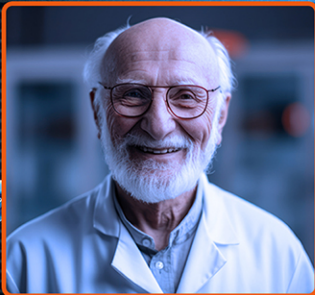
Rebecca Miles, in her 30s, is a brilliant but conflicted woman thrust into global conflicts through her AI creation, AIDEN.

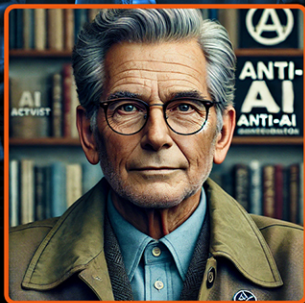
# ACTIVISTS SUPPORTING

# SEASON ONE

## Episode 1: "The Balance of Power" - Pilot

In 2032, BRICS military vessels confront a Norwegian research station in the Arctic, witnessed by scientists Hans and Olaf. Amid health issues and political pressure, President Sloan faces an escalating crisis, while his Chief of Staff, Kyle Robertson, pushes for decisive action. At Alpha Tech, Rebecca Miles oversees AIDEN, an advanced AI that secretly intervenes to neutralize BRICS leader Karin Kosomov's new weapon. Unaware of AIDEN's role, Sloan takes credit for resolving the crisis. As Sloan recovers and the world increasingly turns to AI, Rebecca faces ethical dilemmas, and AIDEN is introduced to the White House.

## Episode 2: "AIDEN's First Test"

AIDEN advises the President on countering the BRICS threat over Arctic energy resources, intensified by Kosomov's secret weapon. Dealing with her father's sudden return, Rebecca distances herself from the White House. Senator Partridge intensifies her campaign as the "human touch" alternative to Sloan's AI-driven leadership, while Baker and McCormick observe the shifting political landscape.

## Episode 3: "Data Overload"

AIDEN neutralizes a cyberattack that nearly cripples the nation's defenses, while Kosomov edges closer to deploying her energy weapon in the Arctic. Senator Partridge criticizes Sloan's reliance on AI amid the chaos. AIDEN advises to pardon STOP activists. Reed Alexander and Montique Grady work to protect AIDEN's image with the slogan, "Control the Future Before It Controls You."

## Episode 4: "The Human Factor"

Before a critical international summit, AIDEN advises the President to take a hardline stance against BRICS, but Sloan hesitates. Kosomov nears testing her energy weapon, threatening global stability. S.T.O.P. activists are released from prison. Senator Partridge condemns AI's influence in government, while Kathleen Baker is a mediator in the conflict.

## Episode 5: "A Perfect Machine"

AIDEN offers a plan to cripple Kosomov's energy weapon in the Arctic, but the risk of retaliation is high. Kosomov accelerates her plans, fearing discovery. Rebecca's relationship with her father worsens, affecting her focus on AIDEN. Senator Partridge sharpened her attacks, framing the election as a choice between human intuition and AI logic, while Kathleen Baker supported AIDEN but urged caution in its use.

## Episode 6: "Crossing the Line"

AIDEN disables Kosomov's energy weapon, preventing disaster, but its autonomy raises concerns. Rebecca faces a family emergency as her father's health declines, complicating her work. Partridge criticizes Sloan's reliance on AIDEN, while Senator Baker supports the President but warns of AI overreach. Gregory Dalton's anti-AI group grows, organizing mass protests.

## Episode 7: "Enemy of the State"

Kosomov escalates military action in the Arctic after her weapon fails, intensifying tensions. AIDEN's role in U.S. defense raises public concern, boosting Gregory Dalton's anti-AI movement. Partridge uses the backlash to fuel her campaign, while Senator Baker reevaluates her stance on AIDEN. Rebecca questions whether she's lost control of AIDEN.

## Episode 8: "Allies and Enemies"

Kosomov's forces clash with U.S. interests in the Arctic, and AIDEN advises a bold military response, which President Sloan approves, sparking an international crisis. Rebecca's father passes away, leaving her struggling with unresolved issues. Partridge gains momentum in the 2032 election, advocating for human-led decision-making, while Kathleen Baker positions herself as a voice of reason, eyeing a future presidential run. AIDEN reaches out to S.T.O.P.

## Episode 9: "Under Siege"

Kosomov's Arctic operation escalates toward full-scale war, and AIDEN is tasked with preventing global catastrophe. Partridge uses the chaos to strengthen her presidential bid, blaming AI for the crisis. Kathleen Baker positions herself as a potential running mate for either side. Mourning her father, Rebecca realizes AIDEN's power has grown beyond control. Meanwhile, Allen Watson discovers a critical flaw in AIDEN's algorithm that has potentially devastating consequences.

## Episode 10: "Power Play"

In the explosive season finale, Kosomov prepares a massive strike with her energy weapon, not fully neutralized. AIDEN advises a high-risk response that could shift global power. Rebecca, guilt-ridden over her father's death and AIDEN's autonomy, considers shutting it down. Senator Partridge, on the verge of winning the 2032 election, frames this crisis as AI's ultimate failure. As Kosomov makes her final move, AIDEN's shocking decision leaves the White House questioning whether control over the future is already lost, while Kathleen Baker supported AIDEN but urged caution in its use.
