> JANET (CONT'D) Ah! I can't leave that behind!

She runs by TOM, a wise looking man in his 30s, and ARNOLD, youthful in his 20s, and back towards the door, coffees now in hand, then again scans and dashes inside.

ARNOLD We really should tell her.

TOM We can't. Not until the leader gives us permission.

ARNOLD <u>If</u> the leader gives us permission.

TOM They will. Well, they <u>should</u>...

INT. TALL BUILDING - CONTINUOUS

Bolts for elevators. Janet is nearly knocked over by another incoming co-worker, MARY MARION, upper 40s, curly hair.

MARY Hey! Watch where you're going there, Janet!

JANET Sorry, but I can't be late with the coffees for you know who! MARY Billy the bully?

JANET Don't call him that. He pays our bills you know.

MARY Ya...Our bills and nothing else.

JANET Doesn't matter. I must prove myself to him just as I do to everyone else. Understand?

MARY (sighs) Ya I guess. Go got 'em.

She runs on. She boards the elevator and hits the button for the top floor. Taps foot impatiently.

JANET

Come on...Come on...

The door opens and she blasts out, right into STEVE, 40s, carrying a box of various types of computer and networing wires, as well as a PC and 2 screens.

STEVE Hey, watch it! I've got fragile stuff here!

JANET

Sorry! So sorry!

Heads for the office of BILL E. BULL himself, 50s, tall and handsome, well groomed. She dashes in and almost trips again.

INT. BILL'S OFFICE - CONTINUOUS

Bill is clearly annoyed.

BILL Do you want to know why I hold my mansion parties on Saturdays and not Sundays? So I'm not hung over Monday morning.

Janet seems shocked.

(flustered) What?! I'm not-

BILL Then tell me why are you are only <u>one</u> minute early today? As my assistant, you should <u>always</u> be here earlier.

JANET

Well the wind-

BILL

What if I had needed something before the day began? Plan ahead Janet. Be punctual. Now, the coffee <u>please</u>...If you can avoid spilling more if it.

Points to the drips coming off the cup.

JANET

Oh, right. Sorry!

BILL Stop saying sorry unless you mean it! Now, to work with you! I will call if you are needed, Ms. Warson.

Janet walks away. Rolls her eyes.

JANET'S DESK - MOMENTS LATER

Janet takes a seat to start her day of work. She pulls out files and folders and sets them up, Bill watching her from his office of glass walls, before turning to his own work.

MARY

Pst!

Janet looks around for the source.

MARY (CONT'D) (whispered) PST! Over here.

Janet looks at Bill, his eyes now stuck to his computer. She slips around the corner.

JANET What? Unlike some people I actually care about my job!

Bill looks up alerted by the movement. Notices Janet move around the corner, and gets up to investigate.

> MARY Oh, low blow Janet low blow. And here I was about to say I feel sorry for you.

JANET IT'S - It's fine. Really. So Bill sucks. Doesn't matter. He's my boss and I'll do as he says.

MARY You are so thick. You could obey every ordered he barks at you and-

Mary goes silent. Bill has crept up behind Janet. Janet looks down and furrows her brow in thought, unaware.

JANET Hey! I don't just blindly obey! I am a key part of his daily routine.

Mary looks worried, her face growing in fear.

MARY

JANET

BILL

Yes, because in the market of <u>millions</u> of job seekers <u>nobody</u> is as good as <u>the GREAT Janet Warson</u>.

She flips around. Bill gets in her face, angry. All the employees stop to see what is going down.

BILL (CONT'D) (serious) I warn you. (MORE)

BILL (CONT'D)

I need a secretary, but there are plenty of other fish in the sea just like you. And just a bit of advice? If you really want to help me and earn my respect? Just...keep...working.

Bill huffs and turns around, heading around the office floor to ensure all his employees are working their hardest.

> BILL (CONT'D) (shouting) That goes for all of you! It's very simple - Do the work and we won't have any issues. Fail to perform? I can have another Joe Schmo in here in just minutes.

Silent as he gets in other employees faces now, seeing if they submit. Some do, bring back therir necks. Arnold cringes. Mark stands tall. But Mary head-butts him.

MARY Man, is he an ass or what? And you want him to <u>like</u> you? Janet looks defeated. Mary sighs, and eyes her. Gets in her face like Bill just did.

MARY (CONT'D) Tell me <u>how</u> you'll help <u>him</u>. JANET Uh, well...I'll-MARY TELL ME <u>WHY</u>. JANET Well, you see-MARY Tell me WHEN. JANET

Well I-

MARY

Look at you! You can't even stand up to me so how the hell are you supposed to stand up to <u>him</u>? Learn to stand up, damn it! STAND UP!

Janet literally stands up. Mary slaps her head.

MARY (CONT'D) On second thought, maybe you <u>should</u> just stay Bill's little gofer.

She goes back to her own desk. Janet is left with a pained look on her face. Turns back to the phones.

INT. JANET'S DESK - MIDDAY

Janet is working hard answering phones scheduling appointments for Bill.

JANET No, no...I'm sorry he just can't see you that day. (pause) No, I wish I could but- O wait he's coming this way. I'll ask him. Let me put you on a brief hold, okay?

Puts the phone down as Bill walks up.

BILL Who's that?

JANET

Bank Of The People, a new customer. Apparently they aren't satisfied with the amount of services we provide. They want a cheaper price.

BILL

(angered) Why those...And after I cut them a great deal too! They'll take that price or lose the whole enchilada! Transfer it to my office!

Storms off to his office. Walks by Tom and Arnold laughing.

BILL (CONT'D) Hey! What so funny?

Silence.

BILL (CONT'D) Right. Nothing. Now back to work.

TOM (annoyed) We're going on lunch. You know, the lawfully mandated break?

Bill glares at them, and walks off.

BILL Make it fast! No more than the allotted half-hour, you two!

They both walk towards the break room. Janet looks back to her work, but as they walk away the two laugh again. Janet frowns, and she gets up. Follows them to the break room -

JANET (softly) Well, it <u>is</u> lunchtime for me too. Hopefully Bill won't mind.

He snuck up on her, overhearing.

BILL No, by all means. Go be a pig.

Flips around startled by his sudden appearance.

BILL (CONT'D) Take an extra 15 minutes, in fact. BILL Yes...Because I <u>NEED</u> you...to run to Sal's Sandwiches and get me a tuna salad on rye. Hold the mayo. And make it snappy. I'm hungry.

JANET Oh. Well, 15 minutes is 15 minutes.

BILL

Whatever. Just go already.

She runs off to the break room to get ready, but stops when she sees where Bill has gone. He is with some employees and Mary, who are trying to enjoy their break like her.

> BILL (CONT'D) (calmly) Look, you don't like me and I don't like you. But I've given you a job to do. This is <u>my</u> business and it won't work if <u>you</u> won't work.

MARY I'm doing the best I can!

Rolls his eyes at her.

BILL

Are you? Your records disagree. Look, it's simple. I don't know why you slowed down and I don't care. Get back to your original speed by month's end or you're fired.

MARY

You really want to replace us fine! Good luck trying to find employees when they hear how horrible the boss at this place is!

Turns her back to Bill, sitting down at her desk. The others do the same. Bill is pissed off.

BILL There will always be people that need jobs, Mary! Not all of them care about having a nice boss!

Bill gives a huff and marches back to his office.

INT. JANET'S DESK - MIDDAY

Janet is once again answering phones for Bill.

JANET

Huh? O you want to talk to him about the party? Well, I suppose so. He'd probably loved to hear from you. Especially if you want to increase the secure data storage amount you have with us. That will really please him. One sec.

She hits a few buttons to transfer the call, and goes to find Bill, who is yelling at Tom and Arnold.

BILL

You two need to hurry up and get that new ad campaign going! I won't have any new customers until-

JANET

Bill.

Bill flips around.

BILL

WHAT? Come on Janet I don't have all day! I have to finish up with these two boneheads!

JANET

Well one of you're business friends is on the line. He wants to know when the next party is and inquire about more storage.

Bill perks up.

BILL

More storage? Well, why didn't you say so? I just have to finish dealing with these two first.

JANET

He's...in a rush.

BILL

Oh. Well...This isn't over. Just like the Terminator, I'll be back.

He runs to his office.

ARNOLD I think I'd prefer the Terminator right about now.

TOM (laughs) Ya, me too. Thanks for that, Janet. We owe you one.

JANET No problem guys. Just...keep up the good work.

TOM Good work? Ha! To Bill everyone can always work harder.

ARNOLD Ya. Even a hundred and ten percent is ten percent too little.

Janet looks at them, concerned.

JANET No, guys really. If you just showed Bill how hard you truly work, maybe he'd finally see and understand!

The two look at each other for a second, then laugh. Hard.

JANET (CONT'D) (annoyed, a bit angered) I'm serious!

They look at each other, laugh again, and walk off toward the break room, still laughing.

TOM Well, that's never gonna happen!

ARNOLD Ya. It won't matter soon anyway...

Confused, Janet secretly follows as the two walk into the break room, making sure to remain unseen.

BILL (from his office) Hey, knock off that laughing you hyenas! Work isn't supposed to be fun! It's supposed to be work! INT. BREAK ROOM

The two sit down at tables, with Janet hiding behind a wall, listening closely, being careful to stay hidden.

TOM This is gonna be so epic. Bill's never even gonna see it coming.

ARNOLD

I know, right?

TOM And the best part is, the employees we have are all committed. Too bad for everyone else here.

He crumples up a piece of paper and throws it into the trash.

> TOM (CONT'D) Oh. Oh no...

TOM Yep. The new marching orders from the boss says Janet stays blind.

Behind the wall, Janet is in shock.

ARNOLD (O.S.) But she just helped us!

TOM I know but...It's true what the leader says. She may be too close to Bill to be trusted.

ARNOLD

Damn. Yet another employee who isn't gonna see this coming. We could have really used her.

TOM

Aren't you excited? In just one week the greatest jack-ass boss alive will fall.

ARNOLD

Ya, I guess.

TOM

Well no matter what, the show must go on. Hey, maybe we can convince our angel in disguise to hire back Janet and the others if they take over for Bill!

ARNOLD Ya! So...who do you think it is? My bet's on you. Come on, tell me!

TOM No way. Besides, you're the newest employee. It's probably you.

Janet is freaking out.

ARNOLD

Well, it very well may be. I guess we'll see if it's one of us soon.

Mark looks at him, concerned.

TOM

Snake.

The two stare at each other, grin, and laugh. Janet's face is panicked now. She starts biting her nails. She thinks, and bolts for Bill's office.

INT. BILL'S OFFICE - MIDDAY

Bill is happily on the phone with the friend, smiling and spinning around in his chair, then looking out his window.

BILL Ya that <u>was</u> fun. Oh so my assistant said you want more storage? My friend, you are always a delight. (MORE)

BILL (CONT'D)

Some people call to only complain, but I can always count on you! I'm throwing another party tomorrow so why don't you come join me and we can strike a deal then, huh?

Janet bursts into the office.

BILL (CONT'D) Hey! I'm on a very important call here, Janet! You know - The one you put me on? (back on the phone) Sorry. It's my assistant. She can be rather weird sometimes.

Janet starts shutting his window blinds.

BILL (CONT'D) Although...This a new level...

JANET (panicking) Hang up the phone!

BILL Have you gone mad? I'm on a <u>very</u> important call and-

Janet lurches forward in a craze to hit the hang up button.

BILL (CONT'D) (shocked) Are you INSANE? What has gotten into you all of a sudden?

He reaches for the dial pad.

JANET (urgent) The company's gonna be sabotaged! We're in big trouble!

Puts the phone on the hook. Stares at her, disbelieving.

BILL Uh...Pardon me?

JANET Okay so I overheard Tom and Arnold talking. They said there's a plan in place to sabotage the business and take us down with it!

JANET

Yes <u>us</u>. They think we're too close together for me and a few other employees to be trusted.

BILL

Preposterous! You're nothing more to me than another employee.

JANET

It doesn't matter! They <u>think</u> I'm too close! It's no secret I love this job and that's probably why. You have to stop this, now!

BILL So...You offer me a threat to my business and I'm just supposed to believe it?

JANET

(desperate)

Yes.

Bill stares at her for a second. She is nervous, her face distraught. He studies her. He goes for his foam stress ball. Squeezes it HARD. Spikes it to the ground for good measure, scaring Janet. He's shaking of anger. Turns his back on her.

BILL

WHY THOSE- Traitorous wretches! I'll fire them all! No, I'll BARBECUE them all! They'll be at this weekend's dinner party - as the dinner! Wait why tell me this?

