TITLE CARD: Fall 1997

Traditional Vietnamese music. There are Vietnamese WATER PUPPET FIGURES in brilliant colors being managed by a PUPPETMASTER. They are made out of wood and lacquered. They each have a wine red thread going down the sides.

NOTE: Yue Xia Lao is pronounced "Yoo-ay Zee-ah Lau."

NARRATOR (V.O.)

"Yue Xia Lao shows a boy the girl who will be his wife.

V.O. continues over puppet figure skit.

Older male puppet figure points to a girl puppet.

NARRATOR (V.O.)

Not interested in having a wife, the boy picks up a rock and throws it at her.

A boy puppet throws a rock at the girl puppet.

NARRATOR (V.O.)

When the boy grows up, his parents arrange a wedding. On that night, his wife waits with the traditional veil covering her face. Raising it, the man finds her to beautiful.

A young male puppet raises the veil on the young female puppet.

NARRATOR (V.O.)

But, she wears an adornment on her eyebrow. He asks why, and she says--

Young female puppet figure appears shy.

2 EXT. OUTSIDE SCHOOL - DAY
Young Wei, throws a (fake) rock at Zarah (pronounced Zeh-ruh).

YOUNG ZARAH

Ow!

Young Zarah runs away crying.

OPENING TITLES

CONTINUE OVER MUSIC.

SUPER: Red Thread of Fate: An Adoptee Tale

3 INT. ZARAH'S PARENTS' HOUSE - FAMILY ROOM - NIGHT 3
The suburban house is located in Gaithersburg, Maryland. There are pics of Young Zarah and random white people on the fridge. ZARAH'S FATHER, 52-63, white male, holds onto an alcoholic DRINK, sloshing his drink on the floor as he searches the house.

ZARAH'S FATHER Where is my phone? Where is my goddamn phone?

ZARAH'S MOTHER, 52-63, white female, wearing a T-SHIRT that says Maryland, gives him something that looks like a Nokia 6110. Zarah pulls out an Adoptee Hub planner (product placement) from her backpack with short nails.

YOUNG ZARAH

Does anyone want to know how my day went? Someone said something to me that was both racist and sexist.

ZARAH'S FATHER (INTO PHONE)

(dialing)

I'm in the middle of a meeting and then I have to catch a plane.

ZARAH'S MOTHER

Yeah, well, some stranger referred to me as your adoptive mother, so it wasn't a great day for me either.

ZARAH'S FATHER

(dialing *6)
God, don't you just hate the
stares?

ZARAH'S MOTHER

Yes, it makes me anxious. I need some time to myself. Why don't you practice your knitting?

INT. ZARAH'S PARENTS' HOUSE - ZARAH'S BEDROOM - DAY 4 Zarah goes to her room. Young Zarah's colorful bedroom is decorated with '90s unicorn POSTERS with red and yellow backgrounds.

YOUNG ZARAH

My father might be too busy for me on earth, but my Heavenly Father always has time for me.

Young Zarah kneels and prays by her bed.

YOUNG ZARAH

Dear Lord, please let me have a committed husband, someone who'll like me and will be fun to be around. If I'm to marry, then please let me meet him when I'm in college. If I'm to remain single, then I won't meet him there.

Looks at her baby doll in a red onesie with a hood.

ZARAH

I just want to be understood.

5 EXT. OUTSIDE SCHOOL - DAY

> Young Zarah, wearing a gifted and talented shirt, and YOUNG AMALEE, 12, dark-skinned Indian girl wearing a shirt with a

YOUNG ZARAH

And then my mom said "We don't use those words here."

YOUNG AMALEE

My parents have said something similar. They don't get us.

YOUNG ZARAH

No, they don't. Have you ever wanted to find your other mom?

YOUNG AMALEE

Yes, did you know that adoptees have their own color?

YOUNG ZARAH

No, I didn't.

rainbow, are eating lunch outside.

YOUNG AMALEE

Adoptees are red, birthparents are green, and adoptive parents are purple.

YOUNG ZARAH

Huh.

(beat)

Will I ever have my true prince? Or is there something wrong with me? Am I defective?

YOUNG AMALEE

No, there's nothing wrong with you. Yes, you'll find the One, and that person will be perfect for you.

YOUNG ZARAH

Maybe you're right.

YOUNG AMALEE

I know because I know who it is. Hope that helps.

The bell rings. Young Amalee waves goodbye and heads on to class.

YOUNG AMALEE

Talk to you later. Bye.

YOUNG ZARAH

Wait!

(runs)

Who are you talking about?

Young Amalee walks inside and didn't hear her.

YOUNG ZARAH

If only I could find the One. I just want someone in my life who likes me.

6 INT. ZARAH'S PARENTS' HOUSE - FAMILY ROOM

6

SUPER: Summer 2003

ZARAH, 23, Vietnamese woman, talks with her mom.

ZARAH'S MOTHER

What happened to you and Amalee?

ZARAH

She just wants to have fun, but we'll still be friends.
(MORE)

ZARAH (CONT'D)

She's going to take a year abroad in India. You haven't told Dad anything, have you?

ZARAH'S MOTHER

You know me; I'm good at keeping secrets.

MATCH CUT:

7 INT. UNIVERSITY GREEK ROW DORM ROOM - DAY

7

SUPER: Zarah's Birthday 2006 WEI, 24, Chinese Cambodian male, and CUTTER, early 20s, Colombian male, are in Wei's spacious dorm playing a VIDEO GAME, listening to rap, and smoking a vape pen.

Cutter's side of the room has spraypaint and pictures of street art.

Wei's dorm room has a BEER PONG "table" that has been marked with permanent marker and a POSTER of a sex idol.

Zarah enters. Cutter looks up and quickly puts away his stash.

WEI

Whassap dude!

Wei and Cutter give each other a complicated insider handshake.

CUTTER

Who's this?

WEI

She's cool.

CUTTER

Hey, any friend of Wei is a friend of mine.

WEI

This is Zarah. This here is Cutter.

CUTTER

Nice to meet ya.

WEI

Today's her 21st birthday. And she ain't tried nothing.

CUTTER

Never smoked?

ZARAH

Nah, never even drank. My parents treat me as if I'm thirteeen. They're super protective.

CUTTER

Hoowee! This is your day!

WEI

Mindtaker!

Cutter grabs a large bottle of beer.

CUTTER

Try this.

Zarah grabs it and chugs it down.

CUTTER

Woa, you sure don't waste anytime!

WEI

We're perfect for each other because we're both a lil crazy.

Wei and Zarah are both wearing a RUBY RING on their left pinky finger.

ZARAH

So why are you named Cutter?

CUTTER

You never told her the story?

WEI

'Cause I know how you love to tell it.

CUTTER

Right on.

WEI

Did I tell you this game is getting repetitive?

Cutter swats him away.

CUTTER

There was this guy who pissed off everyone! And he got what was comin' to him. Name's 'cause I did surgery on the mofo. (MORE)

CUTTER (CONT'D)

Let's just say you don't wanna cross Wei, cause if you do, you'll have me to deal with. Everyone knows we're a pair. But I got better clothes.

WEI

Don't listen to Cutter. He's full of hot air. True story's lot more embarrassing.

Zarah looks uneasy.

ZARAH

I don't feel so good.

Zarah runs to throw up in the toilet.

WEI

She might prefer your stash.

CUTTER

You do the honors.

Wei prepares a VAPE PEN and hands it to Zarah.

WEI

Just smoke it.

Zarah takes a puff from the Jucixy VAPE PEN (product placement) with her back to the camera. She coughs and turns back around. Cutter laughs.

CUTTER

It takes a while to grow on you. Here, take some munchies. It has a special ingredient.

Cutter pushes a plate to her with brownies on it.

WEI

It's my job to teach you the ways of college, just as it was my job to help you with English.

ZARAH

I grew up in the U.S., and I'm an English major.

WEI

Exactly, because of me. Cambodians are much better at English.

Zarah looks at Wei then turns her head to look at Cutter.

ZARAH

Do you go to school here?

CUTTER

(laughs)

I wish. You're the only one here that belongs.

ZARAH

I don't know if I really belong here either.

CUTTER

At least you're legal. Haha. Get it?

Cutter smiles at Wei. Wei shakes his head to knock it off.

CUTTER

I don't know how much time Wei has though. Even favors have an expiration date.

ZARAH

What's that mean?

WEI

Ignore him. He's drunk.

Cutter eats a brownie off a plate.

CUTTER

Drunk and high, my friend.

ZARAH

I'm so high. I feel so good.

CUTTER

Haha! Say that again.

ZARAH

I'm so hiiigh. I feel sooo good.

WEI

I think you're sexier when you're high.

ZARAH

You too. So sexy.

CUTTER

Woa, next time I see ya, just lookin' at ya would make me high.

Light is shining on Zarah's hair from the window.

WEI

Look at how nice your hair looks. You're a pretty brunette.

ZARAH

What? I'm Asian. I have raven hair. You're Asian too.

