me?

KATE goes to the light board and turns on the lights. NICK takes his place at the front of the stage.

NICK (CONT'D)

I'm very glad to see I was able to bribe you all with pizza and a day off from class in exchange for your help.

COLIN

No pineapple on mine and you got a deal, Mr. K.

No pineapple Colin, you got it. As you all know, I've been a little busy planning ADRIAN's retirement celebration and trying to keep this theater running. And, turns out, I just can't do it all by myself.

MEREDITH

We're here for you Mr. K!

NICK

I know you are, and I appreciate it. We have the cast in place, we just need some help backstage and front of house. Who can I count on?

EVERYONE enthusiastically raises their hands.

ALL

Yes, Heck yes, You got it, etc.

NICK

That's what I like to hear.
Alright...Tom, Adam - you two are on running crew, you'll move set pieces and curtains. Jenna, Elise, and David - you are on costumes.
Craig - props. Jessica and Jamal - I need you to run front of house - so tickets, programs, concessions.
Kate's mom, Carol will be heading all of that up, so I 'll let her know you'll be in her charge.

COLIN

Hey. Miss Kate. My girl is in the cast and I heard you might perform? You know, that would get butts in the seats for sure.

KATE

I actually do have a little something planned.

NICK looks at her inquisitively.

COLIN

Score!

Colin, you are going to run lights and sound

COLIN

YES! My dream!

NICK

I appreciate your enthusiasm. And Meredith, you are going to be our stage manager.

MEREDITH

Really?! Thank you, Mr. K.

NICK

I trust you'll do a great job. You all will. But today, we have some prep work to do. Set painting, hanging lights, getting costumes organized. Can you all handle that?

ALL

Yep, absolutely, you got it, etc.

NICK

Then let's get to it. To the stage!

ALL

To the stage!

The class heads to the stage and begins dividing and conquering. KATE approaches NICK.

KATE

You really are a stellar teacher. Just like Dr. D. Remember when we started that Stage Combat Club? Dr. D was thrilled. I think he had as much fun as we did. We loved theatre so much...just every bit of it.

NICK

I still do. It's not Hollywood, but I'm content.

KATE

So do I. Still love theatre, I mean.

Do you?

KATE

I'm here, aren't I?

NICK

You are. For now.

KATE

Ouch.

NICK

I'm sorry, that was harsh.

KATE

No, it's okay. That's fair. You have reason. (beat) Nick, are you really happy here?

NICK

I think being content most days is a pretty great life.

KATE

Yes, but happy. What would make you happy?

NICK looks at her for a long moment.

NICK

I am happy.

KATE

You said content. There's a difference.

NICK

Are you happy Kate?

KATE

Mostly. (beat) I think I rediscovered a few things about myself these last few days that might just make me completely happy. But you, Nick. Don't you miss writing?

NICK

No, not really. I mean I get to teach it, so...

*

KATE

It was your *life* when we were younger. You were always writing something.

NICK

I lost my inspiration... (he means her)

KATE

Did you?

KATE pulls his screenplay out of her bag.

NICK

Where did you get that?

NICK heads to his table and searches through papers.

NICK (CONT'D)

Did you just take it?

KATE

No...and yes. I mean I picked it up yesterday and wanted to talk to you about...

NICK

I asked you not too...

KATE

...I know, but Nick ...

NICK

I asked you not to, and you took it anyway?

KATE

To help. Listen. Please. I tried to talk to you about it, like 3 times, But Lily pushed me out of the theatre yesterday and today the kids...

NICK

I guess you're used to just taking whatever you want.

KATE

KATE (CONT'D)

script. A great one. A perfect one. And this is phenomenal.

NICK

So to you I'm just a means to an end, Kate?

KATE looks at him, not knowing what to say.

NICK (CONT'D)

I have work to do. Thanks for the coffee.

KATE takes a breath and begins to leave. But she turns back.

KATE hurriedly exits the theatre. ADRIAN comes in the doors.

ADRIAN

My sweet girl. What ever is the matter?

KATE

I was just trying to help.

ADRIAN

Ah. Lover's quarrel?

KATE

What are you...no. Nick and I just had a fight.

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ADRIAN

Yes my dear, that's what I said.

KATE looks at him bewildered.

ADRIAN (CONT'D)

Come with me. Tell me all about it.

ADRIAN leads her to his office. It is *full* of memories. Programs, pictures, of ADRIAN on Broadway, of he and KATE, of KATE and NICK. Her whole life in that little room.

