1 FADE IN:

2 INT. WAREHOUSE - DAY

Open on a bare warehouse floor. Just a HOSTAGE sat in a chair before a video camera.

A large figure, the TERRORIST LEADER, advances towards him.

Standing over the Hostage, the Terrorist Leader beats and pummels the Hostage, seemingly enjoying himself.

As the Hostage takes his beating, he sighs, contemplating...

BEGIN FLASHBACK

3 EXT. ROAD - DAY

Six OPERATIVES withdraw under fire, pursued by TERRORISTS. With slick professionalism, the Operatives cover and withdraw in teams of three, unphased as rounds zip all around.

Among the six is our Hostage, as one of the Operatives. His comrade beside him is shot dead. As he glances to his side to see his friend fall, a Terrorist takes a shot which grazes the side of his face.

Knocked unconscious, the Hostage collapses to the ground as the rest of the Operatives, believing him to be dead, withdraw.

4 EXT. ROAD - DAY (LATER)

Slowly, the Hostage regains consciousness. He wakes to see a gaggle of terrorists standing over him, weapons trained on him. They stand aside as the Terrorist Leader strides into the Hostage's field of vision.

He stands over the Hostage and gives a menacing grin.

END FLASHBACK.

5 INT. WAREHOUSE - DAY

The Terrorist Leader stands addresses the video camera, looking straight down the lens, before taking a pistol out of his pocket. He turns to face the Hostage.

The Hostage takes a deep breath of resignation as the pistol is trained on his temple. And a shot rings out...

6 INT. OPS ROOM - DAY

A sophisticated digital screen plays footage from the video camera of the hostage being executed. Beside it, a mugshot of the Terrorist Leader. Beneath that a list of known war crimes.

The fourth image is of drone surveillance footage of activity around a warehouse.

7 EXT. WAREHOUSE - DAY

The surveillance footage transitions to drone footage of four Operatives lying out of sight as Terrorists pass by towards the warehouse.

Once the coast is clear, the Operatives emerge and advance towards the warehouse.

8 EXT. WAREHOUSE - LOADING BAY ENTRANCE - DAY

Stacking up beside a wooden fence, the Operatives get eyes on two Terrorists casually loitering at the loading bay entrance.

In a flash, one of the guards is jumped from behind by the first Operative, who stabs him in the back.

The second Terrorist turns to see the commotion, but before they can react, they're butted in the face by the second Operative and their rifle.

The Operatives start to pick up the bodies and drag them out of sight. But before they can there is a cry from behind them. A third Terrorist has emerged and seen everything.

The third Operative covering from the fence opens fire, but the Terrorist flees inside. The Operatives prepare to go loud.

Split stacking up on the entrance to the loading bay, the Operatives prepare themselves, and then breach.

9 INT. WAREHOUSE - LOADING BAY/AISLE - DAY

The Operatives storm inside, immediately splitting into pairs. Once the entrance is secure, the second pair move off into a different part of the warehouse. The first pair start clearing the aisles.

As the first pair move into the aisle, they drop any Terrorists that pop out ahead of them.

10 INT. WAREHOUSE - AISLE - DAY

A Terrorist, hiding behind large boxes, jumps out and stabs the second Operative in the leg. They're bundled to the floor. The first Operative tries to take the shot, but it's not possible.

As the Terrorist attempts to stab again, the first Operative jumps on them and hauls them off. The wounded Operative patches themselves up, meanwhile, the two enemies are engaged in a fierce knife fight.

Eventually, the Operative overpowers the Terrorist, taking them to the ground and driving the blade into their chest. At the end of the aisle, another Terrorist starts charging towards them, but is shot dead by the wounded Operative.

All clear, they focus on getting the Operative patched up.

11 INT. WAREHOUSE - STAIRS - DAY

Meanwhile, the second pair of Operatives move to the second floor. A Terrorist appears at the top of the stairs, they drop him and he tumbles down the stairs, crashing at their feet. They press on.

12 INT. WAREHOUSE - CABIN OFFICE DOOR - DAY

Outside the office door, the Operatives perform a single rolling stack on the door. They brace themselves as they prepare to breach.

13 INT. CABIN OFFICE - DAY

The door bursts open and the Operatives charge in. Immediately, the lead Operative is gunned down with repeated shots to the chest. They crumple to the floor.

At the other end of the room, pistol empty and barrel still smoking, is the Terrorist Leader. The lone Operative goes for the kill shot, but his rifle jams. He immediately switches to his pistol, but before he can shoot, the Terrorist Leader pounces and bundles them both out the door.

The pistol is knocked out the Operatives' hand and bounces onto the warehouse floor.

14 INT. WAREHOUSE - SECOND FLOOR - DAY

The Operative and the Terrorist Leader are locked in a fierce hand-to-hand fight, grappling, punching and wrestling to gain an advantage. The Operative continually scrambles to reach the pistol.

Eventually the Operative gains the upper hand and manages to kick the Terrorist Leader away. As the Terrorist Leader gathers himself, it's all the time the Operative needs to snatch up the pistol and turn it on his enemy.

He unloads on the Terrorist Leader, emptying the magazine. Succumbing to his wounds, the Terrorist Leader collapses backwards, and pitches off the ledge of the second floor to the warehouse below.

Breathing heavily, face gritted and contemplating what's just transpired, the Operative takes a moment.