WEI

No, your hair is brown, isn't it, Cutter?

CUTTER

Dude, I think you're high.

WEI

No, maybe Zarah's high.

ZARAH

What? Oh, I did say I was high.

WEI

Yeah, you did. Well, we gotta go. Later.

CUTTER

This is your room too. Where ya goin'?

Wei smacks Zarah's ass and winks.

MATCH CUT:

8

8 INT. COMMUNITY THEATER - DAY

SUPER: November 4, 2007

Zarah and Wei are in attendance at a brightly decorated work-related gathering with a lot of red, yellow, magenta, and blue. The FIRING MANAGER, 30s-50s, Asian male, gets up to the podium to speak.

NOTE: Diwali is pronounced "Dih-vah-lee."

FIRING MANAGER

Welcome to the first ever Diwali celebration of Monitoring Solutions! Diwali, the festival of light, symbolizes the victory of light over darkness--

Zarah and Wei start bickering loudly. People are staring. Zarah spills WINE on Wei's only white job interview SHIRT.

WEI

Right before my birthday?!

The Firing Manager talks with the SECURITY OFFICER. The Security Officer escorts them out of the event.

FIRING MANAGER

Hey, everyone, sorry about that. We're gonna start off with a raffle. Take a look at the ticket you got when you came in.

9 EXT. GAS STATION - DAY

9

The gas station is across the street from the office building and Wei and Zarah are yelling across the street. The sky is gray.

WEI

I swear I'll leave you. Why don't you walk home?

ZARAH

You sleep on the couch. The bed is mine. I paid for it.

WEI

No, you sleep on the couch.

ZARAH

I paid for that too. You just pretend to want me because I pay for your stuff.

WEI

How many times do I have to tell you I don't want you for your money?

10 EXT./INT. OFFICE BUILDING/ZARAH'S CAR - DAY (CONTINUOUS)

10

Wei blocks her car in the office parking lot, continuing their argument in front of the security CAMERA. After Wei leaves, the firing manager walks out to Zarah's car and says something to her.

ZARAH

You can't fire me! I've been a good employee.

FIRING MANAGER (O.S.) It's not you. This is a family-friendly company, and we can't afford to have your boyfriend coming inside our building.

ZARAH

But he was only here one time.

FIRING MANAGER (O.S.)

And that one time was one time too many. I know what an abusive relationship looks like. We're giving you a severance package.

ZARAH

I'm sure we can make a better arrangement.

Zarah winks and reaches out to touch the Firing Manager, who blocks her touch.

FIRING MANAGER

No, that's the best arrangement you're gonna get.

ZARAH

So, I'm being penalized because of someone else?

FIRING MANAGER

Rest assured that we're giving him a trespass warrant too.

11 INT. WEI'S APARTMENT - FAMILY ROOM - DAY

11

SUPER: Wei's Birthday (November 6, 2007)
The apartment is in Petersburg, Indiana. There's some red
Vietnamese ART on the walls. The floor is littered with BEER
BOTTLE CAPS.

There's a Christmas CARD on the table with "Christmas" scratched out and "Birthday" written on top. What looks like an iPhone 3G is unwrapped on the table too. WEI is laughing at Lil Baker Films ANIMATION on the TV (product placement) from his blue camping chair.

ZARAH

I got fired because of you.

WEI

Hey, don't put this on me.

ZARAH

No, seriously, they said it was because they couldn't afford someone with your record to be in their facility.

WEI

You don't need them.

Zarah sighs.

She has a full schedule of applying for jobs, and he sits around watching hentai porn, not paying attention to her, having already forgotten what they were yelling about.

WEI

Giggity giggity!

Zarah flips open what looks like a pink Motorola RAZR. A window appears.

ZARAH (INTO PHONE)

Hi.

AMALEE (O.S.)

Hi, sweetie. How are you doing? Are you going to the Asian Pacific Alumni event? It's combined with the Black Alumni event.

ZARAH (INTO PHONE)

No, I lost my job.

AMALEE (O.S.)

Oh, sugar, how can I help?

ZARAH (INTO PHONE)

Can we stay with you? Just until I find something new?

AMALEE (O.S.)

Sure, but I only have one bathroom.

ZARAH (INTO PHONE)

That's fine. Thank you so much!

12 INT. AMALEE'S HOUSE - BEDROOM - DAY It's a weekday morning. Amalee, 23, dark-skinned Indian who identifies as female, now Zarah's first love, is miffed that she's been "friend"-zoned but still cares for Zarah.

They speak in hushed tones in the bedroom while Wei is playing a VIDEO GAME in another room and wearing a blue Platforming Pangolin t-shirt (product placement).

ZARAH

I'd give him the skin off my bones if it would help.

AMALEE (O.S.)

Parenting is no better. (MORE)

AMALEE (O.S.) (CONT'D)

Darling, that man has a momma. Do you mind if I ask you something?

ZARAH

Sure, what?

AMALEE (O.S.)

What do you see in him?

ZARAH

He's my other half. I'm a do-er, and he's a be-er. He represents my heart and soul. He's not afraid to say what he feels. He doesn't censor himself. He knows his worth--

AMALEE (O.S.)

I don't think we're talking about the same person because the guy I know doesn't know his self-worth at all.

ZARAH

We've never had issues in the sex department...

Amalee raises her head from what appears to be Zarah's lap, and gives her a look. She has a (temporary) TATTOO of a Celtic motherhood knot. She puts her hand on Zarah's arm and looks into Zarah's eyes.

AMALEE

That can't be it.

ZARAH

It's not. He wasn't like that when we met. I thought he represented me. I'm not perfect like my parents think I am or should be. He saw me and wasn't scared of my darkness. He wasn't scared of my father either. It's my fault that he's the way he is now. I should have been more empathetic.

AMALEE

Zarah, he doesn't represent you or what you think of yourself. You know I work from home as a photographer.

Zarah is oblivious. Amalee takes a puff from a vape pen.

AMALEE

I've seen him steal your credit card to buy food.

ZARAH

What? No, I trust him.

AMALEE (INTO PHONE)

When I said you'll find the One, I wasn't thinking of him. There's someone better for you out there.

Amalee puts her hand on Zarah's back.

ZARAH

Well, he's never proposed to me. Some people say it's wrong to be living together.

AMALEE

It's not wrong, but he just sees you as free sex.

(then)

But right now you need to focus on finding a new job.

Zarah gets ready for work and puts on deodorant. Amalee stops her from putting on deodorant with her hand. Amalee walks out to where Wei is.

AMALEE

And you do too.

WEI

What?

AMALEE

Get a job. Or get out.

WEI

Yeah yeah. Just after this game.

13 EXT. INDIANA - DAY (ESTABLISHING)

13

14 INT. CAR MANUFACTURING COMPANY - ZARAH'S OFFICE - DAY 14 SUPER: January 1, 2008

The car manufacturing company is in Evansville, Indiana. YUE, 65, Chinese man with short white hair, wears an (American) Vietnam veteran T-SHIRT, blue jean JACKET, and lanyard with his picture, name, and "Parts Department" on the nametag. He walks down the hall while Zarah wears a red SHIRT with the Eiffel Tower and jeans without a name tag.

Everyone is just now starting work.

Yue walks to Zarah's new desk and greets her.

The next two lines are spoken in Vietnamese with an American accent:

YUE

Hello!

Zarah is speechless.

YUE

Goodbye.

He walks out the door before she can respond.

15 EXT. SUBURBAN SIDEWALK - DAY

15

The sky is gray. Wei's unshaven, his clothing's wrinkled, and his face is dirty. Wei has to check the box saying that he had a felony. Show a series of hands accepting his job application only to throw it in the trashcan when he turns his back. He stands by his phone but it never rings.

FADE OUT:

HOLD IN BLACK

16 INT. CAR MANUFACTURING COMPANY - HALLWAY - DAY

The HIRING MANAGER, 30s-50s, Asian man, is giving Zarah a tour on her first day at the job.

NOTE: Yue Lao is pronounced "Yoo-ay Lau."

HIRING MANAGER

...and this is Yue Lao.

Zarah and Yue stare at each other a little too long and the hiring manager looks back and glances at him. The hiring manager continues the tour.

YUE

Have fun on the tour!

HIRING MANAGER

After the tour, I'll show you to your desk.

17 INT. WEI'S APARTMENT - FAMILY ROOM - DAY
Wei, wearing a blue t-shirt and jeans, watches WRESTLING from a blue camping CHAIR with a place to sit drinks.

ZARAH

Can you help me find my makeup and music? I seem to have lost it after our seventh move.

WEI

No.

The floor is littered with beer bottle CAPS. Wei twists a beer bottle off, adding another bottle cap to the floor.

ZARAH

Why not?

Zarah steps on a bottle cap when Wei sees something big happen on TV.

ZARAH/WEI

Ow!/Oh!

WEI

I can't find something if I don't know where it is.

Zarah sighs.

During a commercial break, Wei looks over at Zarah.

WEI

What's with the long face?