ADRIAN (CONT'D)

Sit down. You want some coffee? Tea?

KATE

Thanks. I'm good

ADRIAN

Alright, but I'm making one for myself. It's no trouble.

KATE

Ok, then, thanks. (long sigh) It just got too messy, Adrian. I came back to help. To see you, Mom, and Lily, to celebrate, to support. Do whatever was needed, you know?

ADRIAN

And maybe to run away and hide a little?

KATE

It's infuriating how well you know me. Yeah. Maybe. A little. But not because of Jacob. I told Mom, I was actually more upset about the fact that I wasn't that upset about the breakup.

ADRIAN

Oh darling, been there.

ADRIAN sits down in his chair with his tea and hands KATE hers.

KATE

I want to do something more, you know? I did it. I made it happen. I made every goal I set for myself a reality. And now, I just want to (MORE)

KATE (CONT'D)

do whatever I can to make it happen for the people I love.

ADRIAN

That sounds like you. My Beatrice.

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KATE

And that is why choosing the right screenplay was so important. I wanted it to be written by someone that needed a shot. Someone who needed a break. Someone like I used to be. Then, I wanted to do the same thing with the theater. For Nick. He's worked so hard, and then his mom...he deserved...no, deserves that chance.

ADRIAN

You read his script, didn't you?

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KATE

I did. Have you read it?

ADRIAN

No. I'm surprised he shared it with you. He's become so guarded about his work.

KATE

He...he didn't exactly share it.

ADRIAN

(beat) Ooohhhh. Well, this just got very interesting. Spill.

KATE

It was just a miscommunication...it's not that dramatic.

ADRIAN

Disappointing (he winks at her) But continue.

KATE

I saw the script and wanted to talk to him about it before I read it...I had it in my hands when Jacob showed up, out of nowhere.

ADRIAN

Your ex big wig movie exec?

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KATE

Yes, That's the one.

ADRIAN

No wonder Nick has been so upset.

KATE

He's upset because I read his screenplay without asking.

ADRIAN

When did he learn you absconded his screenplay? Because he's been brooding since yesterday.

KATE

Just now.

ADRIAN

Ah...alright then. He's saying he's upset because you read his screenplay without asking. (beat) He's actually upset because of Jacob.

KATE is very confused.

ADRIAN(CONT'D) (CONT'D) Months ago, when your Mom informed us all of the new leading man in your life, Nick was devastated.

KATE rolls her eyes.

KATE

Adrian. Devastated?

ADRIAN

Devastated. (beat) I've never known a time when Nick didn't love you. And I am very observant.

KATE

And I love him. He's my best friend...

ADRIAN

Sweet girl, you know what I mean. I think he just always felt the two of you would end up together. That somehow, he would make it to LA, or, after he moved back here, you would come home too. And when

(MORE)

ADRIAN (CONT'D)

you showed up for this, in his mind, it was finally happening.

KATE

My mom said the same thing. So did Lily...I just...he's NICK

ADRIAN

I know. You know you have always been exceedingly blind when it comes to things like this in your own life. Love is indeed blind, is it not?

KATE give him a look, but she knows he's right.

KATE

Why didn't he tell me? Why didn't you tell me?

ADRIAN

It is not my job, my dear, to sort out your love life. I can help you in many ways, but not all of them.

KATE

Since when? You'll put your nose everywhere else.

ADRIAN

Correct. But your romantic liaisons are the one place my nose does not belong. Affairs of the heart (a la The King and I) et cetera, et cetera...

KATE

(chiming in) Et Cetera. (laughs in spite of herself) Ugh. What am I going to do, Adrian? This...this is a lot of information to process.

ADRIAN

Process? Sweet girl, this may be the one time in your life when having total dominion over your emotions will not serve you. Don't analyze. Don't edit. Don't rehearse. Feel.

KATE

I'm not very good at that. Feeling my own feelings.

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ADRIAN * Yes. Good thing you love a challenge. KATE Good thing. (beat) I wouldn't have * ignored him if I'd known. I would have told him (Beat) that he's my best friend. ADRIAN * He's never held it against you. (beat) Now, on a lighter subject. What are you preparing for my grand exit from the theatre. KATE looks at him. She gets up to go. KATE You'll just have to wait and see. And it will be worth the wait. I promise. ADRIAN Well then. Break a leq. KATE All of them. KATE smiles and rushes out. CUT TO: 42 * INT. KATE'S CHILDHOOD HOME - EARLY AFTERNOON KATE rushes in the door. CAROL is in the kitchen. * KATE Mom, can you make me some of that magic tea and maybe some blueffles? I have work to do. CAROL Uh...yes. Everything alright? KATE is up the stairs. From upstairs she responds. KATE (VO)

CAROL laughs at her daughter lovingly and starts making tea and her famous blue-ffles.

