EXT. APARTMENT BUILDING - DAY

A mail truck pulls up and out hops NEWMAN.

Gerry signals to his Portuguese henchman JORGE COSTANZA, who pretends to read the paper across the street.

Newman approaches the door with packages, he is buzzed in. Gerry slips his foot in the door just before it closes. Jorge follows Gerry inside.

INT. APARTMENT BUILDING - MOMENTS LATER

Newman leaves a package outside KRAMER'S Apartment. Gerry and Jorge pass him in the hallway. Newman does a double take.

Gerry knocks on Kramer's door.

KRAMER (O.S.)
I said leave the packages!

Gerry kicks the door in.

INT. KRAMERS APARTMENT - CONTINUOUS

Kramer, reading the paper on the toilet, is startled.

Gerry punches Kramer off the toilet.

GERRY
(yells)
Where is the money Kramer?

Gerry picks Kramer up and shoves his head in the toilet.

GERRY (CONT'D)
I want that money Kramer! Where's
the money Kramer?

Gerry lets Kramer up for air. Jorge watches in the b.g.

GERRY (CONT'D)
Where's the money Kramer? Where's
the money shit head?

KRAMER
It's down there somewhere let me
take another look.

Gerry shoves his head in the toilet again.

GERRY
Don't mess with us.

Gerry throws Kramer to the ground.

JORGE
(Portuguese accent)
Never lend to dead beats Kramer.

Jorge pees on the rug in the living room.

KRAMER
No don't do that... Not on the rug
man.

GERRY
See... see what happens Kramer? You
see what happens!

Kramer digs his reading glasses out of the toilet and sits
down.

Gerry picks up a golf club.

GERRY (CONT'D)
What the fuck is this?

KRAMER
Obviously you're not a bowler.

Gerry smashes the club against the sink.

KRAMER (CONT'D)
Not my Ben Hogan!

GERRY
What is he like a big deal or
something?

KRAMER
He is a legend!

Gerry drops the club.

GERRY
You got 48 hours... Next time I'm
breaking balls--and bones.

Gerry punches Kramer in the face.

JORGE
He looks like a fucking loser.

KRAMER

Hey at least I'm house broken.

Jorge gives Kramer the finger.

GERRY

I don't have time for this. Thanks
a lot asshole.

Gerry and Jorge walk out and leave Kramer soaked in blood and
urine.

EXT. APARTMENT BUILDING - MOMENTS LATER

Gerry and Jorge walk.

JORGE

Can you believe that piece of shit?
Three months he says--three months!
Unbelievable. I can't take this
anymore Gerry.

GERRY

Yeah. A real piece of work that
Kramer. He'll get what's coming.

Gerry hops on his motorcycle and revs the engine.

JORGE

So I'll meet ya at the diner later?

GERRY

What?

JORGE

(yells)
So I'll meet ya at the diner later!

GERRY

Sure thing Jorge.

Gerry peels out.

INT. STRIP CLUB - LATER

Behind the bar is ELAYNE BENES, former Broadway dancer turned
strip club owner.

In walks Gerry with the bouncer.

BOUNCER

Elayne.

ELAYNE

Yeah?

BOUNCER

This gentleman says he has business with you.

ELAYNE

Okay. I'll be in my office.

Elayne nods at Gerry to follow her.

OFFICE

ELAYNE

Did you talk to Kramer?

GERRY

Yeah. We had a chat so to speak.

ELAYNE

Well what did he say? Did you get the money?

GERRY

He didn't say much. Just some gurgling noises.

ELAYNE

What about the money? Does he have the money?

GERRY

And he doesn't have the money.

ELAYNE

Big surprise.

GERRY

I gave him 48 hours to make the payment or no more tee times for Kramer.

ELAYNE

I need that money Gerry or some very bad people will be looking for it.

GERRY

Hmmm.

ELAYNE

I should have never trusted that
lowlife con man Kramer.