Wei gets up and puts Zarah into a figure 4 and tickles her. Zarah can't help but laugh.

ZARAH

Sometimes I think that you deserve to just be. I'd pay for you to just be you if I could, but everything costs so much.

18 INT. CAR MANUFACTURING COMPANY - BREAKROOM - DAY

Zarah and Yue, both in jeans, are in the breakroom making small talk. There are Adoptee Hub and Platforming Pangolin mugs (product placements) on the counter.

YUE

There are a lot of Asians in this company in Evansville. We have Chinese, Thai, Hmong, Koreans--

ZARAH

How about Vietnamese?

YUE

I'm sure there's that too.

LATER

Zarah wears SAFETY GOGGLES, a Bloomington (Indiana) t-shirt, and sniffles from a cold.

ZARAH

I feel miserable

YUE

You look fine to me.

ZARAH

I don't like how these safety goggles make my nose look.

YUE

You have a cute nose. You have a master's degree, so what are you doing here?

ZARAH

I just graduated and was looking for an adventure.

(then)

Is that ruby?

Zarah points to his left pinky finger.

YUE

Yes. I see you have one too.

ZARAH

It's a birthstone given to me by my family. I'm a Cancer. What's your sign?

YUE

I'm a Leo. You're gorgeous for someone who's about 35.

ZARAH

I'm 22, almost 23, but thank you. I'd like to coordinate a get-together after work.

YUE

People want to go home after work. Things are very informal. Not a restaurant, but a bar.

Yue stops to look at Zarah lovingly.

19 INT. MEXICAN BAR - NIGHT

19

At a colorful bar with Zarah, Yue, and the hiring manager, Yue wears a dark blue baseball HAT that says "USA."

YUE

I don't trust the government.

ZARAH

I saw a homeless man today who was wearing a nice work outfit, as if he had been newly evicted. Man!

YUE

This is the USA! That can't happen here!

ZARAH

Do I hear sarcasm?

YUE

A big fat YUP.

The hiring manager is watching the TV in the bar and cheering for a sports team.

ZARAH

Do you like sports?

YUE

(quietly)

Not at all.

ZARAH

(quietly)

Thank God you don't like sports.

Me neither.

Zarah laughs. Hiring manager leaves for the restroom.

ZARAH

You said that you have an ex-wife. Do you mind if I ask why you broke up?

20 INT. YUE'S HOUSE - FAMILY ROOM - DAY (FLASHBACK)

20

SUPER: Fall 1975

Yue's house is in Evansville, Indiana. YUE'S EX-WIFE, 30s, a white blonde woman, and YOUNGER YUE, 30s, Chinese man, are talking. Yue's flashbacks have a B&W old 35mm quality.

YUE'S EX-WIFE

I'm pregnant!



YOUNGER YUE

What? I thought you were on birth control.

YUE'S EX-WIFE

Well, it's not 100% effective. I thought you'd be happy for me.

YOUNGER YUE

(reluctant)

Uh, yeah, yeah. I'm happy for you. It's just unexpected.

21 INT. MEXICAN BAR - NIGHT

21

YUE

Children. Vietnam.

22 INT. WEI'S APARTMENT - FAMILY ROOM - DAY

22

It's raining. Zarah turns on her computer and searches for "ego" on a site that looks like Metacrawler. One of the search results refers to Kabbalah, and she starts reading about it.

It says, "Kabbalah is a practical religion. It comes from the Hebrew word meaning 'received knowledge.'" She clicks on the Contact link at the end of the site. She types into the contact form: "How do I protect myself from evil?"

An email pops up: "Wear a red string on your left wrist and have a loved one add seven knots to it. Then recite this prayer..." She prints it out, folds it, and puts it in her pocket.

Zarah turns around to look at Wei who's facing the opposite wall. Wei watches TV.

ZARAH

Guess what today is? It's our 4th anniversary.

NOTE: Bia is pronounced "bee-uh."

WEI

Happy Anniversary! This calls for a celebration. Would you be a dear and get me some bia?

Zarah runs to the nearest LIQUOR STORE to buy beer. She turns the corner. Sound of her falling on the ice. Amalee, who was in the area, runs in the direction of the sound, gripping the HANDLES of a fancy paper bag.

AMALEE

Oh my God! Are you okay? We need to get you to the hospital!

BLOOD runs down Zarah's face from her eyebrow area.

ZARAH

(dazed)

Amalee? What are you doing here?

AMALEE

I was just heading over to surprise you.

23 INT. PRIMARY CARE PHYSICIAN'S OFFICE - DAY

23

Amalee sits in a chair near the medical bed and takes Zarah's hand in both of hers. Zarah does't look at her, embarrassed. The PRIMARY CARE PHYSICIAN, 50s, female African adult, played as self, is looking Zarah over.

PRIMARY CARE PHYSICIAN

She's fine. She just has a cut above her eye, on the brow. I'm giving her a few stitches.

The doctor gets an antiseptic WIPE and starts to clean Zarah's face.

PRIMARY CARE PHYSICIAN (CONT'D)

Just going to clean her off and put a bandage on it, and she should be good.

The doctor puts a butterfly BANDAGE on Zarah's eyebrow.

PRIMARY CARE PHYSICIAN (CONT'D)

There's little chance she's gotten a concussion, but we'll keep an eye on her.

Zarah is out of it because of the pain medication.

24 INT. SYNAGOGUE - OFFICE - DAY (FLASHBACK)

24

Everything has a pink tint. There are words on a BOARD. The heading is "Beginner's Kabbalah." Under that are words like "klipot" and "tikkun" with a diagram of the Kabbalistic Tree of Life. KABBALAH TEACHER, 50s-something woman, any race, is at the front.

KABBALAH TEACHER

Questions?

ZARAH

So what does Kabbalah have to say about domestic abuse and soul mates?

NOTE: Aleph Yod Shin is pronounced "Al-eff Yahd Shih-n" and Aleph Shin Hei is pronounced "Al-eff Shih-n Hay."

KABBALAH TEACHER

The Hebrew word for woman is spelled Aleph Yod Shin and man is spelled Aleph Shin Hei. If you remove the Yod and Hei, which spells God, you get fire: Aleph Shin.

The Kabbalah teacher writes the Hebrew for woman and man and circles the letters symbolizing Yod and Hei.

KABBALAH TEACHER

The Zohar is full of references to twin souls. The Hebrew word for soulmate is "bashert" (literally destiny). If someone needs to rectify their karmic debt, it could be difficult to find and be with your soulmate. Twin soul connections never happen at convenient times.

ZARAH

Thanks. That's my last question. I have to leave a bit early to catch the bus.

Zarah packs up her things and leaves for the bus stop.

KABBALAH TEACHER

Most people think of soulmates as the One or something romantic, but it doesn't have to be. For example, every date you go on is beshert and every bashert prepares you for the next beshert.

She takes a drink of water.

KABBALAH TEACHER

Also, it's not true that there's someone for everyone. Sometimes there are two for one and none for another. Anyways, that's it for today.

(MORE)

Mace in Highland

- 25 INT. PRIMARY CARE PHYSICIAN'S OFFICE DAY 25
 Amalee kisses Zarah on the forehead, far away from the cut. She puts a ruby necklace in Zarah's hand.
- 26 INT. ZARAH'S PARENTS' HOUSE FAMILY ROOM DAY 26 ZARAH'S FATHER, 63, white male, and ZARAH'S MOTHER, 63, white female, sit. Zarah's mother looks out the window.

ZARAH'S MOTHER Zarah hasn't called in a long time. Do you think she's okay?

ZARAH'S FATHER
I don't know. She could be lost to us forever.

ZARAH'S MOTHER
After trying for a baby for six
years, I never thought that we
could lose her when she became an
adult.

INT. CAR MANUFACTURING COMPANY - PARTS ROOM - DAY
The only colors in the background are metallic silver, gray, and brown. Zarah, wearing a brown t-shirt and jeans, walks funny and hides her bruised wrist by aiming them toward the shadows. Yue is wearing a gray t-shirt and jeans.

ZARAH

I'm moving the beginning of March. I'll have to drive a different route to get to work. Can you help me with directions?

YUE

Sure. Didn't I hear that you'd just moved again not that long ago?

Yue brings up Yahoo! Maps, not GPS.

ZARAH

This will be our eighth move in less than a year.

YUE

You need to stop living like a college kid. Here.

Yue gives Zarah a business card.

YUE

I know someone who works at a leasing office. Tell her you know me.

ZARAH

Can I borrow some boxes?

Zarah points to the cardboard boxes in the parts room. Yue nods.

ZARAH

And can you help take them to my car?

Yue nods.

28 EXT. CAR MANUFACTURING COMPANY - PARKING LOT - DAY
Yue walks cardboard boxes out to Zarah's car. It's a nice day
with blue skies. Yue catches a glimpse of the bruise she got
from falling on the ice.

YUE

Does your boyfriend treat you okay?

ZARAH

Uh...