Everything is perfect. Love you.

43 INT. KATE'S CHILDHOOD BEDROOM - EARLY AFTERNOON

43 *

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KATE is intensely working on something. Papers are strewn about. She picks up her phone and texts LILY

KATE (VIA TEXT)

Hey, do you know when Nick will be away from the theatre today?

LILY (VIA TEXT)

I think he teaches at the college from 4-6. Why?

KATE (VIA TEXT)

Perfect. Meet me at the theater at 4 then. Bring Jimmy and his camera. I have something I need your help with.

LILY (VIA TEXT)

You got it.

KATE goes back to work.

44 INT. BOUTIQUE - EARLY AFTERNOON

44 *

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LILY stands behind the counter at the Boutique. She puts down her phone after her text conversation with KATE. JIMMYtakes pics of the displays and such in the shop.

LILY

So, you don't mind if we move our date this evening, right?

JIMMY

What are we doing?

LILY

Helping Kate with something at the theater.

JIMMY

Alright, but I have one condition.

LILY

Oh. Demands. I see.

JIMMY

Show her the dress you designed for her.

LILY

Jimmy, she's too busy with every...

JIMMY

That's my condition. Or else you won't get these magic photo skills.

LILY

What if she doesn't like it? I don't want her to just humor me.

JIMMY

She's your best friend. Do you really think she would do that?

LILY

Yes.

JIMMY looks at her.

LILY(CONT'D) (CONT'D)

No.

JIMMY

Good. What time?

LILY

Four.

JIMMY

You got it. I'll pick us all something up at the diner.

LILY

Hey. (beat) Thank you. For being so great.

LILY comes around the counter and gives JIMMY a small kiss on the cheek.

JIMMY

As long as that's my payment, I'll take pictures for you for the rest of my life.

They smile at each other.

CUT TO EMBASSY THEATER:

45

45 INT. EMBASSY THEATER - AFTERNOON

NICK is working with MEREDITH and COLIN. The rest of the students are file out. ADRIAN walks in.

So, Meredith calls go, and that's when you hit this button. Teamwork is key.

COLIN

No prob Mr. K. Hey, are we still having screenwriting class today?

NICK

Yeah. I'll see you both over there. You have just enough time to grab a snack first.

MEREDITH

Cool. See you Mr. K.

NICK

See you very soon.

ADRIAN walks up admiring the work

NICK (CONT'D)

Well, what do you think? I have been trying to keep it secret to surprise you, but I knew you'd sneak in here somehow.

ADRIAN

Guilty. (beat) Nick, this is stunning.

NICK

The students worked very hard today. I think we are all set for tomorrow.

ADRIAN

Nick, you worked very hard. You may have had some help in the implementation, but this is all you.

NICK, shrugs and smiles modestly.

ADRIAN (CONT'D)

I am so grateful to have you to take over. My legacy is now yours.

NICK takes this in for a moment.

NICK

Thank you, ADRIAN. You have no idea what that means to me.

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ADRIAN

I think I do. Because I know what all of this means to me.

ADRIAN gives NICK a very fatherly pat on the shoulder and heads back to his office.

ADRIAN (CONT'D)

Off to clean out the ole' office space to make some room for you, my protégé. You better get to your class.

NICK

(looks at his watch) Oh, you're right! See you later.

NICK grabs his stuff and heads out the door.

46 EXT. EMBASSY THEATER - AFTERNOON

NICK rushes out the door and literally runs into LILY and JIMMY. This frazzles LILY.

NICK

Oh. I am so sorry. You ok?

LILY

Yeah I'm good. Where's the fire?

NICK

Running a little late for class. You two here working on the campaign?

LILY

Uh huh. Yes. Absolutely we are.

JIMMY

(Jumping in to save her) Sorry, we should have texted first.

NTCK

That's fine. We're a team. Just lock up if I'm not here when you leave. (beat) Is Kate coming?

LILY

I haven't heard from her today.

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46 *

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Oh. Alright. I'll see you both later then?

JIMMY

See you later.

LILY

Bye. (he leaves) That was close.

JIMMY

You're a horrible liar.

LILY

I take that as a compliment.

JIMMY

A compliment?

LILY

Sure. Now you know "I cannot tell a lie"...to you.