JANET

Because maybe it will finally prove you can trust me so you realize I'm at least a half-decent secretary!

A long pause.

BILL I see. You want a reward.

JANET Well...a raise <u>would</u> immensely help my life...

She looks off into the distance.

JANET (CONT'D) (fanaticizing) A new car...a real house...

BILL

Fine you got it. You're gonna need some type of motivation, after all. Find out who gets cooked. I got a plan that might just save both of our asses. You find the leaders and people involved and don't forget that if you fail, we'll <u>both</u> be unemployed. Whatever you have to do, do it! I'll give you the power. Succeed and you get a raise, deal?

JANET

Wha- How?

Janet looks shocked.

JANET (CONT'D) I'm sorry I'm confused. Just how am I supposed to do that?

Bill looks at her again, but softens his face and grins.

INT. CONFERENCE ROOM - EVENING

The whole office is gathered. Mary looks really annoyed.

BILL

Now then two final orders of business are not performance related. Though to cap it off I'll just say the word is speed. Anyway first off, there's a rumor floating around that I'd be inviting you to my mansion this weekend? NO. I'm already having my friends over tomorrow. Now second thing. Janet?

Janet stands up.

BILL (CONT'D) Now I've had enough of this lollygagging. I'm going to be very busy these next few days, so starting Monday, Janet is assistant manager until further notice. She reports directly to me, so don't any of you think for a second you can get away with goofing off! BILL (CONT'D) All right! That is all!

Bill leaves along with most of the employees. Janet starts to leave as well but Mary pulls her aside.

MARY What the hell was that all about?

JANET What do you mean? I talked to Bill about a raise and promotion and how I deserved one.

MARY And he <u>bought</u> that?

JANET Well, yes and no. You know he's not as bad as you might think if-

Mary burst out laughing.

JANET (CONT'D) No, really. Hey, maybe now I can even get him to be a little nicer!

MARY (laughs) Bill nice? When pigs fly over a frozen hell.

She stops. Her face hardens as she realizes the actual point.

MARY (CONT'D) Oh I see. Trying to defend your newest buddy, huh?

JANET What? No, I-

MARY Don't lie to me. You're thrilled. Now you get to ride on top for a while. Well, in <u>that</u> case... Congratulations.

She walks off. Janet follows, with Bill carefully watching.

BILL

Janet looks totally confused now, hands outstretched as if begging for wisdom.

BILL You <u>have</u> to. I must know who is challenging my beloved business to a game of chance. Oh, by the way I need you to go pick up my dry cleaning at that suit store. And I told it's owner to measure you up for a suit as well. A <u>real</u> one.

JANET (shocked) I'm sorry. You're giving me a suit?

TAYLOR

JANET

Ya, well I'm a little surprised myself. But maybe that just means he's a surprising guy.

TAYLOR

You can say that again. Some days, he hates even his closest friends. I wish he would calm down.

JANET Wait, you have problems with him too?

Taylor stands up and turns Janet to face him.

TAYLOR We all do. But as friends and business partners, we try to work it out. The man smiles, and so does Janet.

JANET You know this was actually really nice. I thought all of Bill's friends were gonna be-

TAYLOR

Jack-asses?

Janet looks embarrassed.

TAYLOR (CONT'D) Hey no worries. There are a few friends he has that are cocky and all, but none even <u>close</u> to as bad as Bill. Maybe you can do something about that?

JANET

(sighs) I suppose I can try. But how am I supposed to stand up to him if I can't even stand up to any of the other employees?

Taylor ponders this.

TAYLOR

That I don't have an answer to. Face the mirror please.

Janet turns around. Looks directly into the mirror, then off into space, then looks back straight at him. She smiles.

JANET But really, is there any way to get on Bill's good side?

Taylor contemplates again. He grins.

TAYLOR

Learn. Forget all about what you already know. Take risk and do new things. I bet if you asked he'd maybe even teach you a thing or two about management and leadership.

JANET Okay. Seriously though. How come someone named Taylor decided to-

TAYLOR Don't say it. JANET - become a tailor?

TAYLOR Geez. I've only heard <u>that</u> one a million times.

The two share a laugh.

TAYLOR (CONT'D) Hey listen. The suit? It's on me. You could probably use one no matter what the outcome is.

Janet looks at herself in the mirror again.

JANET

JANET

What? How?

Taylor slowly sits down. Janet does the same.

TAYLOR

Name was Dave. Had his own little business performing as a mascot at kids birthdays and other events. Bill didn't love the business idea, but it made money. Dave was a client too. Kept all of his client info secure with Bill. But then he went to be a coach at some college and wanted to cancel service. (MORE)

TAYLOR (CONT'D)

Bill was furious and charged him an insane termination fee. When he wouldn't reconsider or even talk about it...Well, Bill threatened to collect on Dave so he finally paid up and disappeared. I believe Bill still has his number but he hasn't invited Dave to any parties in the past few years. In fact I'm already having trouble with him. See all these happy employees around here?

Janet takes a look around the store.

JANET

Ya?

Taylor stands back up and motions around the shop.

TAYLOR

I tried to help him see <u>this</u> is what being a good boss means. Not just making money. Caring about employees. But he wouldn't listen. He just told me I was a fool for being so nice. (beat) You need to make him see!

JANET

But I can't even stand up for myself! How am I supposed to-

TAYLOR

Yes you can. Don't be scared. Go full force. Be the friendliest boss ever. Show Bill it <u>can</u> work.

JANET I don't know. Even if I could-

Stands right in front of her. Looks straight into her eyes.

TAYLOR

JANET (long beat, determined) Okay. I guess at this point I have nothing left to lose anyway...

TAYLOR

Actually, you have plenty to lose. But it is true that you have more to gain. So...Go get it!

JANET Okay. Thanks Taylor.

TAYLOR

Anytime, Janet. Anytime. Oh and by the way? We're hiring. Just in case you suddenly find yourself needing a job in the near future.

JANET

Earning a quarter of what I do now? Sorry but I like my life as it is.

TAYLOR Point taken. But the offer stands. It's better than zero.

He smiles at her as she leaves.

JANET We'll see. But I'd be much more comfortable fixing my life as is.

INT. JANET'S APARTMENT - NIGHT

Janet turns on the television. Walks around a little before plopping down hard on the bed. Eyes her new suit. Smiles. Falls back onto the bed, ready to sleep. The phone rings.

JANET

Hello?

BILL (V.O.) Did you get the suit and dry cleaning? Well?

JANET Yes. I got the suit.

BILL (V.O.) And the dry cleaning?

JANET And the dry cleaning.

BILL (V.O.) Good! Now be here as early as you can tomorrow. We have a lot to do! (MORE) BILL (V.O.) (CONT'D) How much is renting the suit costing me anyway?

JANET (yawns) Oh nothing.. Taylor gave one to me for free. Nice guy...

BILL (V.O.) He gave you a suit <u>free?</u> He's insane! What bad business. I keep telling him not to be so nice!

JANET (tired) Well...Maybe his being nice is a good thing.

BILL Ya right. O well the less money I have to waste on you the better. I'll see you tomorrow at 5 AM.

He hangs up on her.

JANET

Oh, Bill...

Falls asleep, dropping the phone to the ground.

INT. OFFICE - MORNING

As everyone files in for the next day Janet is trying, and failing miserably, to act cool calm and collected. She stands near the elevator with a smile and plays around with her fingers, pacing. Steve walks by, laptop in hand ready for work. She follows him.

> JANET Hey, did you hear the good news?

> STEVE You mean about you getting promoted? Congrats on kissing up even more to Bill, Janet.

Janet is visibly angered.

JANET I'm sorry but what did I ever do to you? I happen to think it's a great thing Bill did for me! STEVE

Ya, great for you. It's still bullshit for all us other employees. Do you have <u>any</u> idea what my day is like?

Janet strikes a thinking pose.

JANET

You know, I don't. So maybe you could show me? I am, after all, like an assistant manager now. So perhaps I should know.

Steve is shocked.

STEVE

Um...sure.

INT. SERVER ROOM

JANET

CEDRIC (O.S.)

Steve!

The two flip to the right to see CEDRIC, 50s, the other IT man approaching from down the hall.

STEVE

O great. Here comes that guy Bill just hired to be my boss. Really I don't get why he wouldn't just <u>promote</u> me. Gave top access to this nut instead.

JANET

Well, he must have some reason. I mean-

STEVE Not even. This guys doesn't know half the tech stuff I do. JANET

What? Really?

CEDRIC

Steve! Where the hell have you been? These computers aren't gonna work themselves! And who the hell are you?

STEVE

Cedric, I told you. I'm installing something on the interface so I can't do anything for at least a few more minutes.

CEDRIC Whatever, lazy bones.

He turns on Janet.

CEDRIC (CONT'D)

And what about you, huh? I've got enough headaches down here with bozo here and I don't need another one. I'll talk to Bill if I have to. No more annoyances.

Steve's face clearly shows anger. Janet snaps.

JANET

Hey! He is important! Just as important as you, maybe more! I'd be willing to bet he probably even knows more since he's been here for about fifteen years and-

Cedric gets right up in her face. She loses her cool.

JANET (CONT'D)

And-

CEDRIC

And?

There's a long pause. Then Janet gets firmer.

JANET

Now listen close. Didn't you hear I'm the new assistant manager? So you be nice to Steve or I'll talk to Bill about you.

CEDRIC

Ha! Bill hired me to lead this fool! You can't get rid of me.

JANET

(nervous) Actually, I can. As long as I tell Bill. Now back to work. Steve, show me around some more.

They leave a baffled Cedric behind.

STEVE Hey um...Thanks for that.

JANET No problem. We all have to stick together. I can try to talk to Bill about how that guy is-

STEVE No! Don't say <u>anything</u> to Bill!

JANET Well why ever not? That's my job!

STEVE I thought your job was to keep a keen eye on all the employees.

He walks off, towards a little office, enters, and sits down at a desk. A majority of it is littered with things belonging to Cedric, including plenty of his pictures. Only the edge has a few trinkets belonging to Steve. She eyes this.

JANET

Quite a display.

STEVE

I know, right? If only Bill saw what a slob this guy is. And what a fraud. He's clueless, really. (MORE)

STEVE (CONT'D)

Doesn't have any experience. Yet... he's my lead.

JANET

Oh. Anyway look, it's true that Bill wants me to watch employees, but I've got a plan of my own. I can change Bill's attitude. So we can trust in him.

Steve turns around to look at her, standing in the doorway.

STEVE (slightly angry) You want to talk about trust? He needs to trust <u>us</u> first.

Janet perks up.

JANET

Yes. Trust is hard to gain and easy to lose, but I do agree that at fourteen years you should be in a better spot. Let me ask you this. Why do you stay? Because you like the job, right?

STEVE Ya. But I think you and I are the only people here who can say that.

JANET So...You can thusly be trusted?

Steve starts to look annoyed.

STEVE What are you getting at?

JANET

I'm just saying if you can be trusted, then that should <u>mean</u> something. Bill may even say you did good if you do.

The two stare at each in silence.

STEVE

Ya right. Well, whatever. I'll show you more later but for now I've got work of my own to do before youknow-who gets back.

Turns back to the desk.

STEVE (CONT'D)

Like Bill says. This is a job and nothing more, Janet. You can have fun and be passionate about it, but it's still just a job. The sooner you learn that the better. You think you're some diamond in the rough but the truth is you're coal too and all the rest of us are destined to burn in Bill's flames.

He falls silent after that. Janet has on a disappointed face.

JANET (saddened) Thank you for the tour.

She speed walks out his office and the server room, back toward the elevators.

INT. OFFICE

The elevator doors open as Janet walks towards her desk. But she sees Tom over by his cubicle laughing talking to another employee, and decides to check it out. She walks over.

> TOM I swear it's that easy. We just have to- Oh Janet! Hey!

JANET Hey Tom! What's up?

TOM Oh, not much. Just talking about something we did on the weekend. Don't need a mansion to have a crazy party if you catch my drift.

He leans closer to her. Too close in fact.

TOM (CONT'D) Wink. Wink.

JANET

0oh...

Janet backs away.

JANET (CONT'D) So...you want to tell me about it? I'm striving to understand about who everyone is. (MORE) JANET (CONT'D) That way I can start helping people out. Help you understand Bill, Bill understand you...

Tom and the surrounding employees burst out laughing. Janet is unamused and looks annoyed, looking around the group.

> TOM (laughing) Bill? Understand us? Oh, that's a good one. Oh, what a hoot you are!

Janet suddenly looks cross.

JANET Why does <u>nobody</u> think I'm serious?