INT. CAR MANUFACTURING COMPANY - ZARAH'S OFFICE - DAY 29
Zarah, in a black t-shirt and jeans, is at work with a butterfly bandage on her eyebrow. He comes in, wearing a white-t-shirt and jeans.

YUE

(points to her eyebrow)
I bet that's from having too much sex.

ZARAH

(smiles)

You're so bad.

30 INT. CAR MANUFACTURING COMPANY - STAIRCASE - DAY

Zarah walks downstairs to the parts section. She stops and walks back up as Yue walks down.

ZARAH

No more flirting.

YUE

Don't make a mountain out of a molehill.

31 INT. CAR MANUFACTURING COMPANY - ZARAH'S OFFICE - DAY 31
Zarah goes to her office. OFFICEMATE, 40s, any race, is talking with a Midwestern accent.

ZARAH

I put my foot down. I'm dating someone else. He said not to make a mountain out of a molehill.

OFFICEMATE

That doesn't sound like him, so he must definitely like you. Beware though. He's a user.

ZARAH

He's charming.

OFFICEMATE

Charming men can be the most dangerous.

LATER

It's after hours. Yue walks by Zarah's door.

ZARAH

Wait.

YUE

What? I need to pack for a business trip

ZARAH

Just a second. Sit down.

YUE

No thanks. I need to leave soon.

ZARAH

I'm conflicted because I like you. If you had me, what would you want to do to me?

Yue looks around and walks into the room.

YUE

That's up to the woman.

ZARAH

Good answer.

YUE

What really happened to your eyebrow?

ZARAH

(beat)

I got it from my boyfriend.

Zarah gestures to Yue to sit down.

YUE

No, I'm fine standing.

ZARAH

My sex drive is higher thanks to you.

Zarah pats the seat of the chair.

YUE

We'll work things out.

She tries to kiss him, but he dodges her lips.

32 INT. ZARAH'S CAR IN PETERSBURG, INDIANA - DAY Zarah texts Yue.

ZARAH (TEXT)

Hi.

YUE (TEXT)

Hi. Please call. Every text costs me money.

Zarah dials Yue's number.

ZARAH (INTO PHONE)

Where are you?

YUE (0.S.)

Do you have protection?

ZARAH (INTO PHONE)

No, I can't afford it every month.

(MORE)

32

ZARAH (INTO PHONE) (CONT'D)

Are you curious as to how I got your number?

YUE (0.S.)

No, you can find that out easily.

ZARAH (INTO PHONE)

Every minute seems so long.

INT. CAR MANUFACTURING COMPANY - PARTS ROOM - DAY
Zarah, in jeans, and Yue are in between the parts shelves
downstairs. Zarah pulls Yue's white T-SHIRT toward her. He
pulls her JACKET in too and they kiss. He covers their faces
with a flattened CARDBOARD BOX.

ZARAH

Have you ever felt so horny?

Fifteen minutes later, after making out, he indicates that she should get back to work.

 She walks up the steps and bumps into her officemate.
- INT. CAR MANUFACTURING COMPANY PARTS ROOM DAY
 Zarah and Yue are in between the parts shelves downstairs. Yue grinds against Zarah behind LARGE INDUSTRIAL EQUIPMENT.

YUE

Tonight, I'll be all over your body.

He hurriedly writes down his address and gives it to her.

36 INT. CAR MANUFACTURING COMPANY - HALLWAY - DAY

Yue has a goofy grin on his face as he is about to pass his boss in the hallway. His boss is reading a newspaper with headlines about the recession.

YUE

Man, I am so thankful you got me this job.

HIRING MANAGER

I'm glad you're happy. It's the least I could do after what you did for me. People like us need to stick together.

37 INT. YUE'S HOUSE - BEDROOM - NIGHT

37

Yue's house is in Evansville, Indiana. The new moon is barely visible from the window. The bed is in a dark colorful shade like burgundy or maroon.

YUE

Feel my heart, it's racing. I've dreamt about this.

Zarah puts her hand on his heart. They embrace. They exhale. They sigh. Yue kisses the top of Zarah's head. They hold each other in their arms for a while. They keep kissing each other repeatedly. They seem to be desperate for each other's touch as if it's their last night even though it isn't. The sex is slow and loving and does not have to be explicit. Yue gets more excited at the end.

ZARAH

Yue, oh, Yue!

YUE

It's scorched earth down there.

ZARAH

I can't do anything about it; my boyfriend would know.

YUE

He likes it shaved?

ZARAH

Yes.

YUE

Next time we have sex, I want to put the spermicide on you.

39 INT. CAR MANUFACTURING COMPANY - BREAKROOM - DAY
Yue has some eczema on his elbow, and Zarah massages it.

ZARAH

When's your birthday? How old are you?

YUE

Sixty-five.

ZARAH

Oh.

INT. YUE'S HOUSE - FAMILY ROOM - NIGHT

It's Sunday morning on a CALENDAR. Yue has ANTIQUES in his home. There's an ASHTRAY and a full WHISKEY GLASS on the table. Yue takes his (fake) medication with a swig of whiskey. Zarah

Yue takes his (fake) medication with a swig of whiskey. Zarah wears his white BATHROBE drinking a cup of COFFEE. Yue flips through a PHOTO ALBUM.

YUE

This is me when I was younger.

ZARAH

I think you're more attractive now; I'd never wish you to be younger.

(then)

What were you wearing?

YUE

If you read it sideways it says a four-letter word but it's made to look like Chinese characters. That's my sense of humor.

(then)

These are my LPs.

Yue shows off LPs of bands and musicians popular in the '60s.

ZARAH

I haven't seen a record player since I was at my babysitter's house!

YUE

And this is my computer running damned Windows 7.

ZARAH

Yeah, a lot of people have found it to be unintuitive.

YUE

Can you help me?

ZARAH

Sure.

YUE

I keep typing this address into the--

(points)

thingy.

ZARAH

That's not an address bar. That's a search engine.

YUE

What's the difference?

ZARAH

This is an address bar.

Zarah points to the address bar.

ZARAH

And this is a search engine.

Zarah points to the search engine.

YUE

They're both rectangular. They're both long and hard.
(winks)

EXT. CAR MANUFACTURING COMPANY - HALLWAY - DAYThe next day-

41

Zarah, in jeans, goes out to greet Yue, in a t-shirt and jeans, in the PARKING LOT. Yue's car has an atheist bumper sticker of a fish symbol with legs. Inside, Yue reprimands her.

YUE

That was one of the scariest things! Never do that again. I'm angry, just give me a minute.

ZARAH

Everything was okay. No one saw. And if they did, so what? It's not a crime.

YUE

I understand why you think that, but office romances are tricky; The gossip mill is terrible.

ZARAH

Are you worried about what your subordinates will think?

YUE

I don't have any subordinates. I just want to get to the point where I can retire in peace.

Wei pulls a CONDOM out of Zarah's back jeans POCKET.

WEI

Hello, what's this? I seem to find the weirdest things when I'm not looking for them.

ZARAH

That was when I was thinking about it, but I didn't do anything.

WEI

I've been checking your phone.

ZARAH

You have?

WEI

Will you please stop calling him?

ZARAH

Yes.

- INT. WEI'S PARENTS' HOUSE BEDROOM DAY (FLASHBACK)

 Wei's parents' house is in Bloomington, Indiana. WEI'S MOTHER,

 50s, goes through her husband's DRAWERS. There's a sculpture of
 a balance scale on the top. She finds evidence that he's been
 cheating on her. Young Wei is watching.
- 44 INT. WEI'S APARTMENT KITCHEN DAY

44

WEI

Remember, no one gets you better than me. That's what you want. We're the only ones from our region of the world.

(MORE)

WEI (CONT'D)

ZARAH

Maybe that's not true.

LATER

In disagreement, Zarah throws a GLASS at WEI and tries to push him onto the broken glass but ends up cutting her feet because he dodges it. He's a tough guy and nothing scares him.

ZARAH

You don't love me. No one can love me, not even my parents!

WEI

What the hell! (then)

Do you want my help?

ZARAH

No... yes.

Wei wraps her foot in a SOCK and puts a BOWL underneath her foot to collect blood. The sock becomes completely RED.

45 EXT. WEI'S APARTMENT - DAY

45

Zarah returns home from work. Wei returns home from something too but it's not apparent what that is. Is it possible that he's cheating too?

WEI

Hey, Perfect.

ZARAH

I get tired of looking at your face.

WEI

Well, I get tired of seeing you in purple. It does nothing for you. Red suits you better. This is the thanks I get for loving you unconditionally? This is about him, isn't it?

ZARAH

No, it's about us. Don't make it about him.

WEI

I don't trust him.

ZARAH

Well, I do.

WEI

So you're saying he makes you feel safe, and I don't?

ZARAH

Yes.

WEI

I make my life, and I accept it. You're a fool.

(then)

Well, how about this? You can have sex with someone when I find a girl to have sex with. But it will not be with that man.

Zarah finds an eviction notice on the apartment door. This is the last straw.