They smile at each other and then start inside. KATE rushes up to them.

LILY (CONT'D)

Hey. You just missed Nick.

KATE

I know. I was hiding around the corner.

JIMMY

What have I gotten myself into?

KATE

(laughs) Come on. We have work to do.

The camera follows them through the lobby.

LILY

So, what exactly are we doing?

KATE

Let's just get set up and I will explain everything.

They walk into the auditorium and they all stop in their tracks. The set, the lights, everything is stunning.

KATE (CONT'D)

Oh..Oh wow.

LILY

You said it.

JIMMY

I haven't been in many theaters in my life, but this is the most beautiful set up I have ever seen.

JIMMY walks off in awe to take photos.

LILY

Okay, spill. Why all the secrecy?

KATE

I have a little something planned. For Adrians's retirement.

LILY

I am so glad you decided to step back on that stage where you belong.

KATE

(smiles - then) It's not just for Adrian. It's for Nick too. He's pretty upset with me.

LILY

Why?

KATE

Remember that screenplay I told you I found? It's Nick's and it's unbelievable. This is the one I've been looking for. I gave it to Jacob and we want to produce it.

LILY

But that is amazing news. Why would Nick be upset? Because you didn't ask him first?

KATE

No, apparently, Jacob is the issue.

LILY

Oh, right. Because Jacob showed up and Nick is in love with you.

KATE

Does everyone think this except me?

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JIMMY continues taking photos as he chimes in with LILY

LILY/JIMMY

Yes.

KATE

Great. Wonderful. Well, I am hoping to fix this.

LILY

You're going to tell him how you feel?! That you have loved him since college, but were too blind to know?!

KATE

Does everyone think that too?

LILY/JIMMY

Yes.

KATE

(Beat) Actually, I was going to I want to perform something from his screenplay. I want to make a huge promotional push on my social media about it. Normally my team takes care of my PR, but I thought no one knows me better than you. (beat) Will you help me or not?

LILY glances at JIMMY. He nods at her to go on - then a beat).

LILY (CONT.)

Yes. On one condition. I need to ask you something.

KATE

Anything.

LILY

What do you plan on wearing to the big event?

KATE

(suddenly horrified) Oh my goodness. I absolutely didn't even think of that. I have nothing with me that will work!

LILY

Well, I might be able to help with that too. (beat to gather her courage) I designed something for you. But I need you to try it on so I can alter it.

LILY takes out a sketch pad from her bag and shows KATE.

KATE

(overwhelmed with pride) Oh Lily. This is extraordinary. You designed this for me? It's a masterpiece. I would be absolutely honored to wear it.

LILY

Really? You're not just saying that to humor me?

KATE

No! Lily, you know I've always thought you were extremely talented. But this...this is beyond. I will wear a Lily Monet original any and every time I get the chance.

LILY

I'll grab it. It's in the dressing room. I can alter it, you can rehearse, and Jimmy can document it all. Then we will post everything tonight...blocking Nick from seeing it, of course. Oh, and the donation page is up and running! All of the things are happening.

KATE

Let's get to work.

47 INT. EMBASSY THEATER - AFTERNOON

47

MONTAGE OF BEHIND THE SCENES

KATE tries on LILY's dress. They stand on stage as LILY alters it. JIMMY is photographing and KATE is running her lines.

The camera shows the dressing rooms, the costume racks and props waiting to be used. The posts on social media, the pictures, the live videos, all gathering people to the

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theater and donation page. KATE, LILY and JIMMY laugh, as they continue to create.

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Cut away to posts and emails going out to everyone about what is happening with the Theatre. Live updates online from KATE talking about the donation page and the theatre. Showing her fans around the place she grew up.

LILY pushes play on the video that NICK had in the projector and an old home video pops up. The one from earlier labeled "B and B Sophomore Year" and it plays in the background of KATE'S Live video.

KATE stops what she's doing and watches. The camera pans from KATE to the video on the projector screen.

KATE

Is that?

LILY

It said "B and B Sophomore Year"

The video is of her onstage in the spotlight as Beatrice in *Much Ado*, Act 3, Scene 1 - when Beatrice confesses her love to Benedick. It is shot from the wings. A voice behind the camera speaks. NICK.

V.O. ON VIDEO (NICK)
My love for you...as constant as the

The ADRIAN's voice, loud and clear

northern star ...

ADRIAN (V.O.)

My boy. You're on!

ADRIAN rushes toward the camera. A jostling happens as the camera is transferred. NICK comes out from behind the camera and rushes onstage.