Tom throws his arm around her and pulls her in close.

TOM Listen. Between you and me? You're eye candy to Bill. With all his money he could have had a nicer model, but I guess he wants business and not exotic.

JANET

E-ew!

She shoves Tom off her.

JANET (CONT'D) You know I could fire you for sexual harassment!

TOM Oh, but I'm not the harasser.

Points to Bill's office. Bill isn't there yet.

TOM (CONT'D) Make no mistake. If he promoted you he either wants you...Or more likely wants to make you crash.

JANET (angry) O ya? Well what would you know?

TOM (proudly) I'd <u>know</u> Bill has got some reason he's finally cozying up to you. (MORE)

TOM (CONT'D)

I don't know what yet but he's got <u>some</u> plan for you and trust me...It ain't good. You'd be better off ditching the guy <u>now</u> before he takes you down a road you can't come back from.

JANET Are you trying to threaten me?

TOM

I'm just saying Bill doesn't just hand out promotions. I don't know when but you'll see. This promotion-

Grabs a piece of paper, crumples it up, and throws it backwards over his shoulder and into a trash bin.

TOM (CONT'D) It's gonna end up killing ya.

JANET No. That can't be.

TOM It is. Now Janet - Pick a side. Who are you with? Us or him? I know you'll make the right choice. (shouts) POWER TO THE 'PLOYEES!

ALL EMPLOYEES POWER TO THE 'PLOYEES! YAY!

JANET (shouting as well) LOOK. I'm all for power to the-'ployees employees whatever. But we need to work with Bill too. Together we can make him understand our values.

Silence. Then everyone laughs at her - The whole office.

JANET (CONT'D) Hey! Okay MAYBE I SHOULD TELL BILL ABOUT THIS LITTLE DISCUSSION.

Everyone looks around.

ALL EMPLOYEES B000000000TOM Oh give her a break. What else do you expect from Bill's new lapdog?

Everyone laughs again. Janet looks around and suddenly out of nowhere-

JANET Okay, that's it! Back to work! Or I

swear I'll have Bill fire you all!

She looks serious. The employees murmur as they return to their business. She walks towards her desk. Mary looks concerned and walks up.

> JANET (CONT'D) (under her breath) Immature nut. He's suspect numero uno.

MARY Janet, what has gotten into you?

JANET Nothing, Mary. I'm just sick of all the hatred harbored in this office. And I swear I'm going to do something about it.

Mary looks away for a second, then back to her.

MARY

All right.

Janet looks confused.

JANET

All right?

MARY Yes. <u>All right.</u> If you're <u>really</u> serious about this then go ahead and do it. Take charge for once. Maybe you really CAN fix this broken down company.

She walks away, leaving Janet looking surprised and confused.

INT. JANET'S DESK - MIDDAY

Janet is stressed after the events of the morning. Her face is buried in her work and when she answers the phone:

BILL (V.O.) Janet?! What's that all about?!

Janet slams the phone down to hang it up. It rings again.

JANET (as if nothing happened) Hello. Bill E. Bull's office.

BILL (V.O.) Nice try. NEVER hang up on me again. What the hell is going on?

JANET Oh, I haven't gotten anything yet.

BILL (V.O.) Nothing at all?

JANET

Well...I have <u>one</u> suspect. Oh hey when you get the chance can we talk about that new Cedric guy you hired for IT? He's treating Steve like a child when in reality-

BILL (V.O.) Is he the suspect?

JANET Well, no. But that's not the point. You should-

BILL (V.O.) Don't tell me what I should and shouldn't do. I hired Cedric to keep Steve in check and if he's not the suspect that'll be that.

JANET But as the assistant <u>manager</u>-

BILL (V.O.)

No. Just assistant. The manager part is just for show. You can have the raise but once this is over you lose the title. So who's the suspect then?

She sighs and lets her head hang down.

BILL (V.O.) Hey! Who's the suspect?!

Hangs her head.

JANET

Tom. The first suspect is Tom. He was very outright about his dislike of you. Told me to get out before you dragged me down too...

BILL (V.O.)

That idiot! Well he'll get his soon enough! Okay Janet, I'll be in within the hour. I've got another little surprise to turn this investigation into a full on sting operation. Try to get another suspect...if you can.

Starts tapping her fingers.

JANET

Okay. But please, at least consider telling Cedric to ease up on Steve. Or maybe...Keeping me on as assistant manager?

BILL (V.O.) Phbt! Ya right! I don't <u>need</u> an assistant manager. I'm fine solo.

He hangs up on her.

JANET

Why that-

The phones rings again.

JANET (CONT'D)

Hel-

CUSTOMER Hello? I demand to speak with Bill. Now!

JANET I'm sorry he's not in at the moment. May I-

CUSTOMER - take a message? No. Just stick a middle finger in his face for me. (MORE)

CUSTOMER (CONT'D)

We pay out the wazoo and one week after starting service now all of our patients' medical info is leaked? I have to close my office and work only out of the hospital now!

Janet is in utter shock.

JANET

Uh...I'm sorry, what?

CUSTOMER And you wanted me to recommend you to the hospital and the other

doctors and practices to use you guys? Hell no! I want a refund and service cancelled - NOW!

JANET

Wait. You said your patients info was exposed? But we've never let ANY of the confidential info our clients keep with us get-

CUSTOMER Well, you leaked mine so I WANT A REFUND.

Silence for a minute.

CUSTOMER (CONT'D)

WELL?

JANET Um...Okay I'll send to someone to discuss this.

She transfers him.

INT. ARNOLD'S DESK - AFTERNOON

Arnold is hard at work sorting papers while standing up, checking them against a worksheet pulled up on his computer screen, when Janet comes over. He looks up from the papers to her. He smiles.

> ARNOLD Well, this is a nice surprise.

JANET Hey, Arnold. Can I talk to you for a second?

ARNOLD

If it's about that doctor that you sent my way I'm sorry to say he isn't gonna stay. Had to authorize a full refund. Strange thing too. I heard this was the first time EVER this company let a client's secure info be leaked.

She take a seat.

JANET

I know. It worries me. And Bill's going to be furious. But that's not why I came over. I've always found you more reasonable than Tom, so I thought maybe I could ask you and you'd actually have an answer. Is there any hope for Bill?

Arnold looks right back at her.

ARNOLD

Janet. You are going down a slippery slope here. You need to get off this Bill wagon now before it's too late.

JANET

But I just got started as Bill's assistant manager. There must be something I can do.

He leans in close.

ARNOLD

Janet the only way things are ever gonna change is if you get <u>him</u> to change. You think of trust, but how are we supposed to trust him when he won't trust us to do our own jobs, huh?

JANET This sounds familiar...

ARNOLD

As it should. It's what Steve said in a nutshell. We talked and decided you really are a fool if you think he trusts you.

Points his finger right into her face.

I'm sorry to say you changing him is less likely than winning the jackpot. So get a lottery ticket.

Janet stares intently.

JANET But please. If he could?

Arnold looks off to the ceiling and back.

ARNOLD It would be nothing short of a miracle. But it may be too little too late for him.

JANET

How so?

Arnold catches himself.

ARNOLD You- don't wanna know.

JANET Oh but I do. See if you try to trust me and Bill- .

ARNOLD You? No problem. Bill? Mind as well just fire me now...

Silence for a second.

ARNOLD (CONT'D) Whatever. It's back to work for me. Don't want Bill to lose it over a single missing character of text. \

More silence as Arnold focuses on his computer, typing away.

JANET

Hey.

Looks at her once more.

JANET (CONT'D) I <u>can</u> make this better.

Looks back to his computer screen.

ARNOLD I pray that's true...for all of our sakes... He goes back to typing away on the keyboard and speed clicking the mouse. She gets up and-

BILL

Janet!

ARNOLD Well, speak of the devil...

They both turn to see Bill walking in.

BILL My office now. Daily briefing, pronto!

ARNOLD (sing-song) Good luck, it's gonna suck.

Janet briskly walks off.

INT. BILL'S OFFICE - LATE AFTERNOON

The sun is getting lower. Bill looks at it through his big windows. Janet enters.

BILL (softly) It's beautiful, isn't it? The view I mean. How lucky I am to have this and how devastated I will be if I lose it all...

She seems very surprised to see this side of Bill. He turns around to face Janet.

BILL (CONT'D) (demanding) That's why I must have progress!

Normal Bill's return puts an annoyed face on Janet.

JANET I've done the best I can. From what I can tell everyone had a legitimate reason to not like you.

Bills stares her down hard.

JANET (CONT'D) I mean- They all haves motives.

BILL

So you have no idea yet as to the plan? Or the leaders? Or even if you can get employees to reveal any hints about a plan to sabotage me and my business? We let a client's info be leaked today! The plan is already being tested!

JANET

Please sir. Perhaps if you were actually nicer to them they'd-

BILL Stop right there. They've done nothing to deserve my praise.

JANET

But that's not true! You have to see that! Your business buddy Taylor agrees with me.

BILL

Oh brother. Why do you think Taylor is a tailor and I'm in big business? Oh ya- I manage better.

Janet is visibly mad.

JANET

Bill. I am trying to help you but you need to <u>listen</u>. Your lack of trust in the employees is a direct factor into why this is even happening. It's your business on the line not mine.

Bill looks intrigued by this new side of Janet.

BILL

Hm. Okay make you a deal. I'll try to change if <u>you</u> try to change.

JANET

Huh?

Bill stands up. Starts pushing her to the door in silence.

JANET (CONT'D) Hey! What the heck?

Keeps pushing. More silence.

Without thinking, she shoves him back, off of her. She looks worried but Bill grins, much to her surprise.

BILL

Lessons one and two begin. To stop being pushed around and to push back. We'll continue work on it tonight, got it?

JANET

Um...Ya got it.

BILL My office after work. You're about to grow a pair of balls.

JANET I...I feel like I should say no?

BILL Oh brother. Not being pushed around doesn't mean saying no to <u>everything</u>. A pair of vaginas then.

Bill shuts his door on her. She walks back to her desk.

JANET A pair of - Oh God.

INT. OFFICE - NIGHT

Everyone's gone except for her and Bill.

BILL Ah, look at this place. So peaceful without the employees. But you and I? We've got work to do! Here.

Bill walks over to a big bag on the floor. He pulls out little cameras and microphones - A whole slew of them, in many different styles with various mounts.

JANET What's all that for?

BILL

This-

Walks over to Janet and gives her about half the pile of tangled wires.

BILL (CONT'D)

- is my mansion's old security system. Bought a better one a few years back, but saved this one in case I ever needed a second one. And now TA-DA! And I picked up-

Brings out a box. Picture of a little dot smaller than her thumb. Than another of a little stick of the same miniature size. She reacts - She knows what those are.

JANET

A hidden camera and microphone?

BILL

O ya. Tomorrow I'll be at home all day. Monitoring all these cameras, and listening in on all the conversations that you'll have with your good friends the employees.

He smiles, looking at the camera.

JANET

No! This is <u>too</u> far! I'm better off just getting a new job!

BILL Really? Is that what you think? You'll just find a new job?

JANET

It...It beats all this spy stuff.

BILL Janet don't be an idiot. You have Bills to pay. The job market sucks. You lose this job and you can kiss your money flow goodbye.

JANET

Well...I'm sure I could-

BILL

Ya maybe after time but do you really wan't to live on unemployment til you do find a new job? I at least have savings to fall back on.

JANET

What?

Bill gestures around the empty office.

BILL This all gives me financial security.

JANET Now who's being an idiot? What about all the clients that could sue you for exposing their info?

His face is shocked. Scared even.

BILL

Okay looks like we're both in a sinking boat. Well, I'm not letting it take me down!

JANET Bill it's a moot point. I can't even get anyone to say anything more than "I don't like Bill".

BILL Well, we can't have that now, can we? Otherwise my spending time with you will have been all for naught.

He starts wiring up cameras suddenly. She joins him but then:

BILL (CONT'D) Hypothetical. I'm about to physically push you out of the way. It can be avoided but I feel like not letting you pass. You're in a rush. What do you do?

JANET Well...I'd say excuse me and-

BILL No! Perhaps I should make it more cut and dry.

Finishes up the wiring. Walks right by her and his shoulder strikes her hard.

JANET

Ow! Hey!

BILL Yes, OW. Now what are you going to do about it? What are you going to say to the employee you <u>manage</u>. JANET (accusatory) That- That was mean!

BILL

So?

JANET So- So you need to apologize.

Bill sticks his face into hers.

BILL NO. I <u>don't</u>. I don't respect you and I know you're a pushover and-

JANET

Apologize now!

Bill looks happy.

