

SYNOPSIS

Failure is all around her. This twelve-hour livestream exploring the abandoned St. Jerome resort in rural Michigan feels like it's her last chance to be something. *Anything*.

Elias Bane is and artist.

For ten years, this former cyber security expert has been wandering, aimless. From petty financial crimes, to assault, to murder, he's done it all. But fulfillment, accomplishment, recognition; that has eluded him. Until now. Elias has found his truth and his purpose. Elias is embarking on his masterpiece. Through the dark web, he's sent out the call for like minded "artists". A poisoner, an arsonist and a rapist have answered his macabre siren's song.







In his right, a tactical hatchet.

Wykked (CONT.)

It's a graveyard.

INT. ST. JEROME'S/SECOND FLOOR/CHAPEL - NIGHT

The more Harvey struggles, the wider Adrienne smiles.

His body is lashed to a medical gurney situated before the altar.

Adrienne, in full frock and robes, stands over him.

A syringe in her hand full of clear liquid.

ADRIENNE RIDDLE

Do you know why nightshade was used to kill kings? It all started with Cleopatra. Of course it was a woman, right? Her death immortalized it. It had been used for centuries as poison, but also as an aphrodisiac. Ever wonder why?

She leans down over Harvey's sweating face.

CLOSE SHOT - The needle pierces his skin