ZARAH

This is the 10th time in seven months!

INT. CAR MANUFACTURING COMPANY - ZARAH'S OFFICE - DAY
SUPER: April 30, 2008
Zarah, in jeans, is in her office wearing a bandage on her eyebrow.

OFFICEMATE (2ND JOB)

Can you check these boxes to make sure they have the right manuals in them?

Zarah cuts open boxes and waves scissors around angrily.

ZARAH

I checked them yesterday; I made a list. What are you doing? Don't give me BS. I've had enough BS.

Zarah runs to the HIRING MANAGER.

ZARAH

I need to go home.

INT. WEI'S APARTMENT - FAMILY ROOM - DAY Zarah flips up her flip phone.

47

HIRING MANAGER (INTO PHONE)

You're fired. You were threatening your coworker with a weapon.

ZARAH (O.S.)

But...

Next day-

It's the morning. An angry rap song is playing.

WEI

Ok fine. Just do it. Then be done with it. Where are you going?

ZARAH

You said to just do it.

WEI

No, I didn't.

ZARAH

I'm pretty sure you did.

WEI

I wouldn't say that.

ZARAH

Can I at least call him to tell him goodbye?

WEI

Fine but make it quick!

Zarah goes to the bedroom, closes the bedroom door, and calls Yue.

YUE

Hi. The gossip mill is now saying you threatened your coworker with a razor.

ZARAH

That's B.S.

Wei knocks loudly on the bedroom door.

WEI

Why are you taking so long? It shouldn't take this long!

ZARAH

I've got to go.

Zarah hangs up and opens the door.

ZARAH

We're getting evicted, and you're telling me what to do? Go to a hotel room.

48 INT./EXT. ZARAH'S CAR/AIRPORT PARKING LOT - DAY

Amalee wears a purple airline work SHIRT. They look at each other's intercut screens.

INTERCUT:

ZARAH (INTO PHONE)

I've been in an abusive relationship, and I don't even recognize myself anymore.

AMALEE (INTO PHONE)

If I saw your ex, I'd beat him up for you.

(then)

I can get you a plane ticket.

ZARAH (INTO PHONE)

But my stuff...

AMALEE (INTO PHONE)

No worries. Just be thankful that I got this new job.

END INTERCUT:

AMALEE (O.S.)

Just let me know when you can pay for shipping.

Zarah knocks on the door wearing what she wore on their first night together.

ZARAH

May I come in? I was just fired.

YUE

I know. I like your skirt.

The landline phone rings and Yue picks it up.

YUE

My friend is coming over soon. You better leave.

Zarah watches Wei talk to her father on the phone.

ZARAH'S FATHER (INTO PHONE) What the hell are you doing with your life? Why don't you join the military. You're young enough.

WEI (INTO PHONE)

I...

ZARAH'S FATHER (INTO PHONE) From the point of view of my wife and me, your incompetence is gonna get someone killed.

WEI (INTO PHONE)
I think that's a bit--

ZARAH'S FATHER (INTO PHONE) How long have you been dating my daughter?

WEI (INTO PHONE)

Four years.

ZARAH'S FATHER (INTO PHONE)
Four years, and you haven't done a
damn thing for her life. This is

Zarah bawls. Wei looks down at her then curls up next to her so they look like a Venn diagram. He doesn't know what else to do.

51 INT. WEI'S APARTMENT - BEDROOM - DAY

51

Zarah receives an email from her adoption agency with a form stating that she will pay her adoption agency to have them send a letter to her birthmother. Zarah writes a LETTER to her birthmother on an Untimely Torn card (product placement). She starts "Dear Má".

ZARAH (V.O.)

My name is Zarah. I graduated from college with a bachelor's degree in English. Some of my favorite hobbies include reading, listening to music, watching television and movies, watching Japanese animation, and hanging out with my friends.

52 INT. ZARAH'S PARENTS' HOUSE - FAMILY ROOM - DAY ZARAH'S DIALOGUE continues.

Zarah's father is taking a work-related call. Zarah's mother is grading TESTS. She's wearing CROSS jewelry. All this appears to be viewed with idyllic rose-colored glasses.

ZARAH (V.O.)

I have a very small loving adoptive family. My mom is well known in my church and spends much time volunteering.

ZARAH'S DIALOGUE continues.

Zarah's Mother and Amalee are doing downward dog on their YOGA MATS while watching a yoga video. Amalee turns her head and smiles at Zarah's mother. This is viewed with a rose-colored filter.

53 INT. WEI'S APARTMENT - BEDROOM - DAY

ZARAH (V.O.)

I'm very proud of my adoptive family and everything that they've given me. I wouldn't be who I am now if it weren't for them. I hope to reunite with you someday when you're ready. I'd like to know the circumstances behind my adoption. If you know French and can send me letters in French. I have a friend who can translate them for me.

54 INT. COMMUNITY THEATER - DAY

54

ZARAH'S DIALOGUE continues.

An adult female puppet looks pregnant. She "opens" up an ENVELOPE and cries.

55 INT. WEI'S APARTMENT - BEDROOM - DAY

55

ZARAH (CONT'D)

I hope that someday we can move past everything that has happened in our past, and I hope that we can all find peace.

56 INT. MEXICAN BAR - NIGHT

56

There are POOL TABLES and a bar inside the restaurant. There are several posters of graffiti art. Zarah calls Yue.

Zarah hears Yue groan into the phone.

ZARAH

Please, for me?

Yue enters the bar.

YUE

If I were twenty years younger --

ZARAH

I like you the way you are.

Yue teaches Zarah how to use a cue. A 50's song plays and they dance to it.

57 EXT. MEXICAN BAR - NIGHT

57

Wei is in the parking lot. He pours a SOAP concoction into Zarah's gas tank in a jealous rage and writes "whore" on her car with red spraypaint. Cutter is helping him.

Wei's face is red from anger.

WEI

You seriously chose today?! I just got a new job, bitch!

CUTTER

Yes, drown it in blood!

LATER

Zarah and Yue leave and get in Yue's car instead of her own. They can't see what happened to her car.

58 INT. YUE'S HOUSE - FAMILY ROOM - DAY

58

A modern jazz song plays from his outdoor speakers.

ZARAH

He was so stupid.

YUE

Duh.

ZARAH

There will be no talk about the men in my life, neither my ex nor my father.

YUE

I'm fine with that.

(then)

Your kisses are in the top five percent.

ZARAH

Wow!

YUE

The first time we kissed was amazing. When you came down to the parts room and told me 'No more flirting,' I thought, where did that come from?

Yue is very lusty.

If I were younger, around your age, I'd have been all over you. In the office that first day, you wanted to kiss me, right?

ZARAH

Yes.

YUE

Did you notice what I did? I leaned in and then dodged so you couldn't kiss me.

He leans and dodges to replay the moment.

YUE

(pre-lap)

I got to step outside for a few minutes.

ZARAH

My grandma doesn't like Frank Sinatra because he was a gambler.

YUE

My parents didn't like Frank Sinatra either. Let's watch a movie. So, tell me why your father--

ZARAH

Remember the rule?

YUE

Okay, I won't mention it again.

ZARAH

Do you mind if I ask what happened to your pointer finger?

Nothing, it's probably just from the repetitive motion of screwing things on vehicles.

(looks at Zarah's sandals)
Talking about appendages, you have
long toes.

ZARAH

Oops! I forgot the closed toe policy.

YUE

Are you the type who goes from one relationship to another?

ZARAH

Okay.

YUE

I thought about what it must have been like for you to be a Vietnamese adoptee in an all-white family.

ZARAH

YUE

You're very, very sensitive.

ZARAH

Is it obvious?

YUE

Fersher.

ZARAH

Say that again.

YUE

Fersher, 95% of the time, I can look at a person and describe his or her personality without even hearing them talk.

Yue looks into her face.

YUE

Most folks who have lived awhile, and are somewhat astute, can do that exercise.

ZARAH

There's a lot more to people than their personality. Everyone has stories to tell.

YUE

Fersher.

ZARAH

If we were to live together, do you think we could figure out the finances all right?

Yue walks in to get a drink and didn't hear her. He returns, and she changes topics.

ZARAH

Guess what. I'm a model.

YUE

I was a model too.

Zarah gives him a quizzical look.

YUE

A long time ago.

ZARAH

So, what does being a Leo mean to you?

YUE

It means I'm very bold.

ZARAH

My grandma was a Leo, but she was very different from you. She was modest. What makes her a Leo?

YUE

She must have masturbated every day.

ZARAH

(laughs)

I don't know if I want to have more sex with you or if I want to find out all I can about you.

YUE

I agree.

Zarah points at a piece of paper quizzically. Yue pulls down the piece of paper and shows Zarah his father's will.

YUE

This is my father's will. The bastard didn't leave anything for me because I divorced my ex-wife.

INT. YUE'S HOUSE - BEDROOM - DAY (FLASHBACK)
YUE'S DIALOGUE continues over the FLASHBACK.