GERRY

That's for sure.

ELAYNE

Stupid Vandelay Industries. I wish
I never would have given him that
money.

GERRY

He does have his way of getting it
doesn't he?

ELAYNE

He sure does.

Gerry says Kramer's name like he normally says Newman.

GERRY

Kramer!

Someone knocks on the door.

ELAYNE

Yeah?

He lets himself in.

BOUNCER

You have a phone call. He says it's
important.

ELAYNE

Who is it?

BOUNCER

He says his name is Art--Art
Vandelay.

Elayne gives Gerry a frightened look.

INT. JERRY'S APARTMENT - EVENING

Jerry sits on his couch. He takes a bite of cereal. Kramer
slides in.

KRAMER

Hey buddy.

Jerry gossed out by the sight of Kramer.

JERRY
My god what happened to you?

KRAMER
Oh I'm in big trouble Jerry.

JERRY
You smell like a toilet.

KRAMER
I messed up big time.

JERRY
What happened to your face?

KRAMER
Oh I had a run in with some very
bad men. Crazy men Jerry! They
broke my Ben Hogan.

Kramer whimpers.

JERRY
What is he like a big deal or
something?

KRAMER
He is a legend Jerry! A legend!

JERRY
Whatever. You going to be ok? Let
me get you an ice pack.

Jerry goes to the freezer.

KRAMER
Thanks buddy. They threatened to
break my balls next time--and my
bones!

Jerry digs in the freezer.

JERRY
Where is that ice pack?... Peas.
It's all I got.

Jerry throws the bag of peas at Kramer. He catches it.

JERRY (CONT'D)
I don't want those back.

KRAMER
I'll never play golf again Jerry!

JERRY
What did you do this time?

KRAMER
I owe some money.

JERRY
Kramer I told you not to get mixed
up with a loan shark.

KRAMER
I didn't have a choice Jerry! Turns
out Art Vandelay is a very
dangerous man.

SFX: Door Buzzer

Jerry presses the intercom.

JERRY
Yeah?

GEORGE (O.C.)
(filtered)
It's George.

JERRY
Come on up.

KRAMER
Jerry I was hoping I could borrow a
quick five grand?

JERRY
A quick five grand? The grill on my
car alone costs five grand. I don't
have five grand!

KRAMER
Please Jerry! I beg you.

JERRY
Kramer I can't borrow you any more
money. Or invest in Vandelay
Industries or whatever. I can
barely afford this place--let alone
my mothers care facility.

KRAMER
Come on Jerry. You know I'm good
for it.

JERRY
Ah... no you're not.

George enters.

JERRY (CONT'D)
Hey George.

KRAMER
Hi George.

GEORGE
My god! What happened to your face?

KRAMER
Umm... a golf accident.

GEORGE
What's that smell?

KRAMER
My face.

JERRY
Hey I'm sorry to hear about your
father George.

KRAMER
Yeah, sorry George.

GEORGE
Yeah, yeah, yeah it was his time.
Now I have to figure out what to do
with my mother.

JERRY
You mean she has to figure out what
to do with you.

GEORGE
Funny... she wants to move to the
Kar-uh-bee-uhn of all places. That
place is crawling with scammers
Jerry!

KRAMER
Oh yeah? What part of the kuh-rib-
ee-uhn? I got investors down there.

JERRY
Don't get George involved in your
scheme Kramer!

KRAMER
(to Jerry)
He says it like Pirates of the Kar-
uh-bee-uhn. It's Kuh-rib-ee-uhn.

JERRY

Yes Kuh-rib-ee-uhn. Unless you are specifically talking about Pirates of the Kar-uh-bee-uhn, then Kar-uh-bee-uhn it is.

GEORGE

Huh. Is it the Kar-uh-bee-uhn Sea or Kuh-rib-ee-uhn Sea? Now I'm not so sure.

JERRY

And these are the things that keep you up at night.