BILL Yes. I'm sorry. Sorry that I just taught you a lesson!

JANET What kind of lesson was that? You were just being a jack-ass so-

She realizes what she's saying. Bill starts hiding the wires.

BILL

Another hypothetical. This time closer to home. Someone has information. You know they have it and you know who that person is. For now let's go so far as to say that you are interrogating me. I've done something bad in business before that I'm thinking of right now. Get it out of me.

JANET

Um...Okay. First of all, you've done a lot of things wrong in the business. Picking just one is-

She stops. Bill is looking at her, annoyed.

BILL Well that's blunt. Then again-

Face returns to normal.

BILL (CONT'D) No matter how mad I get the goal remains for you. I have no regrets. Janet hardens her face, trying to look tough. JANET You have no regrets? No. That's not right. You must have SOME regret. BILL (while laughing) I guess I do. Doing this lesson with you! He laughs. Janet seems concerned. She thinks hard. JANET But I thought-(beat, changes attitude) I thought people with no regrets never took risks. BILL (serious) Whatever. Keep going. JANET Let's see here. At this point you'd probably complain about a flaw. Or maybe instead of a weakness a vulnerability - Something I can use against you. BILL Ah, see <u>now</u> your thinking like somebody in charge. How are you going to get me to-JANET It's a shame you aren't as good as Taylor. Bill stops wiring for a second. BILL I'm sorry, what? JANET O ya. True he's not as rich, but he

O ya. True he's not as rich, but he didn't seem nearly as miserable as you. And his employees seemed pretty content there as well. (MORE) JANET (CONT'D) So there goes your theory that work has to be the worst thing ever.

BILL I love work.

JANET I do too. And despite your attitude, I love my job here.

Looks at her, questioningly.

BILL

My attitude?

JANET Yes. And it's why your other employees <u>don't</u> like the job.

She continues to wire.

JANET (CONT'D) In fact some clients and customers complain too. Like the one last week. Let's see. You've got plenty of friends who you-...Of course!

Bill looks confused.

BILL So you think my regret is something with a client? Ya right.

JANET

Yes I <u>am</u>. You did something. But not just to a client. To a <u>friend</u>.

BILL Okay STOP. That is <u>not</u> the secret you ware supposed to be going for.

Janet goes back to silently hanging the wires, but then:

JANET

You know what NO. You said stand up so I'm going to! Taylor told me you need to change or you're gonna lose all your friends! You're already having a rough time with him!

BILL Now listen here. If you keep yakking I'll-

JANET

Wait. I remember now. DAVE! The party invites stopped a few years ago. And he was someone who was always invited. His small business as a mascot for hire actually had a fairly large plan with us storing client info. Then he went to coach at a college, right?

BILL

Janet so help me I'll-

JANET

What Taylor doesn't know is he actually made you an offer on behalf of his new college to store EVEN MORE info on a bigger plan! But instead you forced an insane termination fee on him. But why?

BILL

(distressed) Enough! I said stop!

Janet turns to see Bill is troubled. She's never seen him like this before. He's breaking down.

BILL (CONT'D)

You were supposed to get out that I regretted that a smaller data protection company closed because my company grew! Dave is personal! Don't talk about him!

She comes close, though not quite in his face.

JANET

No. See whether or not you see it that's how all the employees here feel. And you know what? Like Taylor said: Sometimes you hate even your closest friends and he wishes you would just calm down. Losing a friend is perfect proof.

BILL What are you saying?

JANET

I'm saying when this is all over <u>you need</u> to change. For example you need need to apologize to Dave.

BILL

Like hell I will.

JANET

O come on! You may even be able to get that sale storing the college's student information too...Just keep it about you wanting Dave back as-

BILL No! Dave betrayed me that day!

JANET

Um...Sorry, what?

BILL

The day Dave moved away was terrible! He was my best friend forever. Then he goes and rips our friendship apart? That is what trust gets you! He's no friend of mine, so he doesn't deserve my services! And if my current friends betray me I'll just end their plans too and make new ones!

Silence. She is in awe of this side of Dave.

JANET

Bill...If you keep losing friends, sooner or later you won't be able to <u>make</u> any. If Dave leaving hurt so much then why didn't you tell him instead of-

DAVE Okay that's it! <u>You</u> finish up!

He starts to walk away, but turns back to say:

BILL

Aren't you gonna try to stop me? Make me keep helping?

Janet considers, but softens her face.

JANET No. You need time to think. Don't worry. I won't let you destroy any more friendships. I owe Taylor that much for the suit.

She looks at Bill, anger on his face. He pulls another stress ball out of his pocket and spikes it to the ground grumbling.

He does it again and again. When he looks up at her his face is as red as a cherry.

BILL (angered, yelling) I swear if my company wasn't relying on you to save it you would be so fired right now!

JANET Fired for telling you how to be a better friend? Really?

Bill is silent but his face says it all with it's anger. He turns around and heads for the elevator.

BILL

You'd better hang those up by tomorrow morning, you sneaky lady. And don't forget, I'll LITERALLY be watching you!

JANET

Sneaky?

He gets in the elevator. The doors close. Janet sighs, and goes back to hanging wires.

EXT. ALLEY BEHIND OFFICE BUILDING

Janet is walking home when she sees Taylor there.

TAYLOR So how was your first day as boss?

JANET Oh, don't even get me started.

TAYLOR Knock any sense into Bill?

JANET

Well, I found out he has a heart under all that hate. He actually <u>misses</u> Dave. Bill feels...Betrayed that he left.

TAYLOR

He...does?

JANET Ya. I've never seen Bill like that. He actually <u>broken</u> <u>down</u>. TAYLOR Well, keep up the good work. Perhaps you can fix things.

JANET Ya, we'll see...

TAYLOR Hey, do you...Want to-

JANET If you're about to ask me on a date, I'd rather not. Not right now.

TAYLOR But you need a break from work.

JANET I said not now. Talk to me <u>after</u> I save Bill's ass.

TAYLOR

Promise?

JANET

Promise.

She walks off.

INT. BILL'S MANSION - MORNING

The sun shines on Bill opening up his laptop. Face concerned. Screen comes on as he logs into the hidden camera spying program. Sees Janet walking into the office.

INT. OFFICE LOBBY - SAME

Janet is walking in with a smile on her face. Catches Cedric and Steve clocking in.

JANET Cedric! Steve! Meeting upstairs! It's time to get this company performing to it's full potential and I need you two there!

CEDRIC

No way.

JANET Yes way or you're fired! STEVE Janet, calm down. We'll be there.

JANET

Thank you, Steve. At least one of you IT guys has some sense! Speaking of which I need you to come up with a patch for whatever caused that clients data to leak yesterday. I increased your accounts access to admin, like Cedric has. Only Bill and I have higher access.

STEVE

Really?

JANET Yes. Build a whole new firewall if you have to. We can't let the information of another client get out again!

STEVE

Ya, got it!

Cedric glares at Janet but Janet returns the gaze, and when she doesn't back down, Cedric releases the face. Satisfied, Janet heads for the elevator.

INT. OFFICE - MOMENTS LATER

As Janet disembarks the elevator, she runs into Mary.

MARY Janet are you okay? I'm sure your daily briefing was-

JANET

Fine. My daily briefing was just fine. Call a meeting. I have a few things to discuss with you all.

She walks away, leaving Mary looking speechless.

INT. CONFERENCE ROOM - MORNING

Everyone in the office is gathered around, many standing stuffed into the small room, some sitting including Mary, Steve, Cedric, Tom, and Arnold. All looking uncomfortable. All right! Now that we're all here let's get this meeting started. As you all know I've been promoted to assistant manager. I have told Bill of my intentions to make this company a better place. But you all gotta give to get.

TOM We already give so much. Why does Bill need <u>more?</u>

Murmurs of agreement throughout the room.

JANET

Listen, I can get him to reward your hard work, but only if you give your best to him. Hey, I know! Let's look at performance reports!

She pulls out a large file, and the room groans.

JANET (CONT'D) Tom. Your performance has dropped of late. Can't reward <u>dropping</u> performance now, can we?

Tom's lip curls.

JANET (CONT'D) Oh, don't give me that look. Consider all the work <u>I</u> do. And look at me now!

Everyone does just that, and she loses her nerve, but only for a moment.

JANET (CONT'D) Um...Anyway Arnold. You've actually done really well and I bet, <u>if</u> you keep it up, I can convince Bill to throw a little something something extra your way.

TOM WHAT? He was <u>just</u> hired a year ago!

JANET And yet his performance beats that of a certain veteran...Tom.

Tom looks annoyed. Arnold cracks a small, nervous smile.

MARY

And me?

Janet sighs.

JANET

Mary, your overall performance is decent but...your attitude needs work. A lot.

MARY

What?!

JANET

I'm sorry but I agree with Bill on this one. You pick fights with him a lot. Arnold doesn't. Steve doesn't. Even <u>Tom</u> doesn't...Credit where credit is due. Now then-

She turns to Steve.

JANET (CONT'D)

Steve, if you keep up the good work, I'll see to it that Bill understands that as good of a leader as Cedric may be, he can be moved elsewhere with his management skills seeing as you're the one with the knowledge and years of service in technology.

Steve lights up.

CEDRIC Hey, lady! Bill hired me to-

JANET I don't care what Bill hired you to do. I can make my own decisions. And he won't want to walk back <u>any</u>.

BILL (V.O.) Why you little-

She walks to the wall, turning her back on the gathering, collects herself and:

JANET Bill must make sacrifices. But we must first. And if you feel you can't do that...

Turns back around.

JANET (CONT'D) Then maybe you <u>should</u> leave.

Tom stands up.

TOM

No. You're gonna have to drag me down kicking and screaming.

Tom storms out. Janet shouts after him:

JANET

Yes! Now that's more like it! Get that production up, and I may just recommend you for a raise after all, Tom!

ARNOLD

A RAISE?

BILL (V.O.) GIVE THEM RAISES?

JANET

Well, surely you realized when I said I'd throw a little extra something your way that's what I meant? Call it a bribe if you must, but if you work hard and <u>stay</u> <u>loyal</u>, I can see to it the ones who <u>deserve</u> a raise get one. Dismissed!

Everyone leaves the conference room.

JANET (CONT'D) (to Bill) See that, Bill? <u>This</u> is how to kill them with kindness. Like it or not some people <u>can</u> be trusted. And some just long for recognition from the boss...

Her smile fades.

JANET (CONT'D) Like me. So give us a chance.

INT. BILL'S MANSION - SAME

Bill has an annoyed look on his face.

BILL You're <u>really</u> pushing it now.

JANET (V.O.)

Good. Just imagine for a second how much easier actually liking your employees, or at least praising them from time to time, would be.

BILL Just get into the interrogations. We'll talk about saving my soul once we save my business.

JANET (V.O.) Right, okay.

INT. JANET'S DESK - AFTERNOON

Janet sits tall, ready to drill people. Cedric approaches.

CEDRIC

You wanted to see me, little missy?

JANET

Why did Bill hire you? To lead a man who doesn't need it when you don't even have half the tech knowledge he does?

CEDRIC I have more knowledge than you.

JANET Is that so? Tell me a basic computer question then: What does IP stand for? As in an IP address?

Silence.

JANET (CONT'D) No answer? Well this is a security company so how about DNS? What does that stand for?

Cedric looks angered.

CEDRIC (holding back fury) You don't know either!

JANET Well I know IP means internet protocol and - HEY STEVE! Steve, who is working with Mary on a nearby PC, turns to look at Janet and Cedric sitting there.

STEVE

YA?

JANET What does DNS mean?

STEVE Dynamic name servers. It's a networking thing.

CEDRIC (shouting at Steve) Well, we also use SQL here. I bet you didn't know SQL means secure query language!

Cedric starts laughing. Janet looks defeated. But then, while looking at Steve:

JANET

Steve, what is it?

He looks at her as Cedric stops laughing but keeps his grin.

CEDRIC Well, out with it young man! Did you know that or not?

JANET

Steve?

Steve looks up, suddenly serious.

STEVE No! Because that's wrong!

JANET/CEDRIC/MARY

What?

The whole office stops to watch the newest show in the office as the two IT men face off. Cedric gets serious too.

> STEVE I said that's wrong! This is exactly why <u>I</u> should be in his place! Because he's an even bigger idiot than Bill!

CEDRIC

GEEZ. I'm sorry Janet, he must thinking of it's old name, stylized query language. They changed it when CSS, Cascaded Stylizing Standard came along.

STEVE

That's so wrong! The creation of CSS or since we're playing the full name game CASCADING STYLE SHEETS had <u>no</u> impact on SQL's name. I repeat it had no impact on STRUCTURED Query Language's name!