SUPER: Fall in the 1970s Yue's ex-wife goes to take BIRTH CONTROL then decides against it while Yue's not looking. Yue drinks from a bottle of BEER and massages her shoulders in a lusty way. Yue's flashbacks have an old B&W 35mm quality.

YUE

(then)

ZARAH

YUE

ZARAH

Yue.

YUE

Whaaa?

ZARAH

I love you.

That's BS.

ZARAH

I'm very vulnerable.

YUE

I know.

62 INT. WEI'S APARTMENT - NIGHT

Amalee moves Zarah's stuff out of Wei's apartment when he's not around.

ZARAH

At the airport, after dropping her off and returning home, Yue calls her phone, and her phone rings. A bright WINDOW appears. Yue looks at it longingly.

(then)

Let's stay in touch.

ZARAH (INTO PHONE)

Stay in touch sounds too much like goodbye. We'll stay in touch as soon as possible, as often as possible.

Her parents open the door and hug Zarah. Zarah's mother has tears in her eyes, and Zarah's father tries to appear strong. Amalee is also there and hugs Zarah. She leaves, but not before squeezing Zarah's mother's hand.

YUE (ON EMAIL)

Now you have it! Little sentences.

ZARAH (ON EMAIL)

Am I scaring you away?

YUE (ON EMAIL)
You're not scaring me away.

69 EXT. SUBURBAN SIDEWALK - DAY

69

The sky is gray. Zarah's clothing is pressed. Series of doors opening when she presents her résumé. People look impressed and make her offers, but they aren't high enough, and she turns them down. At the last one, someone gives her a get-rich quick home-based business brochure. She picks it up, looks at it, and puts it in her pocket.

ZARAH

If only I could pay for two people...

70 EXT. PARK - NIGHT

70

WEI

He's gonna pay!

Foreboding music stops.

CUTTER

Beat.

WEI

You're right, but I'll find another way.

Wei sits down on his camping chair to watch TV.

CUTTER

Where'd you get the TV?

Made in Highland

WEI

Found it.

72 EXT. MEXICAN BAR - NIGHT

72

Wei follows Yue to the Mexican bar and waits in the parking lot. Fight music begins. When Yue leaves drunk, Wei attacks him. A passionate STREET BRAWL ensues. As he leaves--

WEI

I'll hunt you down old man!

Yue's phone rings. He picks up.

ZARAH

So we're still on for tomorrow?

Yue catches his breath.

YUE

Tomorrow? Oh, yes.

ZARAH (O.S.)

Are you okay?

YUE (ON PHONE)

Yeah, of course, no worries.

73 INT. ZARAH'S APARTMENT - BEDROOM - DAY

73

Zarah brought her '90s unicorn POSTERS in red and yellow from her old bedroom, as well as her baby doll in red. The apartment is decorated with a lot of colors and seems to be in accordance with feng shui rules.

Zarah returns with chocolate SYRUP and turns on a romantic alternative rock song. A romantic French song plays while Zarah is on top of Yue in Zarah's bed. Even though it's hot outside, the apartment is air conditioned but not loudly. They go slow to keep themselves somewhat cool. This scene is PG-13.

YUE

What are you doing to me?

ZARAH

I feel very strongly about you.

YUE

I'm starting to feel the same way. I'll never understand this relationship, but I'm going along with it.

After orgasm-

YUE

I'm tired. You've worn me out. I've used muscles I've not used before in a while. I'm a broken man.

74 EXT. ZARAH'S APARTMENT - DAY
Zarah and Yue make out by the SCREEN DOOR. Yue goes to the rental truck and Zarah heads toward the bus.

YUE

Wait!

Yue holds out her parking pass, which she takes. They hug.

75

INT. ZARAH'S APARTMENT - BEDROOM - NIGHT

ZARAH

Did you know there are Asians in Mexico?

YUE

You could be a Vietnamese person in Mexico who speaks Spanish.

ZARAH

I never said anything about speaking Spanish... Hmm, I wonder what you're thinking.

YUE

Just carrying fantasy to different levels. Maybe learning Spanish is not a bad idea.

A devil emoji pops up in the air.

YUE

This is my dream house.

A picture appears of a beautiful house.

YUE (CONT'D)

but with a surrounding veranda in the foothills of somewhere cool.

There's the sound of a knock at the door.

YUE

Sorry, I have company.

A door appears. Yue returns to his apartment quickly.

80 INT. YUE'S HOUSE - FRONT DOOR - DAY
Yue opens the door to see his PROBATION OFFICER, adult, any age or race, handing him an envelope.

PROBATION OFFICER

Mr. Lao. The terms of your probation are as follows--

NARRATOR (V.O.)

She was by nature a cheater; she could neither love just one man nor just one set of parents.

85 INT. COMMUNITY THEATER - DAY
NARRATOR'S DIALOGUE continues.

85

An adult female water puppet puts her hand on her pregnant stomach.

NARRATOR (CONT'D)

She fooled her ex into thinking he had a chance by making the impossible sound possible,

86 INT. ZARAH'S APARTMENT - BEDROOM - DAY 86
Zarah notices that a bit of red thread has unraveled from the red baby onesie.

NARRATOR (CONT'D)

and she fooled her friends and family by making the possible sound impossible.

Zarah repeatedly flips a coin.

NARRATOR (CONT'D)

She held them both in her heart until she could decide who she was cheating on.

V.O. continues over music.

Rap plays. Zarah reaches in the direction of the rap. Jazz plays. Zarah reaches in the direction of the jazz. Zarah screams in frustration.

87 INT. BEACH - DAY

87

Zarah is building a sandcastle.

NOTE: Polyamorous is pronounced "polly-aam-or-us."

ZARAH

Why can't I just love one man? Maybe I'm polyamorous.

AMALEE

Some people just cannot be monogamous no matter how hard they try. However, I feel that when the person you're with doesn't want you to be non-monogamous, then you are, but I bet you that when you find someone who finally accepts you, then you'll want to be monogamous.

Amalee laces her fingers in Zarah's, and Zarah looks down.

88 INT. ZARAH'S PARENTS' HOUSE - FAMILY ROOM - DAY 88
Zarah's mother is doing yoga with calming meditation music.
Zarah's enters.

ZARAH

Hi, mom.

ZARAH'S MOTHER

Hi, how are you?

Zarah doesn't answer. Zarah's mother turns off the music to look at her.

ZARAH'S MOTHER

What's wrong, honey?

ZARAH

I'm having a hard time deciding between two guys.

ZARAH'S MOTHER

91 INT. ZARAH'S APARTMENT - BEDROOM - DAY

Zarah drinks from a bottle of beer simultaneously, potentially in a floating computer window screen in the bottom righthand corner.

ZARAH (CONT'D)

I need to decide between Person A and Person B. Neither one has much money. Both are far away. Person A is immature, and Person B is mature. I chase Person A, but Person B chases me. I'm religious and Person A is religious, but Person B is not.

Zarah takes a breath.

ZARAH (CONT'D)

Should I believe that comfort will grow with love or love will grow with comfort?

INTERCUT:

ZARAH'S DIALOGUE continues over water puppets.

SUPER: Christmas 1982
An adult female water puppet representing Sang in clothing

SUPER: Christmas 1982
An adult female water puppet representing Sang in clothing typical in garment factories, and an adult male puppet in a suit are yelling at each other silently. A child female puppet

ZARAH

Christianity.

KABBALAH TEACHER

You might want to read 1 Corinthians 13:4-8 in your Bible.

Zarah flips to 1 Corinthians 13:4-8 in the Bible while on the phone.

KABBALAH TEACHER

Would you be willing to let him go if you believed it was the best thing?

98 EXT./INT. YUE'S HOUSE - DAY - TRACKING

98

Yue brings in a PACKAGE from the mailbox and opens it up, surprised to find what's inside. He turns on his computer and opens up his EMAIL ACCOUNT.

YUE (ON EMAIL)

I put them right to my nose and mouth to see if I could smell and taste you.

Zarah is dressed in a colorful BUSINESS SUIT and a subtle CROSS necklace (passed down by her mom) because it's a weeknight, and she wants to look as if she has a job. Yue is dressed casually. Zarah and Yue get into a white RENTAL TRUCK.

YUE

This place probably used to be a steakhouse. This is a family-owned business.

ZARAH

That movie you recommended to me... I'm going to wait to see it. I don't really like Ernest Hemingway.

YUE

Why?

ZARAH

He's a womanizer.

YUE

I'm a womanizer. That's not a good reason for not liking him.

ZARAH

I was reading a book about how women need love and men need respect. I don't feel that your wife respected you.

YUE

There wasn't much to respect.

(then)

I'm going to scan the pictures I have from when I was younger.

ZARAH

Just do it. You've been telling me that for months.

YUE

Will you let me sleep tonight?

Made in Highland

ZARAH

Yeees. Did you tell your daughters anything?

YUE

There are just some things you don't say to your kids, and this is one of them. I love being single.

ZARAH

But you're not single. You're with me.