GEORGE

Anyways--Kramer are you in some sort of trouble?

KRAMER

Big trouble in Kramertown.

GEORGE

Well what is it?

KRAMER

Well... can I borrow a quick five grand --

JERRY

Kramer! Leave George out of this.

KRAMER

What? It's a hot tip! A once in a lifetime opportunity!

GEORGE

What's a quick five grand?

KRAMER

Exactly!

JERRY

Kramer got messed up with a loan shark.

GEORGE

Kramer! Why would you do such a thing?

KRAMER

Look at me I'm a wreck. A low handicap is all I have. They broke my Ben Hogan George.

GEORGE

Kramer, look I'm sorry, but I can't lend you any money. I have this funeral to pay for and my mothers Kar-uh-bee-uhn cruise with Scam Likely!

KRAMER

Kuh-rib-ee-uhn

JERRY

Scam Likely?

KRAMER

Ya know George that's just like you to pass on a great opportunity!

GEORGE

Great opportunity! Great opportunity for you to gamble it away!

KRAMER

It's a sure thing George!

JERRY

Okay that's enough. Kramer I think you should leave.

KRAMER

Please George! I'm begging you!

JERRY

Okay time to go.

Jerry begins to push Kramer out the door.

KRAMER

They are going to rip my limbs off Jerry!

GEORGE

Beat it Kramer.

KRAMER

Come one George! What's a quick five grand between friends? Just like you said!

JERRY

Get out Kramer!

Jerry and George forcefully shove Kramer out. Kramer clings to the door.

KRAMER

Come on guys! I'm a four handicap!
You can't do this to me! You have
no idea what I'm dealing with here!
This could be the end of Cosmo
Kramer and Vandelay Industries!

Kramer, frightened by the force of Jerry and George, sees the
resemblance to the thugs that beat him.

INT. APARTMENT BUILDING - CONTINUOUS

Kramer flips out in the hallway.

KRAMER

Yowza!

Kramer turns around and his door is wide open. He tries
closing the door behind him, but it keeps coming off the
hinge.

INT. JERRY'S APARTMENT - CONTINUOUS

GEORGE

What has gotten into Kramer?

JERRY

I'm not even sure I want to know.

Jerry's phone rings.

JERRY (CONT'D)

Hello... oh Hi Elaine... okay...
sounds good... sure thing... okay
then... eight it is.

Jerry hangs up the phone.

JERRY (CONT'D)

Hey I told Elaine I would meet her
for coffee. You want to go?

GEORGE

Coffee at 8pm? What are you nuts?
I'll be up all night!

JERRY

Really George?

GEORGE

Really! I can't drink that stuff
Jerry! Especially past 4pm!

JERRY

Yeah I don't think you need coffee
at all--Prozac maybe.

GEORGE

You have any?

JERRY

No.

George disappointed.

GEORGE

You want to come or not?

George unsure if he should go.

GEORGE (CONT'D)

Ahh... I guess. I could use the
company. Maybe I'll order an
Ensure.

JERRY

Great... not sure that's on the
menu, but okay.

EXT. NEW YORK SIDEWALK - LATER

Jerry and George walk.

GEORGE

You think Art Vandelay has
something to do with this?

JERRY

I don't know. Kramer said he is a
dangerous man.

GEORGE

(laughs)
Dangerous Man! Like a super hero
who just does ridiculously
dangerous stuff or something.

A mail truck drives by, hits a puddle, and douses George's
pants with water.

JERRY

Newman.

NEWMAN (O.C.)

(laughs)

GEORGE

Thanks a lot Newman! Ah geez I forgot to bring my spare pants.

JERRY

You carry spare pants most of the time?

GEORGE

Yes, yes!... it's embarrassing I know.

JERRY

Very interesting George.

A homeless man (The Soup Nazi) stands on a park bench, He preaches.