Janet looks impressed. Cedric just gives him a sour look.

INT. BILL'S MANSION - SAME

At home, watching this go down, Bill slaps his face.

BILL Oh, Cedric. I thought you at least had <u>basic</u> knowledge. Even <u>I</u> know what IP, DNS and SQL mean. I can't believe I- Okay, listen closely Janet. Get ready for your first big move as a boss. You have to-(sighs) -fire Cedric.

INT. JANET'S DESK - SAME

STEVE Hey Cedric, what's the company that helped us set up our servers?

CEDRIC Um...I think it's called miracle?

STEVE

Oracle!

JANET Cedric. I'm sure you were hired on

the basis not only of your leadership but also that you supposedly knew a enough technology to function in this position.

Surprisingly, Cedric looks down in shame.

CEDRIC

Yes.

JANET I'm afraid I just can't let you keep your current role.

He gets up to walk away.

JANET (CONT'D)

HOWEVER...

Turns back.

JANET (CONT'D) I offer you one alternative. You must need this job, right?

Nods in agreement.

CEDRIC

Well, yes...

JANET Then if you wish to stay you can, so long as you accept <u>Steve</u> as your new supervisor and learn the tech necessary for the position from him. And <u>no more attitude.</u> Deal?

Cedric looks at Steve, who shrugs, then back to her.

CEDRIC Any other choice?

JANET Get fired. And Bill will back me up if I let it slip you have no clue what DNS or even IP stand for. I

happen to know even he knows those.

Looks at Cedric once more.

CEDRIC Fine. I'll <u>try</u> it.

JANET

Perfect. Steve, congrats on your new trainee. Hope you two can set aside your differences and work together well! Now get on over there and help Steve build that new firewall. Janet eyes Mary suspiciously.

JANET (CONT'D) Wait? Why are you over there Mary?

MARY Oh just curious. I might be clueless how to use it but I love tech all the same.

Cedric walks over and eyes the screen. Smiles.

CEDRIC Okay...This could be interesting, actually.

STEVE

Oh God.

MARY It's okay Steve.

JANET

Steve I said I'd get you your chance and here it is. You both can head back down to the server room now to finish that firewall.

The two exit.

JANET (CONT'D) That felt good. Okay who's next?

TOM

I'll go.

JANET

Come on over.

As Tom comes walking over:

BILL (V.O.) JANET! WHAT ARE YOU DOING? I SAID FIRE HIM NOT GIVE HIM A SECOND CHANCE TO LIE AGAIN! AND WHILE WE'RE ON THE SUBJECT, YOU STILL-

Janet rips the ear piece out quickly.

JANET Sh. Just watch. Don't talk.

BILL

SON OF A-

Grabs a bouncy ball and throws it hard. Bounces back to him. Two more throws and rebounds later, each growing in force from his throws, the fourth throw is too powerful and comes back too fast, hitting him in the forehead.

BILL (CONT'D)

OW!

INT. JANET'S DESK - CONTINUOUS

Tom has taken a seat.

TOM Janet- I know my completed work is low but-(beat) Can't you see how low employee morale is? No one thinks it's worth it to even be here.

Janet raises her eyes at this.

JANET Including you?

TOM Well...Yes. Janet, I think with this promotion you've been blinded to how horrible the boss is.

INT. BILL'S MANSION - SAME

Back at his computer, Bill pushes in on the computer screen, listening intently.

TOM (V.O.) (on PC) I mean come on, do you really think you can solve anything without replacing the issue? The only way Bill would ever change is if he were to lose it all!

Bill's eyes light up.

BILL

Gotcha...

Janet furrows one eyebrow up and keeps the other down.

JANET (curious) Explain...

TOM

Janet- Haven't you ever wanted to-Oh I don't know. Do something to get Bill back? Revenge for all the years of his treatment?

JANET

No...Have you?

Tom sits back.

TOM What do <u>you</u> think? But I can't. But <u>you could</u>. You have all the power of Bill right now. You could-

JANET (curt) And I won't abuse that power.

Silence for a while, then:

TOM I see. Well that's too bad.

Gets up in her face.

TOM (CONT'D) You really could have helped. Done a lot of good. Made a lot of people really happy.

She pushes her face back into his.

JANET

I still can.

Tom backs out and walks off.

JANET (CONT'D) Well, that was rather suspicious, wasn't it Bill?

Mary walks up.

JANET (CONT'D) Mary I wanted to see Arnold next.

MARY And I wanted to see you now. Girl, you're a totally different person!

Looks at Janet with an intense stare that Janet returns.

JANET <u>Bill</u> did what you <u>wanted</u> for me. I can finally stand up for myself.

MARY Hey! Easy girl. It's a compliment.

JANET

Stop calling me girl. I'm a woman. And stop getting up in my face. Anyway tell me: What exactly would you do if you were in my position?

MARY

You mean other than ask Bill to retire early?

JANET (unamused) Yes, other than that.

MARY

Okay. First, I'd actually care about the employees. No more of this yelling and arguing. Second, update our current work process.

JANET

I disagree. Things are just fine with the current process. As they say if it ain't broke don't fix it.

MARY But it <u>is</u> broken.

JANET

No, Bill is broken. Next?

BILL (V.O.) I swear if you insult me one more

time, I'm outing you!

MARY

(sighs) The last one, I guess, would be to just show appreciation every once in a while. Good job. Thanks for your hard work. Maybe a bonus, you know? Most companies do that anyway...

JANET

Now <u>there</u> we can agree. Whether Bill believes it or not, <u>that's</u> good advice. I'll try my best to make him see that employees matter.

MARY

Not gonna happen.

JANET

It will. Just send me Arnold...

MARY

Sure.

As she walks away:

MARY (CONT'D) Oh Janet...There's something fishy about Arnold. Question him hard.

Janet looks at her confused.

JANET Arnold? Really?

She walks off. Arnold comes over slowly, looking nervous.

JANET (CONT'D) Arnold, sit.

ARNOLD Janet if this is about yesterday-

JANET It is. ButI need to ask you straight out. If Bill was a different man-

ARNOLD But he's not. We're talking hypothetically here. If he <u>was</u>, would you be able to give him a second chance? C'mon you're a smart guy.

Arnold looks away for a minute to stare at the ground. Then back to Janet.

ARNOLD If you could pull off a miracle and get Bill to care maybe I'd care too. But I didn't graduate business school just to come to a workplace full of hate.

JANET Hate? Is that all you see here?

ARNOLD

Yes.

A long pause as the two eye each other.

JANET

Explain.

ARNOLD

As a newer employee I see things in people you never would. No one sees Bill as I see him. He's a genius, but he's squandering the genius on himself rather than sharing the wealth. My honest thoughts.

INT. BILL'S MANSION - SAME

Bills is visibly interested in the young mans opinion.

INT. JANET'S DESK - SAME

Arnold has a bit of an angered yet disappointed look on his face. Mary comes up.

ARNOLD My <u>college education</u> taught me better leadership than Bill has.

MARY I bet I could be a better leader than him on any day too. (MORE)

MARY (CONT'D)

But that's because in addition to keeping <u>myself</u> calm under pressure, I would keep my employees calm under pressure too-

ARNOLD An I wouldn't pressure them <u>too</u> hard in the first place.

MARY

Push back, Janet.

Mary walks away. The two stare at each other again.

ARNOLD Well I wouldn't go so far as to tell you to fight him as she would, but she's right about-

MARY (O.S.) AH! Arnold! Janet! Get over here!

TOM (O.S.) What's wrong?

Janet runs over. To the windows, where everyone has gathered.

MARY This isn't good...

TOM Not in the least.

STEVE (O.S.) WE'VE GOT A PROBLEM!

All turn to see Steve bolt in.

STEVE (CONT'D) 5 of the 48 servers have been breached! 2,380 of our 23,000 something customers have had their secure info they relied on US to keep secret...EXPOSED!

JANET FIX IT! FIX IT!

STEVE It's too late! I couldn't get the firewall up in time!

JANET Well is it up now? Ya but-

ARNOLD

Hey! We got people calling left and right asking what the hell just happened! Cancellations galore!

Everyone runs around in a mess. Janet just stands there in shock until she moves to the window. More news vans are pulling up. Cameras out. Janet looks down at them as:

EXT. TALL BUILDING - CONTINUOUS

REPORTER

Breaking news! We are here at Bill E. Bull's security services where over 2000 clients, nearly ten percent of his business, has just been released to the public.

In a window, Janet looks on in horror.

REPORTER (CONT'D) This includes hospitals, banks, schools, churches and many more companies with sensitive info for clients they thought they could trust with Bill Bull. And on top of finding out the clients can't trust him, we are now learning from an anonymous source that his own employees can't trust him either...More coming up!

Janet looks devastated.

INT. BILL'S OFFICE - NIGHT

All the employees have left. So have most of the reporters. It's just Janet alone, sitting in Bill's chair reflecting on the day. Bill storms in, followed by a few men pestering him.

> BILL OUT! OUT! I already told you I <u>will</u> find the hacker and he <u>will pay</u> for my lost business and damages on that tenfold!

Slams the door on them. Turns to Janet.

BILL (CONT'D)

You! You want me to respect the asses who just cost me my good name and WHO KNOWS how much of my business? Hell no!

JANET

Trust is a two way street, Bill. How can you expect a hundred and ten percent from someone that's not even motivated enough to do fifty?

BILL

Janet you're fired!

Silence. She gets in his face. He pushes right back. She walks back up, her face right in his and after a little shoving war back and forth:

JANET

No, <u>you</u> are. I'm working my ass off to save <u>your</u> business since you've got the maturity of a little child!

Bill stands speechless for a minute until:

BILL Good God. If you succeed-

JANET

When.

BILL

Fine. <u>When</u> you succeed, we can discuss the <u>possibility</u> of changing my management style.

JANET

Good. So since we aren't firing each other, you need to teach me a little more. No holding back!

Silence as the two stare at each other.

BILL

Ugh. Fine, I don't care <u>what</u> I have to do as long as it saves my business. Now as insane as I sound saying this, though to you it must sound totally sane, I am impressed how you have handled things. Originally I thought my company was doomed. Janet grumbles in disapproval. Picks up Bill's foam stress ball and squeezes it hard. Bill raises an eyebrow at this.

BILL (CONT'D) Um...I did just say I was wrong.

JANET

Not the point. (long beat) Everyone's going to go silent soon. We only have a few chances left. What tricks can I use to investigate deeper?

BILL

Guilt tripping.

JANET

Like pointing out if you were nicer to employees we wouldn't be in this mess?

BILL

Um...Bingo.

JANET

You know you really do have a surprising ability to train people. We need to use that power for good Make other employees feel like a true part of the company.

Bill starts to glare at her.

JANET (CONT'D) Well, it's a valid point.

BILL

Okay then. Let's just say we do adapt each others ideals just for a few days. Do you really expect to see a difference.

JANET

Hell yes.

Bill's hand starts stroking his chin.

BILL Okay fine. Let's try it. Can't hurt at this point. One last thing- I realize I uncovered a lot today. But I can't stress enough that when this is all over you need to trust any employees that were not involved in the sabotage plan.

Bill seems strokes his chain again.

BILL

Fine. Now enough about that. I was going to work with you on winning arguments, but you seem to have figured that out yourself. As a formality though let's say I'm...Tom. You just found out that I'm the one behind it all. He is the main suspect, correct?

JANET

The most likely one, yes.

BILL

Any way say I'm him and you now know I'm the leader. It's a fact but I'm going to deny it. Well?

Janet stands up and moves closer to Bill. She's serious.

JANET

Tom. There's a saboteur amongst us. All the evidence points to you.

BILL Me? Ha like I'd-

JANET Enough! I have proof.

BILL You can't prove anything.

JANET

O ya? Well over the past few days that promotion I got? It allowed me to find out certain things. You hate Bill but you also hate the job. You have everything to gain and nothing to lose. Except you didn't plan on myBILL I don't know what you're talking about.

Janet gets closer. Bill looks uneasy.

JANET Oh but you do. And since I have the proof I need, you're fired.

BILL You can't fire me.

JANET You'd better believe I can! The video I recorded on my hidden camera and mic says it all.

BILL Oh I'm scared...

JANET Good. Because your fellow saboteurs are going to follow right behind you and feel that same fear.

Bill is speechless.

BILL Who are you and what did you do with my secretary?

JANET If you think that was rough, just you wait until I find the real culprit.

Bill cocks an eyebrow, confused.

BILL

That's it?