At the stoplight, Zarah takes out her phone and takes a picture of him, afraid that she doesn't have enough to remember him by.

ZARAH

Yue is still driving to the airport with Zarah in the passenger seat.

YUE

You can't get pregnant.
(MORE)

YUE (CONT'D)

If you do, you must get an abortion. Understand?

ZARAH

(disturbed)

Yes

Yue parks the truck and gets out. Yue seems to almost fall but grabs the TRUCK DOOR for balance. Zarah doesn't see as she's distracted by something.

That's me being an ass.

ZARAH

If you were twenty years younger, I'd have loved to have a son with you.

YUE

Oh, fersher. If it were to happen, we would figure something out.

107 EXT. BUS STOP - NIGHT

Zarah picks up Wei from the airport bus stop.

108 INT. ZARAH'S APARTMENT - BEDROOM - NIGHT

It's thundering outside. After Zarah let Wei inside, Wei pulls down her jeans in a hurry. The power goes out. This scene is PG-13.

OVER BLACK

ZARAH (O.S.)

Stop! Stop!

FADE IN:

He keeps going. All the color seems to drain from her colorful apartment, starting with the walls.

ZARAH (O.S.)

(exhausted with her eyes

open)

Stop... Stop... Please...

NURSE (V.O.)

(pre-lap)

Zarah?

Zarah follows the nurse with a clipboard into the doctor's

A thread from Zarah's baby onesie unravels.

SUPER: Yue's Birthday

Yue looks around and is all by himself. The colors have faded.

An text message appears on the screen

YUE (ON TEXT)

I miss you!

Yue pours himself a glass of whiskey and drinks it alone.

Zarah's phone plays a fight song ringtone she had just assigned to her ex. The phone rings a few times with Wei's name on the CALLER ID, but she doesn't answer.

YUE

ZARAH

Have you ever been in love?

YUE

Fersher. I've been in love a handful of times...three...maybe five times.

ZARAH

So, you say you've been in love several times. Who were they with? Your ex-wife?

YUE

No, I never loved her. In fact, maybe I've never been in love.

ZARAH

What do you think about when you think about us?

YUE

Actually, I've been reading various accounts about near death experiences and the afterlife.

Zarah has a quizzical look on her face.

ZARAH

Do I make you feel older?

No. You make me feel like I'm fifty years old.

ZARAH

What do you think about me?

YUE

I see you as worldly, but unsophisticated. No offense, but you're too trusting.

Zarah is all too aware.

ZARAH

So where do you see us going?

YUE

I don't see us going anywhere. The money issue is huge.

ZARAH

I want to move in with you. After having moved to one state, I want to try them all out.

Zarah laughs.

YUE

Fersher, you could still do it! But no, you need to stay where you are and establish yourself.

ZARAH

I was thinking, I could be with you for five years. I know I can last that long in a relationship. I can't promise anything past that.

YUE

In five years, I'll be about 70.

ZARAH

So?

YUE

You'll find someone else, or I'll find someone else. There is no long-term potential. In addition, money is a big issue. I'll be retiring soon.

(MORE)

YUE (CONT'D)

I don't have a retirement account and just started living off of social security.

He pulls out the inside of his pockets to make his point.

YUE

I can't afford to live in the states. You don't have money either. It would be unfair to you. Let's just enjoy ourselves and have fun.

Beat.

ZARAH

If you want to be fair to me, then do what you can to keep yourself living longer, meaning laugh more and smoke less and eat antioxidants.

(then)

God, I love the sound of your laughter...

YUE

Am trying...

117 INT. ZARAH'S APARTMENT - BEDROOM - DAY

117

SUPER: Day After

Zarah makes a sort of shrine to Yue with his PICTURE on top of the image of a mountain, magazine clippings, and a votive candle. It's large enough to look like a teenage crush but not large enough to be creepy. Zarah is praying to her shrine.

ZARAH

Lord, please release me from the covenant I made with you.

Zarah looks up at the unicorn POSTERS and down at her CROSS necklace.

ZARAH

It's not working.

118 EXT. SUBURBAN SIDEWALK - DAY

118

Yue shows Zarah around where he grew up.

YUE

And this is where I had sex for the first time...

119

119 INT. TELEPHONE WORLD - DAY

Zarah sees Yue looking at a plant.

YUE

I got a new plant. It's actually poisonous.

ZARAH

Why in the world would you get a poisonous plant? Do you want to die?

YUE

My retirement is coming up. There's not much left for me.

After they hang up, Zarah calls 911. She waits to be asked "what's your emergency?" but the audience can't hear.

ZARAH

I'm afraid that my boyfriend is suicidal. Can you provide a wellness check?

Zarah's phone rings.

YUE

Please don't do that. It's embarrassing. Gimme some time. I'll be fine tomorrow.

120 INT. YUE'S HOUSE - FAMILY ROOM - DAY

120

Zarah, in a skirt, and Yue are sitting on the couch. The moon is full from the window.

Zarah orders a colorful vegetarian PIZZA.

ZARAH

Can you?

Yue gives her the CASH to pay for it.

YUE

You know there are forty years between us. That's a lot.

ZARAH

Yes.

LATER

Well that's my first time seeing animé. Very interesting. Anyways, it's my turn to pick the next movie.

Zarah, in a skirt, and Yue watch a romantic French tragedy.

ZARAH

You seem to have a thing for movies with unhappy endings. That'll have to change.

YUE

Am not familiar with current movies... Have not been in a movie theatre for over 15-20 years.

121 INT. YUE'S HOUSE - BEDROOM - DAY

121

Zarah and Yue are in bed. Yue has his back to Zarah with Zarah's hand around his waist.

ZARAH

In that movie we watched, I wouldn't say that I'd kill myself for you, but I'd die for you.

YUE

You'll never have to.

ZARAH

I'd do anything for you.

YUE

I know, but I'd never exploit it.

ZARAH

Well, you can.

YUE

Well, I won't.

ZARAH

You can never understand my feelings.

YUE

The more you tell me, the more I understand.

It hurts me to be with you; it makes me sad because you keep saying it is temporary.

YUE

At some point I'll have to say it is the end, but I'll not want to.

ZARAH

God played a cruel joke on me!

YUE

God didn't do anything to you. There is no God anyways.

ZARAH

I'll love you even if we were not compatible.

YUE

You should go to the bathroom. Don't want you to get pregnant.

Zarah leaves for the bathroom but is still talking.

ZARAH

Do I talk too much?

YUE

(laughs)

Fersher.

Yue gets back into bed with his back facing her.

ZARAH

I'll love you forever. You can't say anything to change my mind.

YUE

I'm TOO OLD!

ZARAH

That's not going to work.

Yue leaves for the bathroom again. He seems to be dealing with a health issue. Yue gets back into bed with his back facing her again.

Made in Highland

ZARAH

Are you awake?

YUE

Fersher. How'd you know?

If I ever go to Mexico or Panama, it'll be for me, and we'll live separately.

The next day-

Zarah moans into the receiver while Yue listens but doesn't respond.

122 INT. TELEPHONE WORLD - DAY

122

Colors have become a bit darker. Zarah's father is coming down on Zarah hard.

ZARAH'S FATHER (INTO PHONE)

You have zero confidence and selfesteem. You have only yourself to blame. Look in the mirror and know who did this.

ZARAH

I...

ZARAH'S FATHER

If you want someone to love there's me. There's your mother. Two people who are safe to love.

ZARAH

I know.

ZARAH'S FATHER

You intentionally complicate your life. You'll need at least a 1 1/2 years to fix yourself. What are you going to do?

ZARAH (INTO PHONE)

I can find a job so that I can be independent and pay off my debt.

ZARAH'S FATHER (INTO PHONE)

You better. I became the co-signer because you're my daughter, but when the rent comes due I expect you to pay it. Instead of doing what you did before, why don't you get a real job?

ZARAH'S MOTHER (O.S.)

Who's on the phone?

ZARAH'S FATHER (INTO PHONE)

Zarah.

ZARAH'S MOTHER (O.S.)
Oh, Zarah, what's going on baby?

ZARAH'S FATHER (INTO PHONE)
Her boyfriend wants to break up
with her. Zarah, let him. No one
wants to be a burden: you or him.

ZARAH'S MOTHER (INTO PHONE) Are you okay?

ZARAH (INTO PHONE)
No, mom. I miss him so much!

ZARAH'S MOTHER (INTO PHONE) You're lucky to have two men who care for you. One man, your ex, gives you what you want. The other man gives you what you need. If you truly love him, you'll accept this gift he's giving you.

LATER

Zarah turns to face Yue.

ZARAH

(cries)

I can't be in an unbalanced relationship. I think you're a bit of a commitment-phobe.

YUE

I'm not afraid of commitment.

ZARAH

Well, okay...

YUE

And the age thing--

ZARAH

Age has never been an issue!

YUE

Well, okay. How do you want to do this?

ZARAH

We'll take a break, I'll return, and I'll always love you. Do you believe in my word?

YUE

I don't plan for the future.