SOUP NAZI

(yells)

The will of god will never take you to where the grace of God will not protect you! To gain that which is worth having, it may be necessary to lose everything else --

JERRY

Wait... is that the Soup Nazi?

GEORGE

Where? I don't want him to embarrass me.

JERRY

There.

Jerry points to the preacher.

GEORGE

Who the homeless guy? He's a crazy man! Nobody listens to him.

SOUP NAZI

Relying on God has to start all over everyday, as if nothing has yet been done! Nothing! God is looking for those with whom he can do the impossible--what a pity that we plan only the things that we can do by ourselves --

GEORGE

Huh--I think that is him.

The Soup Nazi spots Jerry and George.

SOUP NAZI
You! Curse you Jerry Seinfeld!

JERRY
Let's get out of here!

Jerry and George quickly move along.

SOUP NAZI (O.C.)
Curse you George Costanza! You
ruined my life! I spite you both!
No prayer for you! You ruined my
business! I will kill you both!

GEORGE
I'm never giving that guy bread
again!

JERRY
You just can't let that go can you
George?

GEORGE
Never!

BANIA (O.C.)
Hey Jerry! Is that you?

JERRY
(annoyed)
Oh great it's Bania.

BANIA
Jerry! It's me Kenny! Kenny Bania!

JERRY
Hi Bania how are you doing?

BANIA
Great! Doing great Jerry!... hey
George!

GEORGE
Hi.

BANIA
I killed it last night Jerry.
Killed it!

JERRY
What, with the Ensure bit?

BANIA
It's the best! Killed it! Killed!
I'm going to go pick up some
chicks. Good looking ones too.

A Woman walks by and Bania follows

BANIA (CONT'D)
Hey what's your name?

JERRY
Some things never change.

GEORGE
(snorts)
That's for Ensure. Ha, ha.

JERRY
Very funny George.

GEORGE
I thought so.

LARRY DAVID
George! Jerry!

JERRY
Oh hey Larry David what's going on?

GEORGE
Larry, good to see you.

LARRY DAVID
I've been meaning to talk with you
guys! I got a great idea for the
Seinfeld reboot!

JERRY
Oh yeah what's that?

LARRY DAVID
A show about nothing!

GEORGE
Larry we did that already.

LARRY DAVID
Yeah, but this time it's different.

JERRY
Yeah but?

LARRY DAVID

Hear me out! A snarky no-nonsense loan shark "Gerry" and his Portuguese henchman "Jorge" take reparation on a bad investment with Vandelay Industries, only to find out they are laundering money for the Puerto Rican Cartel. Welcome to Gerrytown!

JERRY

I don't know Larry. Seems like a stretch. Do they even have cartels in Puerto Rico?

LARRY DAVID

I'm not sure.

JERRY

I'm no loan shark.

GEORGE

Yeah, and I'm no Portuguese henchman.

George snorts.

LARRY DAVID

Guys, this is huge. This could be the next Seinfeld!

JERRY

I don't know man.

GEORGE

I don't know man! A super hero who knows nothing! But accidentally saves people. Huh, huh?

LARRY DAVID

That's a terrible idea George.

JERRY

Ahh... a cartoon maybe.

LARRY DAVID

Think about it Jerry! It's West Side Story meets Seinfeld! Get back to me! I gotta go.

Larry walks away.

GEORGE

(yells)

Hey Larry? Do you say Kuh-rib-ee-uhn or Kar-uh-bee-uhn?

LARRY DAVID

(yells)

Kuh-rib-ee-uhn... Unless you are specifically talking about Pirates of the Kar-uh-bee-uhn. Then of course it's Kar-uh-bee-uhn.

GEORGE

Huh.

JERRY

I told you so.

EXT. NEW YORK SIDEWALK - EVENING

Elaine turns the corner about to enter the diner. Putty steps in front of her.

PUTTY

Hi Elaine.

ELAINE

(frightened)

Oh my god! You scared me!

Elaine bats him with her purse. Putty puts up his hand.