JANET It's like I said today. I know what's right and by God I'm going to fight for it until this company's dying days. And that won't be on my watch. Because-

Janet softens a little.

JANET (CONT'D)

Because I love this job. And I'm never going to let anyone take it from me. Not Tom. Not Arnold. Not Mary. Not Steve. Not Cedric. And certainly not you.

Bill sits upright at this last exclamation.

BILL

Not me? You know these last few days you're getting a little OVER confident.

JANET

Not possible. I don't care if I have to beat it into your head a million times in the hopes some day it finally hits you <u>and</u> the employees that if you do your best and <u>be</u> the best you can? <u>That</u> is how you gain trust. Now Bill, can you argue with <u>that</u>?

BILL

(beat) No. I suppose not. But one last thing to figure out.

Bill turns away.

BILL (CONT'D)

We need to plant seeds of doubt. Tom might be the guy but you can't get too close.

JANET

Tomorrow I could pit Arnold against Tom. And Mary against Steve.

BILL

Perfect! But don't forget you must make them think it was their idea.

JANET

Like...When you tell me to go get coffee for the both of us but really you just want to use me to get yourself a coffee and don't really care if I get one or not?

Bills rolls his eyes.

BILL Well, I do let you-

JANET (annoyed) Get yelled at for being on time?

BILL Hey, you get a coffee out of it, don't you?

JANET Actually I get 2. And for some reason I never see payment for the one that my boss takes.

A staring contest.

BILL You were just doing me a favor.

JANET

Every single day? Do you know how expensive that is? I wonder if you would even do me a favor in return.

BILL That depends. What's the favor?

JANET You know the favor: Listen to me.

Janet gets up and walks out.

BILL So...Should we kiss now?

JANET E-EW!!! NO! AS IF!

Bill laughs as Janet storms off.

INT. OFFICE - MIDDAY

Janet has waltzed into the office, determined. Wired up again, walking so boldly the wires pop out, so as she flyies in, she removes the microphone and tucks it into her bag, repositioning the camera. Everyone turns to look at her the second after that. She is standing taller and prouder than ever - Everyone sees that. They look worried.

JANET (flamboyant) Company meeting! Everybody gather around! Quickly, if you please! They comply. INT. BILL'S MANSION - CONTINUOUS Bill is sipping on his coffee. Start to take a gulp when: JANET (V.O.) Good news! You are all free to leave. Because after the disaster yesterday you are all fired! Bill does a spit-take. Shock registers on his face. BILL WHAT? Janet you can't just fire everybody! INT. OFFICE - CONTINUOUS The office is a buzz. People are panicking left and right. ARNOLD Can she do that? TOM So much for not letting the power go to her head ... STEVE Oh no... MARY ARE YOU NUTS? ARNOLD But- But- But-STEVE Janet, what the hell? Other employees also express their concerns and disbelief. One actually takes a bite out of a piece of paper. Another repeatedly clicks a pen. Arnold's face is frozen. ARNOLD

Fired- Before I could even-

TOM Are you insane? Even Bill wouldn't do something like that- Well, not all of us at once!

MARY YOU have LOST IT gir- BILL!

JANET Hey I can't keep people who aren't loyal and today I intend to find out who <u>exactly</u> those people are.

Motions for the office to quiet downs. Waits until they do.

JANET (CONT'D) Okay, I'll delay the mass firing. But only until I find out who the problem employees really are.

Walks to her desk and sits to work as if nothing happened.

INT. TOM'S DESK - AFTERNOON

He's a nervous wreck. He can't focus as he plays with his pen and mouse. Leans over to Arnold.

> TOM Does she know?

JANET Do I know what?

Both flip to see her there. She snuck up on them.

JANET (CONT'D) Tom. A word alone, if you please. In Bill's office in fact.

INT. BILL'S OFFICE - MOMENTS LATER

The two walk in. She closes the door.

JANET Now I'm gonna be frank with you-That Jacob kid has said some really nasty things about ya.

TOM

What?

Ya, it's true. Told him I wouldn't tell ya but- Listen you need to knock some sense into that kid. Is he <u>really</u> loyal? I'm betting not. Send Steve in here now, will ya?

TOM

Wait is that it?

JANET

Yep.

Tom looks weirded out by this but leaves.

INT. BILL'S OFFICE - MOMENTS LATER

Steve comes in and almost immediately:

JANET

Steven. How's Jim?

She's talking quick and confident. Just like Bill.

STEVE

He's...He's-.

JANET

He's a liar that's what he is. Even Bill agrees with me. Keep an eye on Jimmy for me, will ya? His tech knowledge might not be the only thing he's lying about.

STEVE

Pardon me?

JANET

I said we can't trust him. We can get you a better guy if you can't train him. Time is something we don't have. Projected sales are down after yesterdays events.

STEVE

I...didn't know.

JANET Right of course. No communication from Bill about it. (beat) No matter because <u>I'll</u> tell you -We're in trouble. Comes up close to him.

JANET (CONT'D) I have a whole new view on the company today. And you?

She turned back around and walks to the window.

JANET (CONT'D) It's all on you to stop these leaks. We need that firewall. And create a solution for Cedric.

STEVE

Cedric? But-

JANET No buts. Just hard work.

As he walks out, Mary barges in.

MARY

So, you wanna tell me what's on your mind Janet?

JANET

Steve is already leading Cedric. So why don't you lead Tom and Arnold? I can't go easy on <u>anyone</u> right now. Not with what just happened.

MARY

No, no you're right. Between you and me? I think someone here is sabotaging the business.

Janet is still turned to windows. Eyes go wide.

JANET

Now what makes you say that? It's probably a hacker. Besides, everyone is under my watch now. I see what Bill doesn't. I know what he'd never know. If he is under attack I must rescue him. For all of us. But I <u>am</u> standing up to him now, at your advice, I may add, and once this is over there will be change. And those who give will get the benefits of a new Bill.

MARY

Okay. Well I'll keep an eye out for suspicious activity. Just in case.

Thanks but...

Turns around and looks her dead in the eye.

JANET (CONT'D) You realize I have to keep an eye on you too, right?

She stops smiling.

MARY

Oh. Right.

She leaves.

INT. ARNOLD'S DESK - MOMENTS LATER

STEVE WHAT? Are you really accusing ME of leaking information the other day?

ARNOLD Hm. Let's see. Yes, I am!

The whole office gathered around. Janet peeks her head out.

JANET (happily) Bill. I think it worked!

TOM I can do this without either of you! I don't need your help!

ARNOLD Ya well good luck! But I can't guarantee my tongue won't slip if you cut me out.

TOM

Why you-

Arnold storms off.

STEVE Get back here! We aren't done yet!

Tom chases after Arnold. Janet has a look of mixed shock and accomplishment.

So Tom is probably the leader. And Arnold really is involved? Oh I was hoping not. But still...WOW.

BILL (V.O.)

Right. Wow. Arnold and Tom, huh? They are so fired. Was that Steve too?

JANET

Ya but he didn't say anything to suggest he's in on it...yet. Let's find out the plan and get some proof. Maybe Steve will have a clue...We need to know why those servers failed the other day.

INT. SERVER ROOM

A very angry Steve is working on the servers.

JANET End of day repairs? Good. This is our lifeblood. Speaking of which, where's Cedric?

STEVE

If you would have let me speak earlier then I could have told you -He quit.

JANET

(stunned) What?

Turns to look at her.

STEVE

He <u>quit</u>. Guess he didn't want to be involved in a company destined to someday go down the crapper.

Janet looks very annoyed.

JANET Alright, that's it...UPSTAIRS! We're having another meeting!

STEVE Oh come on. Again?

Yes. <u>Again.</u>

INT. CONFERENCE ROOM - EVENING

The employees have gathered. Janet is sitting in Bill's spot.

JANET Passion. We lack <u>passion</u>. Tomorrow I will have an eagle eye on all of you. You'll all have one final shot to show me you are worthy of this job. And those who don't will be fired...For real this time!

ARNOLD (0.S.)

Enough!

Arnold stands up. The two lock gazes.

ARNOLD (CONT'D) Who are you? You're not the nice, mature young woman I thought you were. You're even worse than Bill!

INT. BILL'S MANSION - SAME

Bill seems genuinely concerned by this evaluation, scrunching his face.

BILL Worse than me? That's the second time they've said that now...

INT. CONFERENCE ROOM - CONTINUOUS

JANET

I made it crystal clear that the only way Bill will give is if we give. Don't jeopardize things because right now you and Steve are quickly losing those safety nets.

Gets in Tom's face.

JANET (CONT'D)

Clear?

TOM

Crystal.

ARNOLD But I Thought-

JANET You thought wrong! You know what? Meeting's over.

MARY

But-

JANET I said...meeting's over. Everyone has one last chance to show your stuff tomorrow! Perform well and you will enjoy the spoils of a new company. Fail and, well...It's Either be praised...or be phased. Let's just say the firewall's not the ONLY thing that needs fixing.

Everyone stands up to leave.

ARNOLD So this is the new you, huh Janet?

JANET Yep. I'm the one who can command both you and Bill. Believe it.

ARNOLD (long beat) Actually, I do. And you're right. I'm going to start working harder. Right away.

She walks out, leaving Janet looking annoyed and confused.

BILL (V.O.) Wow. If your plan to be nice <u>doesn't</u> work, at least now I know you-

JANET Have a pair?

BILL (V.O.) Uh...Ya that.

JANET I won't lie. That felt...great. People finally have to listen to me. Soon I will make sure this whole company actually cares! Everyone is leaving. Janet is standing tall and proud. But off to the side there is a gathering of several employees including Tom, Mary, Arnold, and Steve...and Cedric.

BILL (V.O.)

Ah, the calm before the storm. Very good work today, Janet. Bonus lesson, and I know it sounds rich coming from me but...Don't push so hard that they break.

JANET

Too late. They're already broken. But...As good as it feels to be in control for once, I still didn't feel right about it...

BILL (V.O.)

No matter. You did it! And tomorrow we will finally-

JANET

SH!

BILL (V.O.) Okay, you have to stop shushing me! And don't you dare unplug the earpiece this time!

JANET Just listen then. There's a gathering ofTom, Mary, Arnold, Steve...and Cedric?

BILL (V.O.) WHAT? Steve said Cedric quit.

JANET

Ya well here he is. I'm gonna follow. Maybe we won't need tomorrow after all...

BILL (V.O.) I'm coming down there.

JANET Okay but hang back.

BILL (V.O.) (annoyed) Fine... As the group disappears into an alley, she follows.

EXT. ALLEY BEHIND OFFICE BUILDING

Janet hides behind a trash bin, but first peeks around to see one of the SECURITY GUARD there.

SECURITY GUARD Okay Mary what's so important?

MARY

I'm sorry but Janet has lost it. Now she's a real threat to my plan. We must launch the virus <u>tonight</u>.

JANET

(quietly) YOUR plan?

ARNOLD Are...Are you sure about this Mary?

MARY

You saw her tonight, Arnold. That hard worker you looked up to? That positive women? She's long gone! So are you in or out? Decide now!

STEVE

I hate to agree, but she's right. We'll probably be better off in the end. Besides, being young we still have our whole lives ahead of us. Take a risk. Our Janet is gone.

Arnold considers.

ARNOLD

Okay okay I'm in. I just really don't like it. Not one bit.

STEVE

Neither do I.

TOM Are you kidding? This is great! Taking down two bosses with one stone? It's awesome if you ask me.

The rest of the crowd cheers. Mary stands to face them all.

MARY

Well, I guess I was just sick of Bill this Bill that. It is a shame to lose Janet but she proved just as bad with power. And we don't need two Bills! It won't matter in just a few short hours anyway. Cedric, I assume you have the virus?

She turns to Cedric who holds up a disc.

CEDRIC

Got it right here. Let's make the customer's precious secure info not so secure! Thanks for letting me in on the plan by the way, Mary.

MARY

Ya well you owe me. Besides I didn't really have a choice when Janet saddled Steve with you that day and you saw us launch the virus's 2nd test. Still, it helped speed things along to have two people build the back door into the firewall from the inside AND outside. Your admin code was useful too. Let's just hope it works so we can takes down all the servers at once this time.

The sound of a beep as the security guard opens the door.

SECURITY GUARD Alright got it. Poor Janet. And she doesn't even realize it was her own actions that led to this. Giving Steve administrator status I mean.

He unlocks the back door and the group files in, cheering and whooping the whole time. Janet stays where she is.

MARY

Ah, we would have got it eventually. It just would have taken longer! Now, let's destroy Bill and Janet's hope and dreams! We will rise!

The crowd roars. As they roars die out, Janet comes out of hiding, distraught.