Don't go! This is the last time I get to talk to you. Well, the last time for a very, very long time.

(then)

How do you feel about me?

YUE

I'm not where you are, mentally. We'll leave it at that.

ZARAH

I'll miss you so much.

YUE

I'll miss you too.

ZARAH

Will you stop thinking about me?

YUE

No.

ZARAH

I'll love you forever.

YUE

Go to bed.

Zarah calls Yue again.

ZARAH

Sorry.

YUE (O.S.)

Why?

ZARAH

For calling you again.

YUE (0.S.)

God, I'll miss your laughter so much.

(then)

Go to sleep.

FADE TO:

BLACK

123
INT. ZARAH'S APARTMENT - FAMILY ROOM - NIGHT
It's the next day. A breakup song plays. Amalee sits on Zarah's COUCH smoking a VAPE PEN.

You got your revenge.

AMALEE

I'd never wish that on you. Do what's in your heart.

ZARAH

I feel abandoned all over again. I feel like dating is like being a foster child.

AMALEE

You know I'd never abandon you.

ZARAH

Yeah, but you're my friend.

AMALEE

So? Friends abandon each other all the time.

ZARAH

Should I call him?

AMALEE

There's no time likes the present.

Zarah reads the EMAIL she is writing aloud.

ZARAH (ON EMAIL)

Ok, I admit I can't take this. We can stop these games now. I promise that I don't care about your age. I'm strong. I'm a big girl. Talk to me. Call me.

Zarah sends the email, not noticing that Yue had already emailed her previously. Zarah calls Yue twice. Zarah calls him again every few minutes while her first love is in the apartment stoned.

AMALEE

The euphoric feelings from getting high are similar to the euphoric feelings of being in love, and You're on a double high.

Zarah calls Yue, and Yue picks up. He hangs up. She hangs up.

YUE (0.S.)

Read my email. I liked what you said yesterday.

Yue reads his EMAIL on Zarah's LAPTOP SCREEN.

YUE (V.O.)

Were I thirty years younger, there might be a chance. In a couple of years, I'll begin the downhill aging process. In no way will I let you be saddled with an old man. You're young and have the whole world ahead of you. Grab on to it. It's over.

Upon realization that she's being abandoned, Zarah's eyes water and her lips tremble before she cries violently.

AMALEE

You'll never stop loving, but the pain will go away. You have to continue living. You have to learn to accept it.

ZARAH

When he dies, I'll have peace that he's all around me and can watch me. I'll spend my annual vacation visiting his grave. When I die, I wish to be buried next to him.

INT. ZARAH'S APARTMENT - BEDROOM - NIGHT 124 124 Zarah prints out Yue's last email and lays it upright on the shrine with a FIGURINE pointing to it that says, "Love". She lights the votive candle and turns on romantic chill music.

ZARAH

You know what he said to me? He said, "There are just some things you don't say to your kids."

AMALEE

I see his point of view.

ZARAH

What do you mean?

AMALEE

Zarah, I'm dating your mom.

ZARAH

You're what?! But she's married. She's white. She's straight.

AMALEE

Oh honey, she's not straight anymore.

Amalee puts a hand on Zarah's back.

AMALEE

But this is about you. Know what? You don't need him.

ZARAH

I guess not. I don't need anyone.

AMALEE

Don't crawl back to me. At least I'm not the stereotype.

Zarah is taken aback.

Zarah puts her hands together on the desk as if in prayer. She stares up at a cross.

KABBALAH TEACHER

(pre-lap)

Love addiction and codependency go together.

125 INT. SYNAGOGUE - OFFICE - DAY

125

We see the Kabbalah tree of life. Zarah sits anxiously across from the Kabbalah teacher/counselor. She looks at herself in the teacher's mirror.

KABBALAH TEACHER (CONT'D)

And what they both have in common is a focus on other people. Remember that focusing on others is a cop out from focusing on yourself.

The Kabbalah teacher takes a drink of water.

KABBALAH TEACHER

However, it's more apparent in love relationships, whereas friendships tend to fall by the wayside. I bet you don't spend much time in self-care.

ZARAH

I've a hard time understanding "self-care" and "self-love." I struggle buying groceries for myself if that's what you mean.

KABBALAH TEACHER

Exactly. Have you ever thought of meditation?

Oh, I don't think I can do that. It's much too unproductive.

KABBALAH TEACHER

I disagree. There are plenty of benefits. If you're new, why don't you just try to be by yourself.

ZARAH

Ew, that's terrifying. I'll keep my calendar full just so I don't have to be in my apartment.

KABBALAH TEACHER
As Ralph Waldo Emerson said,
"always do what you're afraid to
do." That's from Kabbalah as well.

ZARAH

It is, but easier said than done.

126 INT. ZARAH'S APARTMENT - BEDROOM - DAY

Zarah writes an EMAIL that she never sends. Zarah reads the email she is writing aloud.

ZARAH (ON EMAIL)

If you're out there and you're reading this, know that I've accepted your gift of a "better life," but I'll always love you, Yue.

127
An adult female water puppet fills out a form in Vietnamese with a number behind the Vietnamese dong symbol. SANG, 46-52, Vietnamese woman, asks-

SANG

(in Vietnamese; subtitled)
Can I borrow some money? I'll pay

128 INT. ZARAH'S APARTMENT - BEDROOM - DAY
A relevant and poignant Vietnamese song plays. Zarah finishes her sewing project on her sewing machine, and it's revealed to be the Vietnamese flag.

An email pops up. Zarah opens up an email from her adoption agency with two attachments. There's a JPEG file with Sang's picture and the document file name is "Translation of Birthmother Letter."

SANG (V.O.)

And it's better to marry a man who loves you than whom you love.

129 INT. COMMUNITY THEATER - DAY SANG'S DIALOGUE continues.

129

An adult female water puppet is leading other female water puppets in a garment factory. The adult female water puppet's water breaks. It puts a phone to its ear. An adult male and female water puppet come into the garment factory and rush her to the hospital. The adult female water puppet is in the hospital giving birth. An adult male puppet kisses Sang's puppet on the cheek after her baby puppet is born.

SANG (V.O.)

Be sure to choose a man who is not selfish, but is considerate and responsible, and has earning power.

Sang grabs her husband's hand and says something in Vietnamese:

SANG

(whispers)

Let's not tell our baby that she has an older sister.

130 INT. ZARAH'S APARTMENT - BEDROOM - DAY

130

SANG (V.O.)

It's not that easy to be a mature adult, so please deal with every moment of your life as you learn.

131 EXT. BUS STOP - DAY

131

What appears to be helicopter seeds fall to the ground. Zarah stands waiting for her bus. Zarah opens up her wallet and counts her cash to pay for the bus.

Stock footage of squirrels gathering acorns and an oak tree.

132 EXT. YUE'S HOUSE - DAY Yue gardens.

132

NARRATOR (V.O.)

Yue was already in the winter of life. Until they reunited in heaven, her heart would ache.

V.O. continues.

He cuts a plant and replants it in a cardboard container.

133 INT. YUE'S HOUSE - FAMILY ROOM - DAY

133

NARRATOR (V.O.)

Wei's time was running out too.

V.O. continues.

Yue finishes the movie on his TV that they watched when Yue and Zarah broke up. He takes a drag from his cigarette, then he starts it again from the beginning. Everything has a B&W 35MM appearance.

134 INT./EXT. WEI'S APARTMENT - DAY (SERIES OF SHOTS)

134

NARRATOR (V.O.)

Time was running out to change bad habits

While we continue to HEAR the narrator's voice, we begin a SERIES OF SHOTS:

Wei looks around at the floor in the family room and starts picking bottle caps off the floor.

NARRATOR (V.O.)

that could last throughout his lifetime,

Wei knocks on doors outside his apartment, taking surveys for his job.

NARRATOR (V.O.)

that could lead to an earlier death.

Wei puts money in a COIN JAR that has an acorn symbol on the front. He keeps it in the back of his kitchen pantry so that Melinda doesn't know.

END SERIES OF SHOTS

135 INT. AIRPORT - DAY

Zarah's DIALOGUE continues.

Melinda waits for Wei at the airport, saving him a seat and looking at the clock, but Wei never shows.

136 INT. ZARAH'S APARTMENT - DAY

136

TITLE CARD: February 2011

Wei knocks on the front door. Zarah opens it. He smiles.

WEI

Here, this is for you.

Wei wears a casual SHIRT that glamorizes money and BLING. When he tries to put a NECKLACE on her neck, with a ruby pendant, he struggles with the clasp, and it falls to the ground.

Zarah looks down at the necklace then closes the door. WEI bangs on the door.

WEI

What does he have that I don't have? Why? Why?

Zarah does what her therapist recommended: spending time with herself. ZARAH (CONT'D)

The world, how I was raised, it's hard not to be what the world defines me as because it becomes a part of my self-image.

AMALEE

I get it.

ZARAH

But I'm gonna work on it. Let's start over. Friends?

AMALEE

Friends.