PUTTY

Hi five?

ELAINE

What? No... Putty... what are you doing here?

PUTTY

Looking for you babe.

ELAINE

Well you could have called me.

PUTTY

You know phones aren't really my thing.

ELAINE

Putty, we broke up years ago.

PUTTY

Yeah, I know. I was just seeing if you want to get back together?

ELAINE

No... that was forever ago!

PUTTY

I thought it was just a long break?

ELAINE

Putty, take a hike.

PUTTY

Babe, c'mon! I'm miserable without you.

Elaine annoyed, stares down Putty.

ELAINE

Ughh... maybe I'll call you later.

Elaine walks into the Diner.

INT. DINER - CONTINUOUS

Jerry and George sit in a booth.

JERRY

Oh here comes Elaine... Elaine.

Elaine approaches the booth.

ELAINE

Hi Jerry, Hi George.

JERRY

Helllllooooo!

GEORGE

Helllllooooo!

Elaine sits down and slouches in the booth.

ELAINE

Ughh.

JERRY

What's the matter? You seem annoyed.

ELAINE

I just ran into David Putty!

GEORGE

Oh yeah how is Putty?

ELAINE

I don't know George. I haven't seen him in like ten years.

JERRY

It's been that long?

ELAINE

Yes! He wants to get back together.

GEORGE

After ten years?

George snorts.

ELAINE

Isn't that crazy? He thought we were just on a break!

JERRY

Figures.

Waitress comes over.

WAITRESS

What can I get ya hun?

ELAINE

Coffee. Black.

The waitress fills her cup and looks at Jerry.

JERRY

I'll just have another coffee.

GEORGE

Are you sure you don't have Ensure? You should carry it. It's very popular these days.

The waitress shakes her head, fills Jerry's cup, and walks away.

JERRY

I told you they don't have that George.

ELAINE

Actually that sounds good. They should carry it.

GEORGE

See! I'm not alone here Jerry.

JERRY

Okay then.

ELAINE

Have any of you seen Kramer?

JERRY

Oh we've seen Kramer.

GEORGE

We think he is in some big trouble
Elaine.

Elaine blows air out her mouth

ELAINE

Well yeah! He owes me like five
grand!

GEORGE

Five grand! That's what he wanted
me to invest!

ELAINE

Get out!

JERRY

Something fishy is going on here.

GEORGE

Jerry thinks Art Vandelay has
something to do with it.

Jerry shushes George.

JERRY

Shhh, lower your voice please.

GEORGE

Sorry.

ELAINE

Well yeah the payment was made to
Vandelay Industries. Kramers
company.

JERRY

Yeah that's a shell company.

ELAINE

What's a shell company? Do they
make shells or something?

GEORGE

No, no, no it's like a fake company. No locations, no employees.

JERRY

Look, all I know is Kramer showed up at my apartment all beat to hell smelling like a toilet. He's in some trouble with a loan shark and he mentioned Art Vandelay is a very dangerous man.

ELAINE

No kidding?

GEORGE

ELAINE

bursts in.

KRAMER

Jerry!

Kramer spooks Jerry and he spills milk on his shirt.

JERRY

Ahh Kramer! You made me spill milk
on my shirt!

KRAMER

I had the craziest dream!

JERRY

Oh yeah what about?

KRAMER

Well it was about you Jerry! And
George and Elaine!

JERRY

Huh?

KRAMER

You broke my Ben Hogan.

JERRY

What is he like a big deal or
something?

KRAMER

He is a legend Jerry! A legend!

Kramer notices a black motorcycle jacket hangs behind the door.

KRAMER (CONT'D)
(frightened)
Hey where did you get that jacket?

Jerry takes a bite of cereal.

JERRY
Oh I just got that. I'm thinking of getting a motorcycle.

Kramer runs out of the apartment.

JERRY (CONT'D)
Kramer! Where are you going? Was it something I said?