NICK

(as Benedick) Lady Beatrice, have you wept all this while?

ADRIAN fumbles with the camera and drops it. The camera stops.

KATE is shocked. LILY is shocked. Even JIMMY has looked up from his camera. There are hearts and lovey-dovey comments all over KATE's live feed, as she lowers her phone and stops the live stream.

LILY I'm not one to say I told you so, butwe all told you so.	,			
KATE He always said that to me. "As constant as the northern star." I started saying it back. It was our thingI never understood. (beat) I really am oblivious. Forever Constant. His screenplay. It'sit's me (beat) It's us.				
LILY walks to her friend.	•			
LILY Now that you see what we have all been seeing for years

KATE (CONT'D)

* can. KATE stops and looks up at LILY. * KATE (CONT'D) I'm taking this chance. What if he doesn't return the sentiment? LILY/JIMMY * He will. KATE Well, if not, the whole world is * going to witness my heart ache. So. There's that. Yay. LILY Kate. He will. LILY gives KATE a big hug. KATE Okay, I can't think about it or I will chicken out. So. Big gesture. Action. A beat. Then, JIMMY crosses to them. JIMMY Hey Lily, I'm going to need some * help editing to get all this done in time, can you come with me? LILY Uh...yeah. Kate. You gonna be ok? KATE (focused) Uh huh. Fine. Just processing. Creating. LILY and JIMMY start to leave. KATE (CONT'D)

Can you get the lights?

LILY hits the lights and they go out. Just before the go out we see KATE take her place Center Stage. Then, the lights go out. All that illuminates is the ghost light and we see KATE from the back looking out to the empty theatre, like when she first arrived.

48 INT. EMBASSY THEATER - THE NEXT EVENING (FRIDAY) 48 *

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KATE fades out on the stage as people begin to fill the seats. The Retirement Gala.

The Audience is excited. The whole town is in attendance, but there are new faces too. Everyone is dressed to the nine's. The press files in. TV cameras.

NICK stands in the back of the theatre, exactly where KATE'S dad used to, as it fills. CAROL walks in. She is wearing a beautiful gown.

NICK

Mrs. W. You look stunning. I haven't seen that dress since...

CAROL

Since Kate's first movie premiere. I only wear it for the most special of occasions.

NICK smiles.

NICK

Thank you. For everything.

CAROL

I see a lot of new faces out there.

NICK

A lot. I can't believe how many people showed up. I guess this project of Kate's really worked.

CAROL

Looks like it.

NICK

Carol. Is she coming? I haven't heard from her. I was pretty rude, and I've been trying to apologize.

CAROL

Yes. She'll be here. She's the quest of honor's date.

NICK

Of course, she is.

CAROL spots MEREDITH

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CAROL

If you will excuse me for a moment. I need to have a word with your stage manager.

CAROL goes to MEREDITH and hands her a piece of paper. Explaining to her what is on it. CAROL exits to the LOBBY.

NICK

Meredith.

NICK gestures for MEREDITH to come to him.

What did Carol give you?

MEREDITH

Uh. (Beat) It's a surprise.

NICK

Well kid, you have to tell the director.

MEREDITH

Kate Warner is performing. It's the cue sheet for it. (Pause) Please don't tell anyone that I spoiled the surprise.

NICK

I won't. I promise. May I see it?

MEREDITH

Oh no. I'm afraid it's showtime, which means it's my show now. You just relax and enjoy.

NICK

(laughs) I supposed I trained you well. Too well.

MEREDITH smiles and heads to COLIN to give him the updated cues.

JIMMY is taking photos. LILY is talking with the crowd. She comes over to NICK

LILY

Ready?

NICK

As ready as I'll ever be.

LILY

I think you are going to be very pleased with how this night turns out.

NICK

I'm too nervous to believe you at this particular moment, but, I'm sure you're right.

LILY heads back to chat with others. Just then, KATE'S head peeks through the doors. She smiles and acknowledges NICK and gives him a thumbs up. Then JACOB comes through the door. KATE points to a seat up front reserved for him. NICK stops him.

NICK (CONT'D)

Hi. I'm sorry, I didn't introduce myself the other day. I'm Nick Kruger. I'm the artistic director.

JACOB

Nick, hi. Jacob Mills. I have heard all about you.

NICK

I wasn't expecting you to be here.

JACOB

Kate talked me into it. Had to change my flight, and have a pretty rough conversation with my boss about a deadline. But she said it would be worth it. She's been right so far.