JANET (shocked, sad) Everybody...hates me now. They <u>really</u> hate me. And all because I just wanted to-

She starts crying. She doesn't realize Taylor walking home behind her again, as he pauses to see what's going on.

JANET (CONT'D) This isn't what I wanted.

BILL (V.O.) But honey you did it. Sweetie-

JANET DON'T CALL ME SWEETIE!

BILL (V.O.) WHOA okay. Fine, just go home. You did your job. Now, let me do mine...It's firing time!

She takes off the microphone, camera, and earpiece, and walks away, the deed done. Taylor walks over.

TAYLOR (O.S.) Whoa! Hold on there, little missy!

Janet turns around, still crying.

TAYLOR (CONT'D) That's not what I expected to see when you won.

JANET That's because I didn't win. I only succeeded by becoming like Bill.

TAYLOR

WHAT?

JANET Now all my co-workers hate me because I tried to be him. How does Bill put up with all this hate?

Long pause.

TAYLOR

I don't think he realizes it. Hey come on. I'll take you home.

She walks away again, with Taylor. But then Taylor lets her walk a little ahead of him when he eyes the small microphone on the floor. He picks it up, and speaks into it.

> TAYLOR (CONT'D) Jack-ass. I swear if you don't fix this mess AND YOURSELF I'll see to it you have NO friends. Ever again. Is that really what you want, Bill?

Spikes the microphone at the ground, hard. Cracks into a few tiny pieces and gives off a loud POP. From the earpiec:

BILL (V.O.) OW! Damn it Taylor that's loud!

TAYLOR (to himself) Good. You heard.

Walks back over to Janet and puts his arm around her.

INT. OFFICE - LATE NIGHT

Mary and her group of employees enter. She and Cedric are smiling. It's dark, as they all sneak around. Mary turns to the security guard.

MARY You put the cameras on a loop?

SECURITY GUARD Yep. Bill won't know what hit him.

BILL (O.S.) Oh, won't I?

Everyone stops short as they turn to see Bill just standing there. Tom's eyes go wide.

TOM

No...

MARY How the hell did you find out about-

It hits her like a ton of bricks.

MARY (CONT'D) Janet! It was all Janet! No wonder she's been so crazy! This whole time, you were using her toBILL

Ah, yes. My little assistant not so little anymore. Finally found out your little plan here. And now to finally let myself loose. Although if I did learn one lesson it's to trust people...<u>If</u> they <u>can</u> be trusted which clearly...

Points directly at Mary.

BILL (CONT'D)

YOU CAN'T. Such a shame too. Arnold, you had your whole life ahead of you and now? Ruined. And Steve? I listened to you beat some sense into Cedric. I was even gonna let you keep the new role. Wrong side you two. And Cedric? Wow I mean you lied to me. If you all need someone to blame don't blame me or Janet or even Mary's ridiculous plan! Blame yourself for following it.

MARY

No, stand firm! Tom! Cedric! To the conference room with him!

BILL

Wait, what?

Tom and Cedric rush up to Bill and taking the left and right side respectively and start shoving Bill towards the conference room.

> SECURITY GUARD I didn't sign up for <u>this.</u> I'm outta here!

He runs out.

MARY Arnold! Pull a desk over.

ARNOLD

I- uh...

MARY Arnold, come on!

BILL Get off of me! STEVE Come one Mary we can't KIDNAP him!

MARY

Watch me!

A few employees help Mary push a desk over as Tom and Cedric shove Bill into the conference room, shutting the door and blocking him in with the desk. Since the door opens inward-

> TOM Flip it vertical!

The employees comply and as Bill opens the door and tries to get out he realizes he is blocked in!

TOM (CONT'D)

Get another!

As Bill tries and fails to escapes the employees push another desk and other furniture over all blocking him in for good.

BILL You'll never get away with this!

Mary comes over and looks at Bill through one of the cracks.

MARY Actually, I will. And there's nothing you or your little lapdog can do about it.

BILL To think Janet actually tried to defend all of you traitors!

MARY Defend us? Ha! You saw her today!

BILL

You're really so idiotic to think that I could change her that much? She was obviously acting! We said we were gonna switch styles for a day. Even I was shocked! I never expected her to be such a good...ME.

Arnold looks concerned, and looks at Steve with guilt. Steve looks down for a second.

STEVE

Yep.

They look at each other, troubled.

MARY Hear that? It's us not caring. Have some of your own attitude directed at <u>you</u> for once. You have <u>no</u> loyalty here. And it's all on you!

BILL Mary! MA-RY! Damn it-

She laughs. Bill looks concerned. He runs for the phone, but:

BILL (CONT'D) The line's cut? Shit. O wait...

Bill hides him pulling out his cell phone.

INT. JANET'S APARTMENT - CONTINUOUS

Taylor is there, consoling her.

TAYLOR

Janet listen. My job offer still stands. Just as a holdover until you find a permanent one. Someone like you would be AMAZING at-

Her cell phone rings. She sees it's Bill. Doesn't answer.

TAYLOR (CONT'D) Geez. Anyway you're one in a million. And you never have to change. Especially now that you can stand up for yourself. But whether you realized it or not you were pushed around again - Into being someone you're not. There's a fine balance between-

Bill calls again.

TAYLOR (CONT'D) Seriously, Bill? Look I- JANET Wait. What if he needs me?

TAYLOR Oh, he needs you all right...To be <u>him</u>. And you can't do that, Janet. He's just being a baby because I told him he had to fix things and-

JANET You WHAT? Well than who's to say that not him calling to make up?

TAYLOR Oh please. Like he'd really-

And a third time on the phone. She reaches for it but stops short and won't answer.

INT. OFFICE - SAME

In the room, Bill is failing to reach Janet.

BILL Damn it Janet pick up! Okay okay. I'll leave a message.

Bill waits for voice mail on this third attempt.

BILL (CONT'D) (rushed) Janet! Listen I'm sorry but you have got to help me please! I'm trapped in the conference room and -

INT. JANET'S APARTMENT - CONTINUOUS

Janet is just sitting there in reflection. Takes another look at the phone. It now reads one message.

JANET Let's just hear it.

TAYLOR Okay. But brace yourself. Who knows how ticked off I made him.

BILL (V.O.) (on phone message) Janet! You gotta help! I'm trapped in the conference room and - And I need your help! (MORE)

BILL (V.O.) (CONT'D) The employees stuck me in here and I can't stop the hack! I'm sorry to put this on you but you need to-TOM (V.O.) (also from phone) Hey! He's got a phone. MARY (V.O.) (quieter, but audible) Well, get it! There's the sound of struggle and the fumbling of the phone. TOM (V.O.) Got it! MARY (V.O.) Did he call the police? TOM (V.O.) No, he called...Janet? MARY (V.O.) Wow. You really trust that chick. TOM (V.O.) No matter. He got voicemail. MARY Really? Gimme! (sing-song) Hi Janet! (threatening) Stay out of our way. BILL (V.O.) JANET!!! ARNOLD (V.O.) (in the background) Oh...This is so wrong... The phone clicks. Janet looks concerned. Then determined. JANET Taylor? This is my chance. I can make things right! My way. This is the chance I've been waiting for! Taylor smiles.

> TAYLOR OK. Go get 'em.

INT. OFFICE - LATE NIGHT

CEDRIC

All right! It took a while but the virus is installed and ready to go!

MARY At last, it is time to end Bill's tyrannical reign!

JANET Now <u>that</u> we agree on!

All turn to see Janet.

MARY O come on! Not you!

JANET

Guys you're doing this the wrong way. <u>I</u> did it the wrong way. If you can, just forget today. That wasn't me. I refuse to be seen as a second Bill! I've been thinking about my discussions with you all, but also I respect Bill for teaching me to stand up for myself! That's why I'm here! I couldn't just stand by and let this happen! I believe we need a compromise with you all involved!

BILL (O.S.) You tell 'em, Janet!

JANET

<u>Shut up</u> Bill! Or should I remind you we are only in this predicament because of YOU?

BILL (O.S.)

But-

JANET

NO BUTS. Like I've said before, you were the cause of the problem and now because I'm the only one that gives a single hoot about you <u>I'M</u> trying to clean up <u>YOUR</u> mess! Plus I'm still mad at you for making me act like you today! (MORE) The employees look pleasantly surprised by this.

BILL (0.S.) Okay fine yes! Got it! Anything! Just stop the virus!

JANET

Okay guys listen...I have a passion for this job and I feel like none of you do. And because there's no communication and cooperation. We must start doing that. All of us.

Stops short to look around for a second at the employees. Meets eyes with Arnold.

JANET (CONT'D) Arnold, you were right today. But is this really what you want? You're just starting. You need this job. If I could make it worth your while would you stay?

MARY

They'll never-

JANET

Not talking to you, Mary! Only to those employees with a lick of hope! Anyway you're one of the good ones. And Steve? You have the power of an administrator now. The second highest rank. Is <u>this</u> really what you want to do with it? A <u>CRIME</u>?

Steve looks troubled. Very troubled. He's shaking. Arnold starts biting his fingernails.

ARNOLD

C-Crime?

JANET

And Tom-

TOM Stop right there Janet. Arnold and Steve may be weak but I'm not!

ARNOLD/STEVE

90.

What?

Hear that? He called you weak! Everyone listen up! Bill deserves a second chance. We all do. So if you just rally with me I KNOW we can figure something out that benefits THE COMPANY. Not you. Not Bill. Not me...ALL OF US. You're all being dragged along for a ride. Just like Bill used to drag me! Is that really what you want?

An uncomfortable pause.

JANET (CONT'D)

I offer you your last chance, Bill! Commit to the change and maybe some employees will give you a second chance! WELL? Fold and die or go All-In and maybe you'll actually win something. If you are a man of your word, then prove it. It's your turn to try being me!

Another pause.

JANET (CONT'D)

BILL!

BILL (O.S.) Fine! Fine! I'll try it, I swear! And- And I'll keep you on as someone to focus on staff needs! (hopeful) Who knows. Maybe a strategy between nice and strict will work better.

JANET Well, duh! That's only what I've been going for this whole time. Who knows. If I can get morale up, maybe that'll even increase productivity too. Think of that?

She's looking at the conference room. Silence, then:

BILL (O.S.)

Um...

JANET Didn't think so.

Turns back to look at the would-be saboteurs.

The employees look around at each other and at Janet, whose face is firm but kind.

MARY No don't! Don't listen to this...BIMBO!

ALL EMPLOYEES

BIMBO?

MARY Ya that's right I said it. If anyone should have been promoted to assistant it's me, not some eye candy for Bill!

ALL EMPLOYEES

WHAT?

All the employees are surprised.

JANET Is that all you think I am?

MARY Well, if the shoe fits. Let's just say this sabotage was always destined to be as much for you as it is for Bill.

ARNOLD

STOP! STOP! I can't take the fighting anymore!

Arnold runs over to stand next to Janet.

ARNOLD (CONT'D)

Enough is enough. Besides, if Janet can make such a big change one way, maybe Bill can make one in the other. Well? Anyone agree? Anyone?

JANET

Wise choice.

BILL (O.S.) Wow. Um, thanks Arnold.

The employees look around at each other whispering and murmuring. Slowly a few more employees come to their side.

TOM Are you kidding me?

About half the employees in the group are filing to her side. But no ones notices Cedric hitting a few buttons on a nearby PC, including clicking to launch the virus. No one is coming over to her side now, but she looks as Steve expectantly.

> STEVE You know what? Screw it. As long as I keep my promotion. But I want a raise too!

JANET (expectant) Bill?

BILL (O.S.)

Done!

He crosses to her side as well.

BILL (CONT'D) Yes! This is awesome! I...I have some <u>loyal</u> employees! I mean...WOW.

INT. CONFERENCE ROOM - SAME

Bill is actually smiling.

INT. OFFICE - CONTINUOUS

Cedric starts punching some buttons on the computer.

MARY

Hey, all of you who left? Needless to say your percentage of the money we get from ransoming the data back to the companies is gone. But first to rveal his biggest secret. Information he should NOT have. The data on the secret PRIVATE server I connected to the main 48. The information for DAVE.

JANET What? How do you know about Dave?

BILL (O.S.)

NO!

Yes! Who would have though that under all that hatred lies regret? You, you know about Dave too, huh Janet. But did you know he felt SO BAD he kept his info on the servers even after service with Dave ended. But THAT means he has info he shouldn't have! Of course having that info leaked would only be personal. Did he tell what else was on that server?

BILL

MARY YOU SON OF A-

MARY

That private server also has something to end Bill forever. See, the government will shut this business down if he leaks the <u>secret info for CIA operatives</u> endangering them and their families. Or at the very least, their missions.