NICK

She always is. I hope you enjoy it.

JACOB

Thanks. I think I will. It's been a long time since I've been in a theater. I've missed the energy. You know, I used to be a rather good Stage Manager. Anyway, I'll see you after.

The house lights go out in the theater. Music begins to play and the stage lights come on. The spotlight shines to the back of the house and the doors open. ADRIAN and KATE walk in together. KATE is stunning in her LILY MONET original. ADRIAN is as dapper and eccentric as they come. NICK can't keep his eyes off of KATE.

A few steps in, KATE let's ADRIAN take the rest of the walk on his own. She moves toward NICK. The show begins. Musical numbers from ADRIAN'S past shows, * monologues, scenes. The sold-out crowd cheering. This all plays in the background. KATE and NICK are the focus. KATE goes to NICK. KATE So. (beat) How does it feel? NICK What? KATE Leading our good old Embassy into a new era? NICK It's just a retirement party, Kate. KATE Have you checked the donation page in the last 10 minutes? NICK No. KATE pulls up the page on her phone. NICK reacts. KATE We surpassed the goal. (beat) You did it Nick. The theater is going to make it. It's gonna make it. NICK When? How? KATE The town came through. And my fans. Even Jacob donated. NICK (smiles) Apparently, he used to be quite the stage manager. (beat) Kate, listen, about last night. I'm so sorry. I shouldn't have... KATE

Hold that thought, Nick. Please. I

have to

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KATE points toward the stage.

NICK

Right, Jacob is waiting.

KATE

No. No Nick. He's here to see you, not me. About your screenplay. Jacob and I, we aren't a thing anymore. I'm sorry that you thought we were. But, he and I will still be working together...hopefully on YOUR movie. But right now, I have to go backstage. I'm almost on.

NICK looks after her.

The stage lights fade down. COLIN turns on the spotlight and fixes it on KATE, Center Stage.

KATE begins. She is only talking to NICK.

KATE (CONT'D)

Our lives have been a series of missteps. Missed opportunities. Missed moments. And here we are again. Standing in this place that made us who we are. At a crossroads.

Camera pans to NICK. He smiles. He begins to mouth along with the words.

KATE (CONT'D)

I...I don't want another missed opportunity. Days of unanswered texts and voicemails to catch up on each other's lives. I want (breath) you. And me. And whatever that crazy life looks like for us. Maybe it's here, maybe it's in California. Maybe it's somewhere that is just our own. That only we know...that we haven't even found yet. I don't know. But I do know this. (beat) I see you. I see us. And in that, I found the missing piece of my happy.

During this speech, NICK is walking toward her, almost in a trance. LILY (who has been live-streaming on KATE'S page), JIMMY, CAROL, ADRIAN, watch.

KATE(CONT'D) (CONT'D)

I love you. So, if I haven't missed the moment...

NICK is on the stage in this moment. The crowd is hushed. The music stopped. We hear from the back.

COLIN

Kiss her Mr. K!

The CROWD and CAST laughs and cheers.

KATE

I'm sorry Nick. For everything, I'm so, sorry. The studio wants to make your screenplay into a movie. Jacob has a contract all ready for you to sign. He got us an extension till tomorrow. You can stay here and run the theater or come and be with me in LA, or I can come here, or...

NICK

Hey. It's my line now. (beat) I love you Katie. You are my inspiration. We'll figure out everything else. Together.

NICK looks deep into her eyes and KATE into his. They kiss. The audience jumps to their feet. LILY throws her arms up and drops the phone. She grabs it and JIMMY kisses her. ADRIAN looks around at it all. CAROL is seated beside him.

ADRIAN

The perfect ending.

CAROL

No. Not an ending. A beginning. Their sequel.

ADRIAN looks at KATE and NICK who smile down at him and ADRIAN mouths "Thank you".

KATE and NICK pull ADRIAN to the stage. Confetti and balloons rain down on him, and a sign that says "THANK YOU ADRIAN". The entire cast comes onstage.

The crowd begins singing "For he's a Jolly Good Fellow". The camera zooms in on KATE and NICK, singing.

KATE

We saved it.

NICK

YOU saved it. And you saved me. (beat) My northern star.

KATE

Forever constant.

They look at each other, the crowd, and back to each other. They kiss again.

The camera zooms out on a full theatre. The audience is one their feet. The lights begin to fade only KATE and NICK can be seen. In LOVE IN THE SPOTLIGHT.

FADE TO BLACK:

THE END