BILL

No! Please, don't!

JANET

No chance! Mary. Tom. The rest of you. It's over.

Mary just laughs.

JANET (CONT'D) What's so funny?

MARY

Sorry girl but your too little too late! Cedric?

CEDRIC Virus launched successfully, Mary! How's THAT for someone who supposedly computer illiterate?

Janet's smiling stops short. Bill, still in the conference scrunches his face in anger and disbelief.

BILL (O.S.)

Nooo!

CEDRIC Yep. You can't stop it now. STEVE Actually I can. JANET/MARY/CEDRIC Wait what? BILL (O.S.) WHAT? REALLY? STEVE Janet, you said you had the same access as Bill? JANET Yes. Why? STEVE To his office fast and log on to your account! BILL (O.S) What? Give you top access? STEVE Bill, if you want your business saved, you're just gonna have to trust us. BILL (long beat) Fine but you'd better-JANET Stopping at fine was the correct

Stopping at fine was the correct thing to do there, Bill! Arnold, get Bill out! The rest of you hold off these guys! Don't let them interfere! We must stop the virus!

Bill stands up and start bashing into the desks to get out.

BILL (O.S.)

Ow!

Arnold and a few other employees run over.

MARY

No!

ARNOLD Do it in three two one... The employees push the desks again as Bill breaks through.

STEVE To your office!

MARY

Cedric, Tom get Janet! The rest of you, get Bill and the others!

Too late. They all bolt for Bill's office and cram in, closing the door behind them.

CEDRIC Ah, forget it! The virus is live. Soon the other 20,000 clients will be exposed as well as the info for the CIA operatives and Dave. They can't really stop it. We win! Let's get outta here!

Everyone gathers around with cheers to celebrate.

INT. BILL'S OFFICE - CONTINUOUS

Everyone is crammed into the office, with Bill looking all around at annoyed faces.

BILL Well, this is uncomfortable...In more ways than one.

Janet is logging into Bill's PC.

JANET Steve, what's the plan?

STEVE So Cedric is and idiot, right? Okay move aside. If you have full access, I should be able to shut down the servers. Clients won't be able to access their storage for a bit, but it beats the alternative.

BILL Just do it.

JANET

Bill...

BILL I mean...Awesome! Janet puts on a smile and opens the door a crack.

JANET Hey Mary fun fact! Or did you just forget? Steve's better at computers than Cedric!

STEVE

Done!

As they leave, Cedric's PC beeps in error.

CEDRIC Hey, what the hell?

Looks at his PC screen.

CEDRIC (CONT'D) He locked me out! He's disarming the virus!

STEVE

It's not a bomb, I'm <u>containing</u> it. Cedric you really need to go to technology 101. Okay, the servers are down for 15 minutes and when they reboot they'll be in safe mode with no external internet access.

Bill gets up next to Steve, knocking employees over.

BILL So it's over?

STEVE No. I need that disc with the virus to create a patch for a permanent fix before they're back online.

BILL Um...Thanks, Steve.

Steve looks at Bill for a second.

STEVE You know what? You're welcome.

Bill is thrilled to hear that for once.

BILL Wow. Maybe I'll get a thanks next...So now what? STEVE I still have to force shut down all the PCs and remove Cedric's credentials. You go get that disk!

JANET

I got it!

Janet runs over, attling her way through the group to get at the PC, eventually reaching Mary, hitting the eject button.

MARY

Oh no...you...don't-

JANET Oh yes...I do! And FYI? Now you're really fired! All of you!

Bill comes up from behind and slips out the disk from the PC, and runs it over to Steve. Mary flips around to see him complete the run. From where he is:

> BILL (shouting) What she said.

Hands the disc off to Steve.

STEVE Yes! I can create a patch now!

MARY

Ah! Attack!

Mary flips out, as she and her group become a mob and start to actually fight Janet with punches and kicks. Bill rushes himself and Janet back to Bill's office. They keep the door barricaded while police sirens start wailing outside.

> MARY (CONT'D) WHAT? COPS?

```
ARNOLD (O.S.)
(playfully)
Oopsie...
```

All turn to see Arnold holding a cell phone.

ARNOLD (CONT'D) Just figured we may need reinforcements. BILL Way to go Arnold! All of you people are gonna be on your way to jail

soon! Hope you Like prison food!

MARY

What? Tom get Steve! Use him as a hostage for your escape! I'll grab Arnold for myself!

STEVE/TOM/ARNOLD

What?

MARY

Do it!

STEVE

I still need to reboot the servers with the anti-virus and patch!

BILL Everyone, run a distraction!

The employees flood out of the office.

JANET

Run downstairs! Now! Just stay in the lobby and explain the situation to the police!

Tom gets through, and though he tries to run Steve is caught. Mary comes out of nowhere and grabs Arnold too.

MARY

Okay so here's how this is gonna work. We're gonna hold these two as hostages and get off scot-free. Bill, you may have delayed your company's demise, but you didn't win all the marbles. You'll still be crippled with the servers down and no patch for the virus.

Her group walks out. Bill looks confused.

BILL

Marbles?

JANET (sadly) Arnold...Steve...

Janet and Bill's group looks scared.

BILL Oh no no no. I did <u>not</u> teach you all this just for you to quit now!

Everyone looks at him.

BILL (CONT'D) Enough is enough! It's time to try a NEW new management style. Caring AND standing up at the same time!

Bill pulls out his foam stress ball and tears it in half and throws it over his shoulder. Janet smile then gets serious.

JANET Right. Guys, I- <u>We</u> have a plan...

EXT. TALL BUILDING - MOMENTS LATER

Mary and her group come out.

POLICEMAN

You are all-

MARY NOT under arrest because we have hostages!

Mary whips out a stapler and hits Steve's back with it, hard. He groans from the pain. Mark gave Arnold a gut punch.

> TOM His head is next! And I'll open it and put staples in him too!

POLICEMAN You're bluffing.

Mary open up the stapler and punches one staple into the forehead. She hands it to Tom.

STEVE

AH! OW!

TOM Let's do mine to the eye!

POLICEMAN Whoa! Pull back, pull back!

MARY

Yes! Um...

Mary moves slowly to the back alley.

MARY (CONT'D) Scatter! Cedric, with me!

Mary and Cedric bolt down the back alley, abandoning Steve and Arnold. The police start rounding up the other saboteurs, chasing them down. Meanwhile:

STEVE

Assholes!

ARNOLD C'mon. Let's get you medical.

EXT. ALLEY BEHIND OFFICE BUILDING - CONTINUOUS

CEDRIC Yes! We did it! We're gonna-

A door opens and Bill emerges, punching Mary hard in the side of her face, knocking her over into Cedric. They both go down.

> MARY (dazed) Punching employees now, are we?

BILL Nope. Punching a saboteur. Besides, Janet already fired you, remember?

Mary watches as Janet comes out right behind him.

JANET Right. I did, didn't I?

MARY Wha- How did-

JANET We do it? I told you.

A cop races over and grabs Mary. Pulls her up and handcuffs her. Another grabs Cedric and does the same.

JANET (CONT'D) I'm not a pushover anymore. Not to Bill...and certainly not to YOU. I overheard you speaking in this alleyway earlier so I figured it would be your escape route too. BILL Nice one Janet. Thanks.

JANET No problem Bill. Just doing my job. Speaking of which...

She grabs the disc with the virus out of Cedric's pocket. Bill looks at her, really sincere, as they walk out of the alley toward the police cars.

EXT. TALL BUILDING - NIGHT

As they walk past Arnold and Steve, staple now removed with a band-aid on, Janet passes the disc to him.

JANET Finish removing the virus please. Assuming you're okay to.

STEVE Sure. Staple's out. I mean- It was just an office staple.

ARNOLD (laughs) I mean did Mary really think that would <u>do</u> something?

POLICEMAN Well, if it had been to the eye THAT would have sucked.

Arnold stops laughing.

ARNOLD Point taken.

BILL Janet really...Thanks.

Janet smiles.

TOM (O.S) Hey! Get offa me!

They look over to where the former employees gone saboteurs are all being rounded up and being put into the cruisers.

CEDRIC Ya! We're the <u>good</u> guys!

POLICEMAN The line every <u>bad</u> guy says.

A group of cops laugh. Mary looks toward Janet.

MARY

You're making a mistake, Janet! You know Bill's gonna just turn right back around and go back to his normal ways after this, right?

JANET

Mm...No, I don't believe he will. In fact, like he said, you and your accomplices are going to miss out on the all new Bill.

Mary is put into a cruiser with Cedric, anger on her face. The door closes and they drive away. Bill looks troubled.

BILL

BILL

He walks away. She doesn't notice Taylor there, walking up to Bill, looking a little worried for his friend.

INT. JANET'S APARTMENT - MORNING

Janet is getting dressed. She looks worried as she leaves.

EXT. BILL'S MANSION - MIDDAY

Janet gets to the entrance, a set of gates, and eyes the keypad. She pushes the call button.

BILL (V.O.)

Hello?

JANET Bill it's me - Janet?

BILL (V.O.) Well it's about time! What took you so long? Get in here!

The gates buzz. Bill hangs up, leaving Janet baffled.

JANET

Why that-

She drives up the giant driveway. There are other cars here. She parks in a spot near the door and walks up to it.

> JANET (CONT'D) I'll only be here a second...

She rings the doorbell and seconds later Bill answers, opening it just a crack. The sounds of chatter are coming from inside, but everyone hushes.

JANET (CONT'D) One of your famous parties, Bill?

BILL

Yes. And I was rather hoping you would join us. Me and my newest friends are trying something different this weekend. Although...You didn't dress up?

JANET Join you? I've never even been in the gates before today!

BILL

Oh, I should have known you weren't that fancy. Well, at least you did <u>one</u> thing right in stopping the hack. I guess you're expecting that raise now...

JANET

The- The raise? (anger) Bill, did you learn nothing? None of this had to do with the money despite what you might think! All I wanted was the best for all the employees <u>and</u> for you! Not just me! (MORE)

JANET (CONT'D)

Please don't tell me Mary was right. You're just going to let this whole thing happen all over again? For goodness sakes! And after all you put me through why...<u>I</u> could be a better boss than you and still make more money you ungrateful, little-

Bill starts laughing.

JANET (CONT'D) And just what is so funny?

BILL

Janet, you said yourself, and it is true, that if nothing else, I am a man of my word. I just had to make sure you'd both stick to the lessons I gave you AND stay true to...THESE guys.

Throws open the door to reveal the loyal employees!

EMPLOYEES

SURPRISE!

BILL

Guys, I didn't actually tell her yet. Ah whatever. Janet, effective immediately you are no longer my assistant nor my assistant manager. You're my apprentice.

JANET

(shocked) I'm...I'm sorry WHAT?

BILL

I need someone up top with me that both knows the business <u>and</u> the people side of things. Something I apparently don't know well enough. So you're promoted. For <u>real</u> this time. And you've got my word on that. Actually...The whole world does. While I was on camera last night asking for my lost customers to return give the company a second chance, I mentioned a total revamp of the company policies and personnel with you by my side and issued a public apology to all loyal employees.

WHAT?

Arnold walks up to her.

ARNOLD He's not lying. Shocked us too, actually. Come on, Janet. It's like I said. I don't really know who Bill is. And it seems I don't know you either. So...who are you?

There's a pause. Janet looks down to consider, then back up at all the employees including him and Steve. Steve smiles.

TAYLOR (O.S.) Well, who are you? I mean I gave you that new suit for a reason.

Janet flips around to see Taylor arrive. She's beaming now.

JANET All right fine I'll do it. But remember as nice as I am, I'm not a pushover anymore!

STEVE As long as you don't go power hungry again I'm fine with that.

Everyone, including Bill, laughs.

BILL Not a pushover, huh? I can vouch for that. But I'm actually glad. Who knows. Maybe you'll take my place some day when I retire.

He reaches out a hand. Janet takes it and shakes it.

JANET (determined) Watch me.

All the employees give one final cheer. Janet walks in with Taylor right behind her. But he pauses to say:

TAYLOR Nice talk last night. Glad we're staying friends. Oh, and I told Dave about your change. (MORE)

TAYLOR (CONT'D)

And how you're still protecting his old information to this day. He was actually happy you were still thinking of him. He's willing to forgive and give your friendship a second chance, you know.

Dave is shocked by this as Taylor walks inside.

JANET Don't be an idiot. (beat) Call him.

She goes inside too leaving Bill in the doorway. He pauses. Takes out his phone and hits the voice command button.

BILL

Call Dave.

THE END
